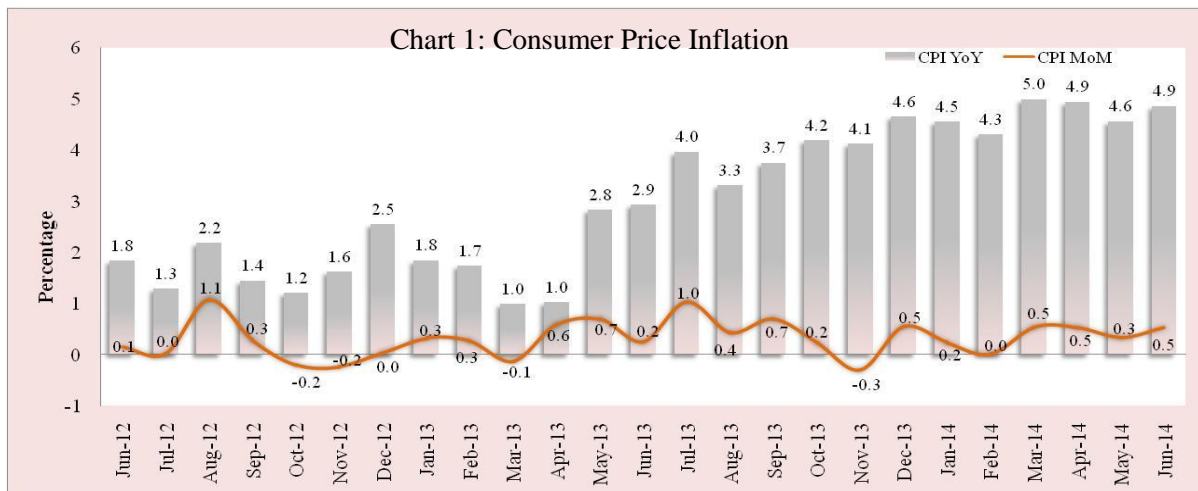

## Introduction

Headline Consumer price inflation in June 2014 climbed moderately and Cambodian riel (KHR) exchange rate against US dollar continued to depreciate slightly. At the same time, banking transaction reflected by credit to private sector and deposits continued to increase consecutively. During the period, international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

## Consumer Price Index

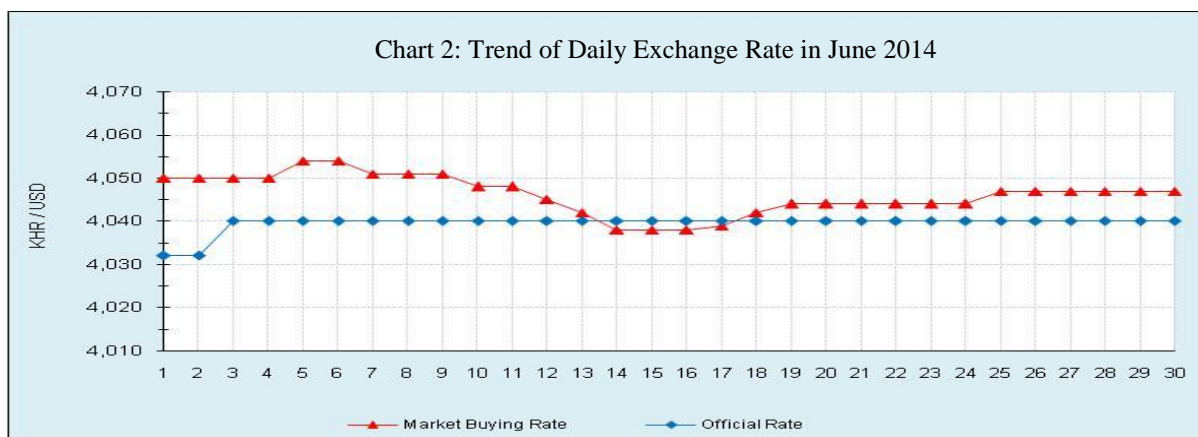
Consumer price inflation (CPI) in Phnom Penh accelerated to 0.53% (month-on-month) in June 2014 from 0.32% in May 2014. In which, seven out of twelve group indexes increased, four group indexes decreased, and another one remained stable.



During the period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items increased to 4.85% in June from 4.55% in a month earlier, mainly due to increases in food and oil prices.

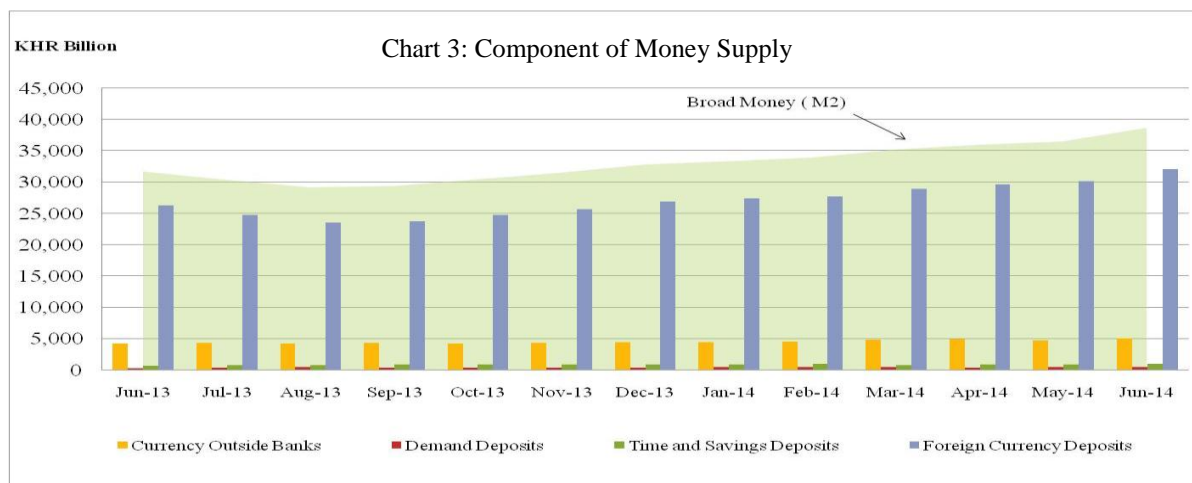
## Exchange Rate

The value of KHR against the US dollar (market buying rate) continued to depreciate slightly by 0.09% in June after depreciating 0.77% in May 2014. This was mainly due to the rainy and fishery ban season.



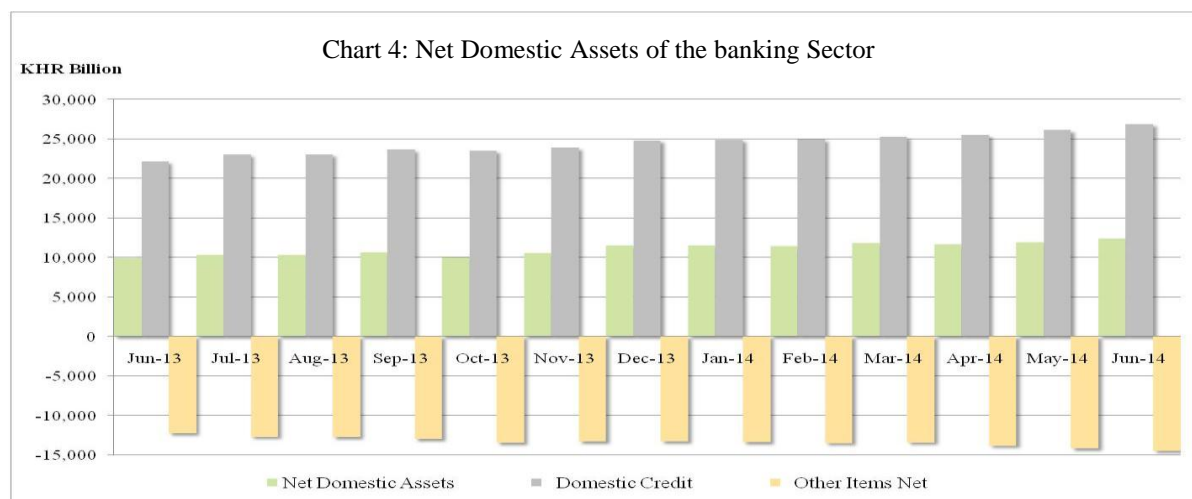
## Money Supply

Broad money (M2) in June 2014 continued to increase sharply by 4.9% following the increase of 1.5% in the preceding month. The contributors to this increase were: resident's foreign currency deposits (6.3%) and time and saving deposits (0.9%) while demand deposits and currency outside banks declined by 5.6% and 1.4%, respectively.



## Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

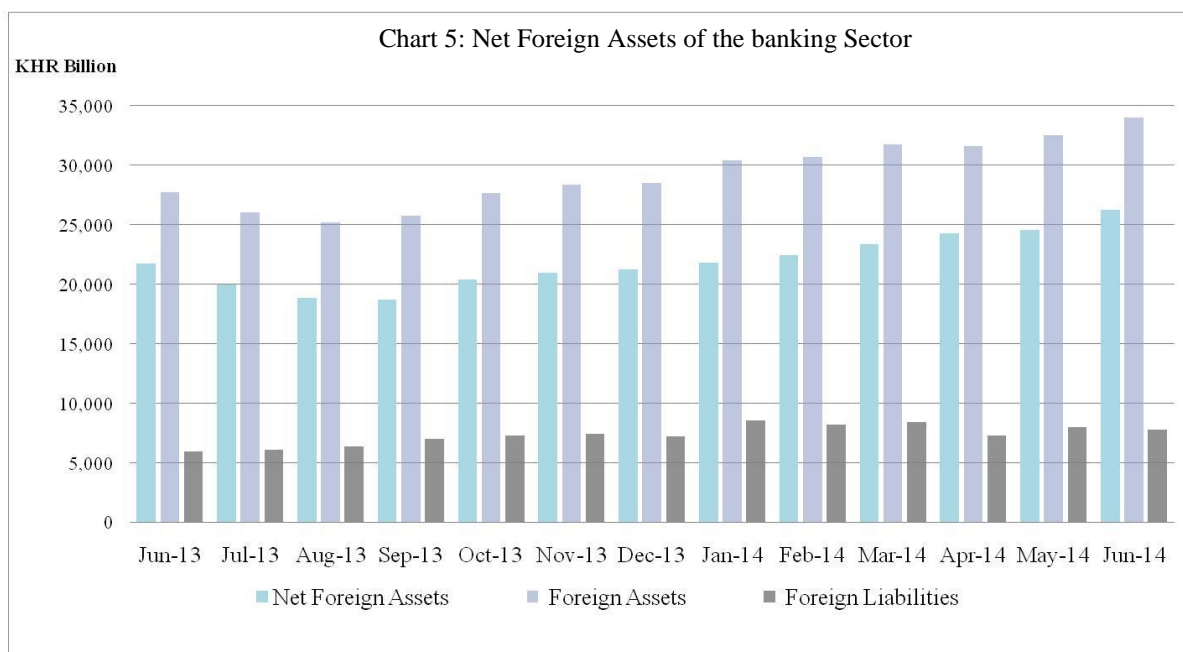
Net domestic assets of the banking sector continued to increase by 0.9%, due to an increase of 2.9% in domestic credit while other items net decreased 4.6%.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 2.9% in credit to private sector while credit to state enterprises and net claims on government declined by 33.8% and 3%, respectively.

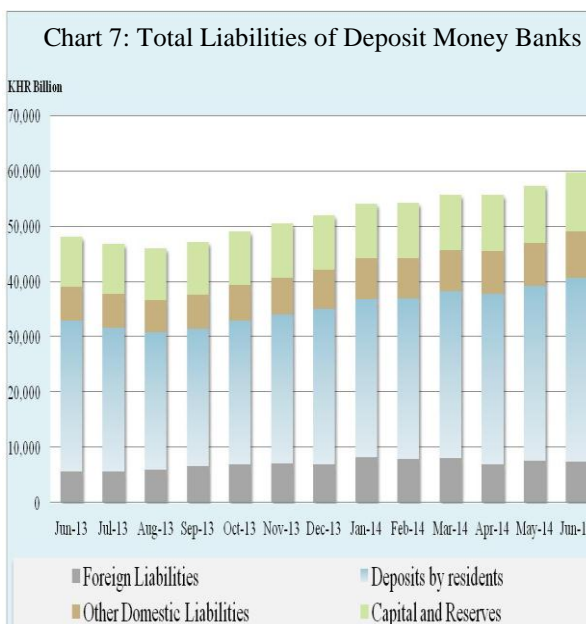
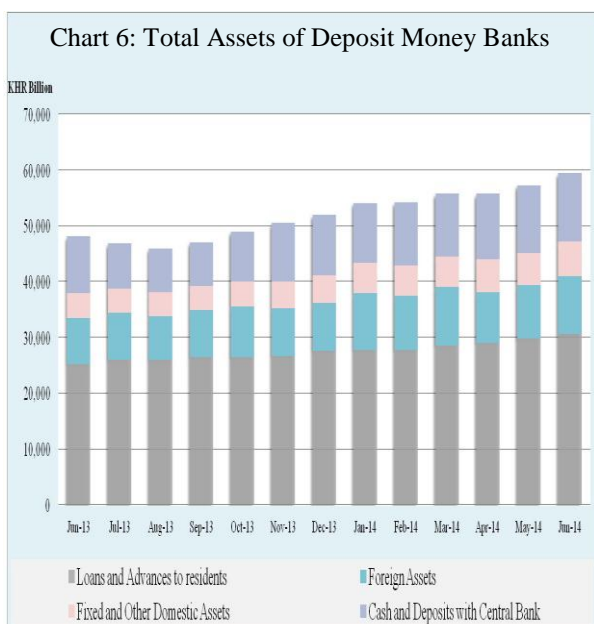
## Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector in June 2014 increased significantly 6.9% from 1.1% increase in May. This increase was mainly due to an increase of 4.5% in total foreign assets.



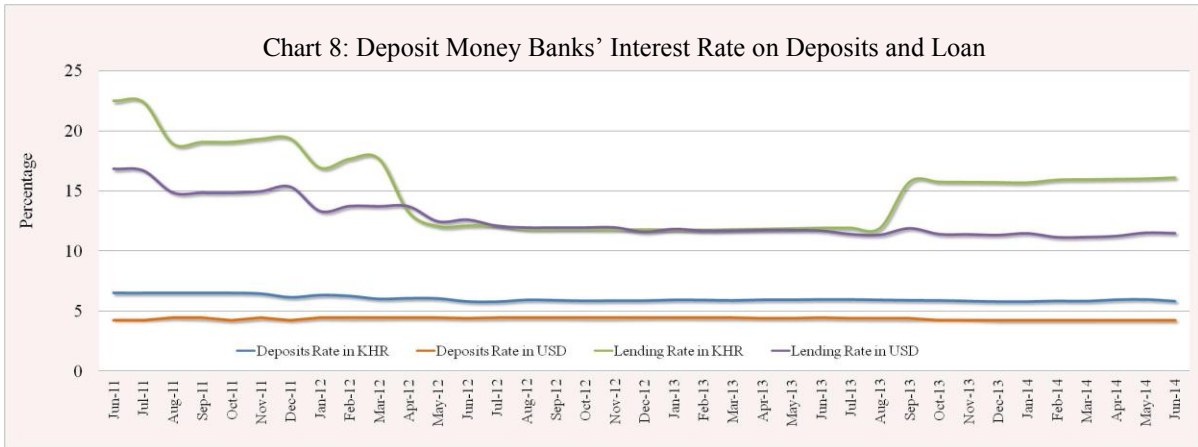
### Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks continued to increase sharply in June 2014, up by 4.3% after increasing 2.8% in the previous month.



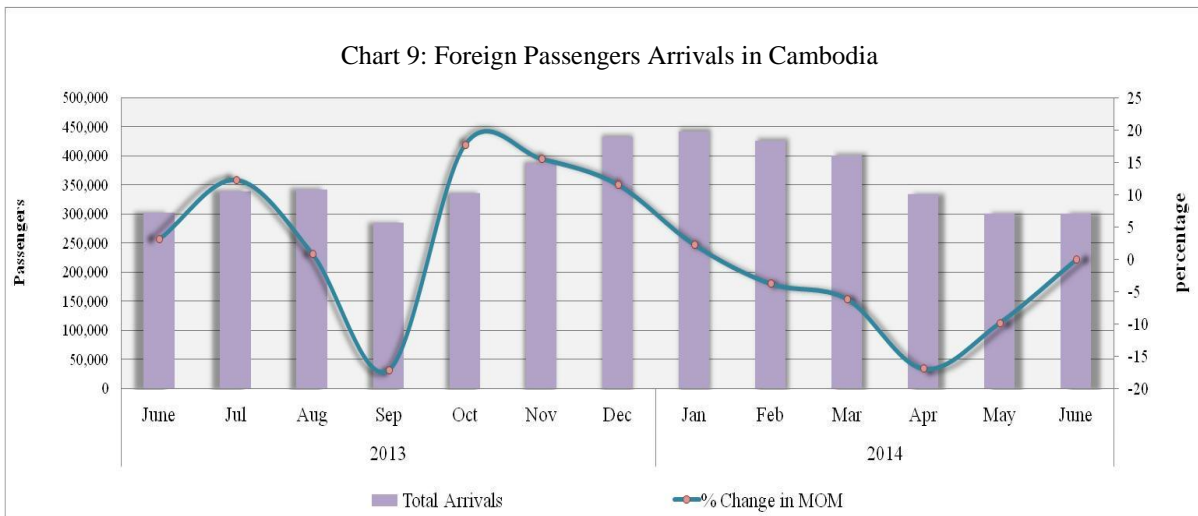
### Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In June 2014, the interest rate movement with a maturity of 12-month on loans and deposits showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR decreased by 0.15% while deposits in US Dollar remained stable. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR increased by 0.01% while lending rate in US dollar decreased by 0.04%.

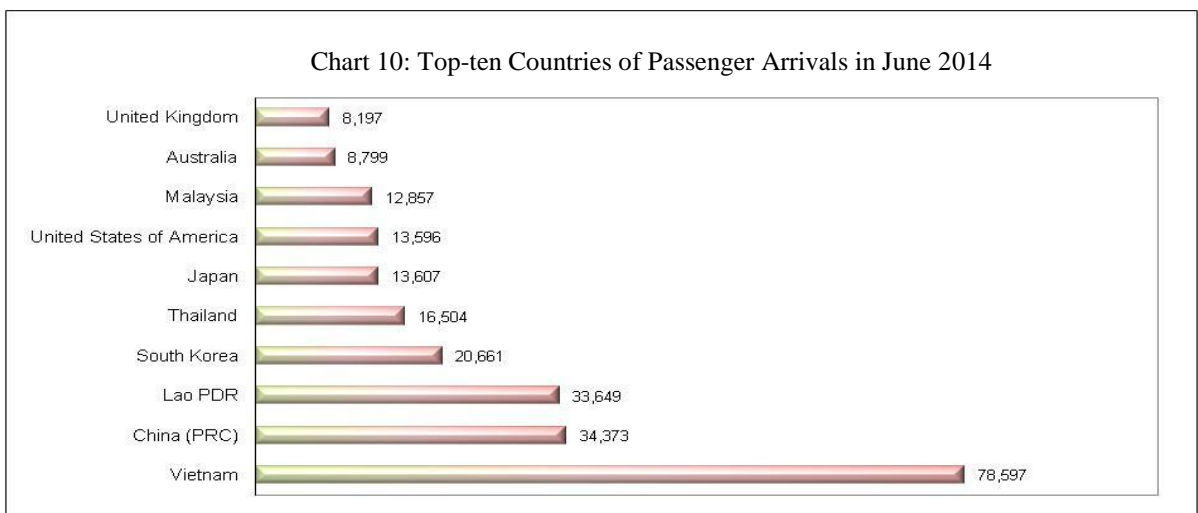


**Foreign Tourist Arrivals**

In June 2014, the total number of passenger arrivals increased slightly 0.1% after the decrease of 9.7% in a month earlier. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 94% of the total.

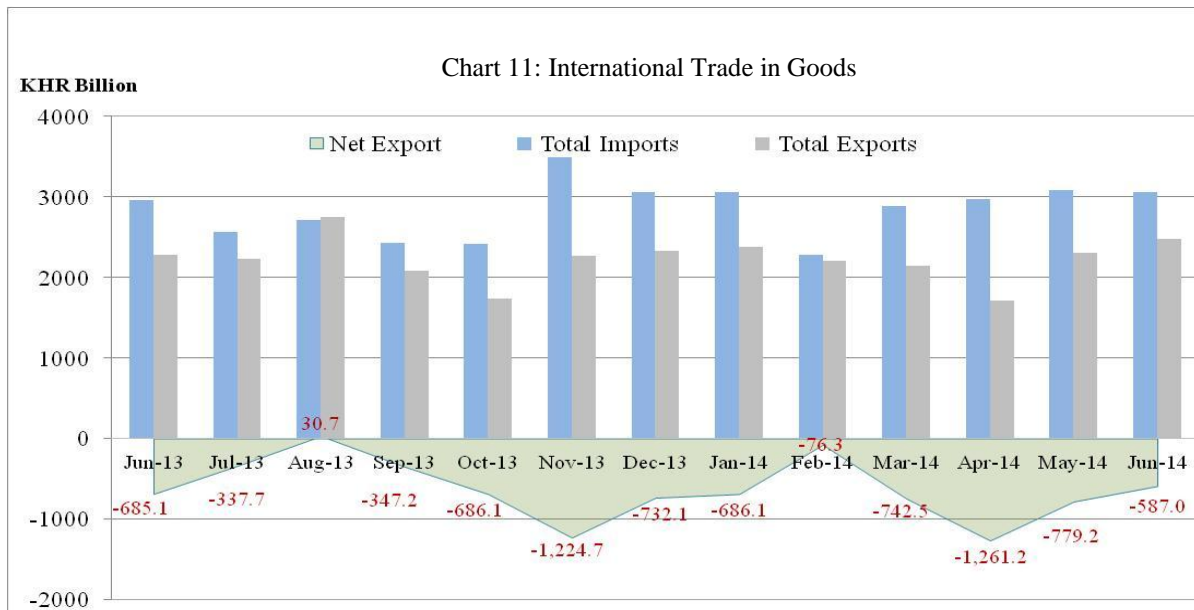


Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, China P.R.C., Lao PDR, South Korea, Thailand, and Japan.

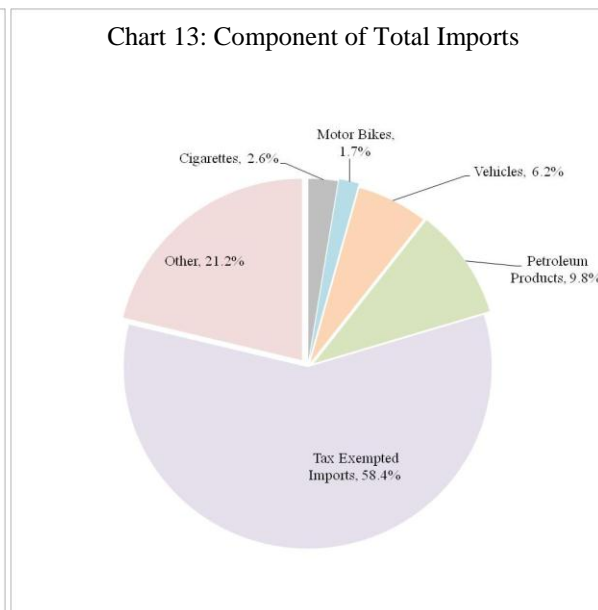
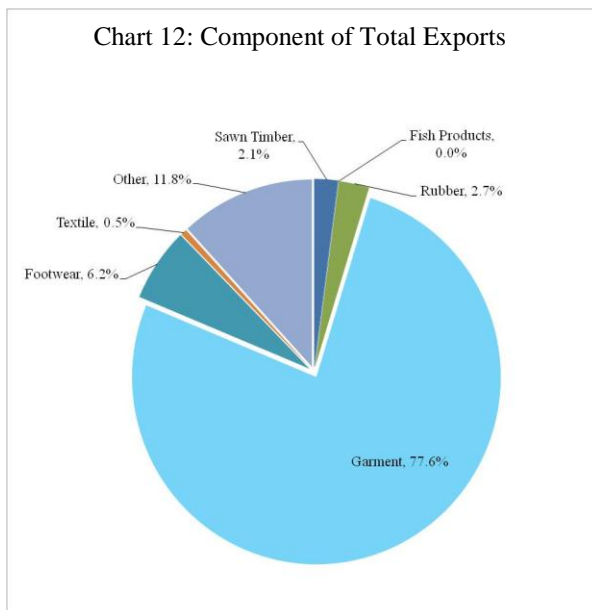


## International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 587 billion (19.2%) in June, from the deficit of KHR 779.2 billion (25.3%) in May 2014. This was mainly due to an increase in total exports.



The major components of total exports were: Garment, Footwear, Rubber, and Swan Timber and the major components of total imports were: Petroleum, Vehicles, Cigarettes, Motor Bikes, Cement, Construction Materials, Clothing, Steel, and Beer.

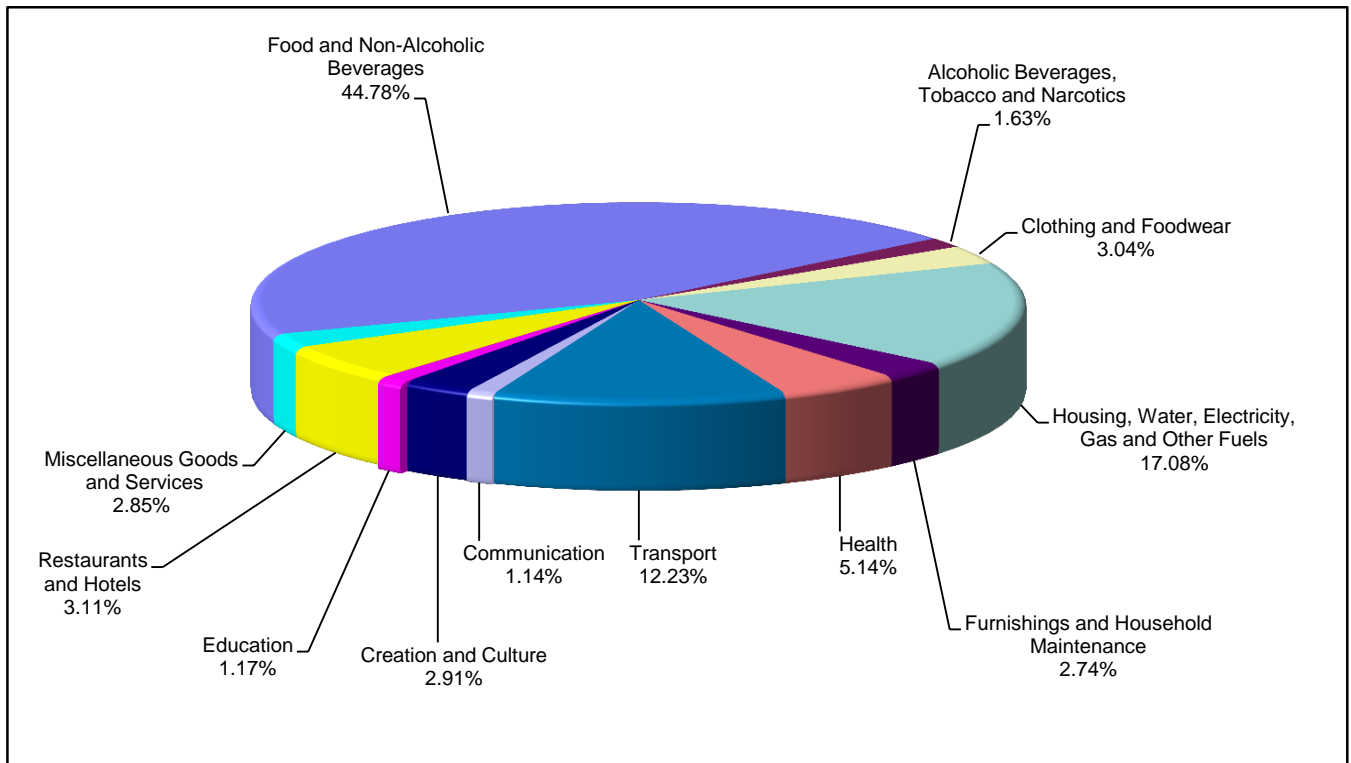

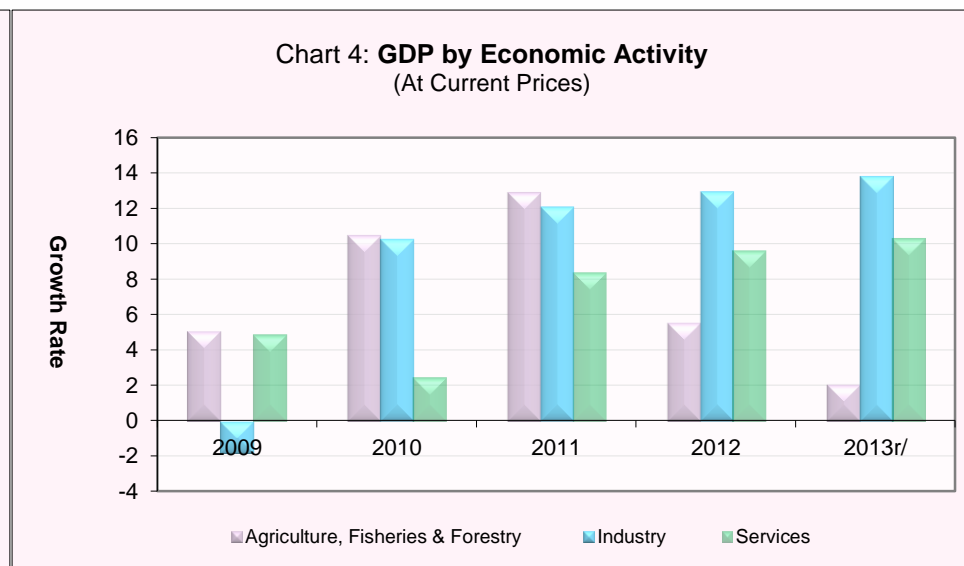
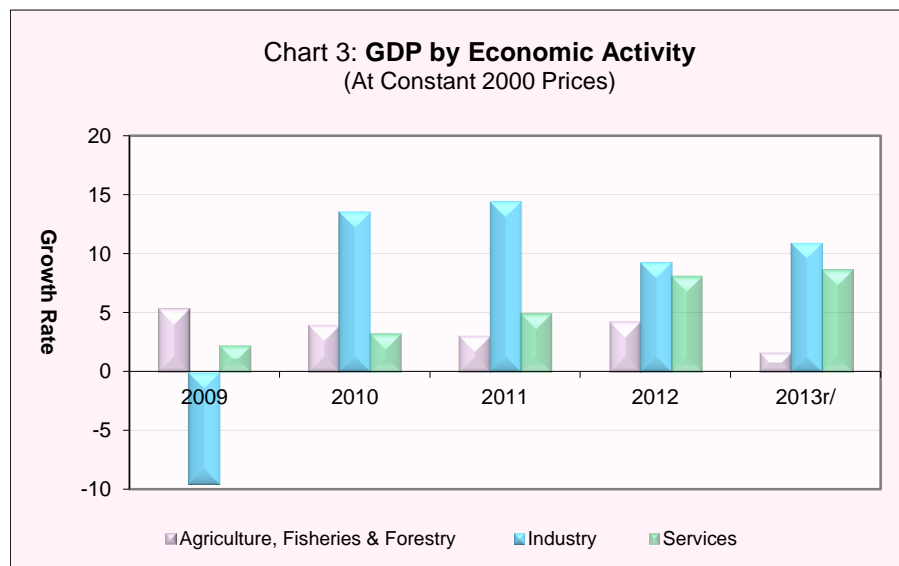
**Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket**

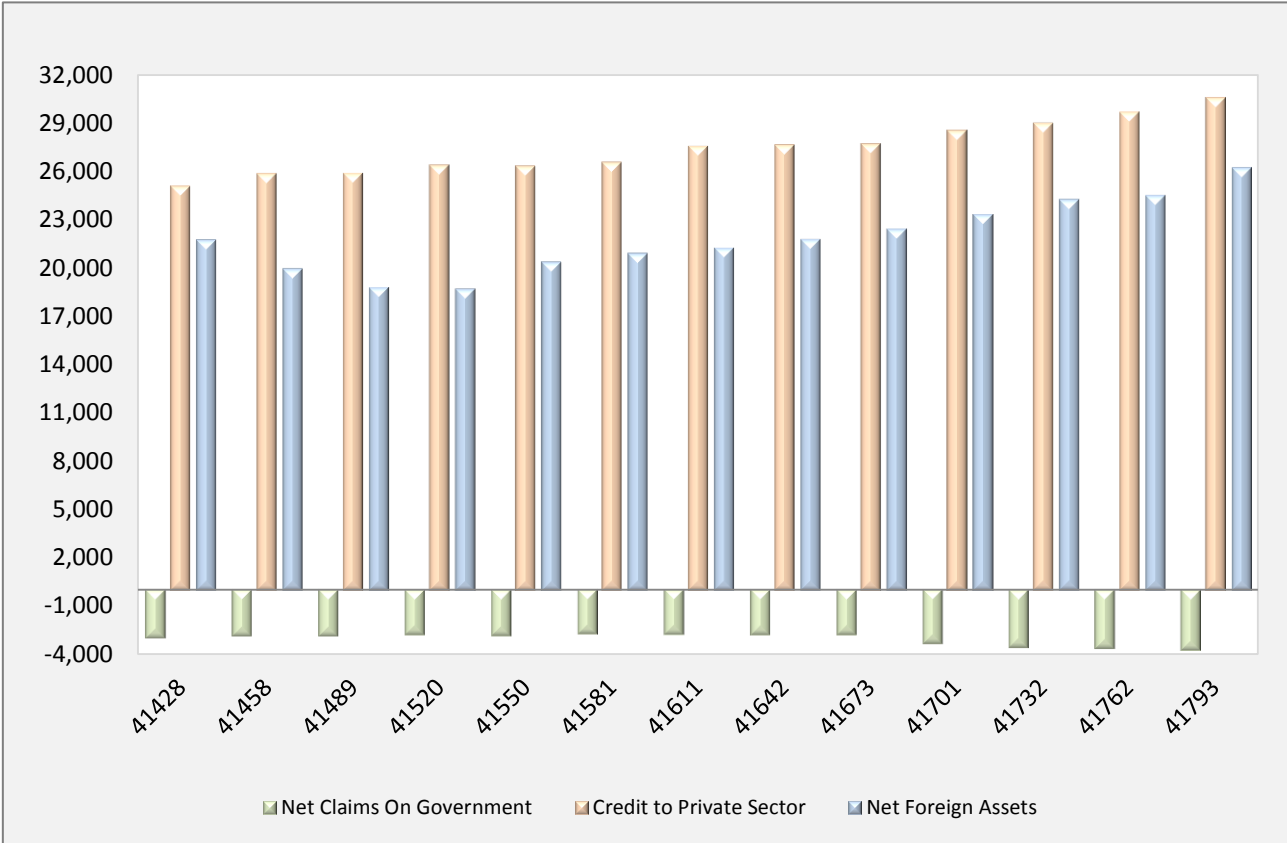

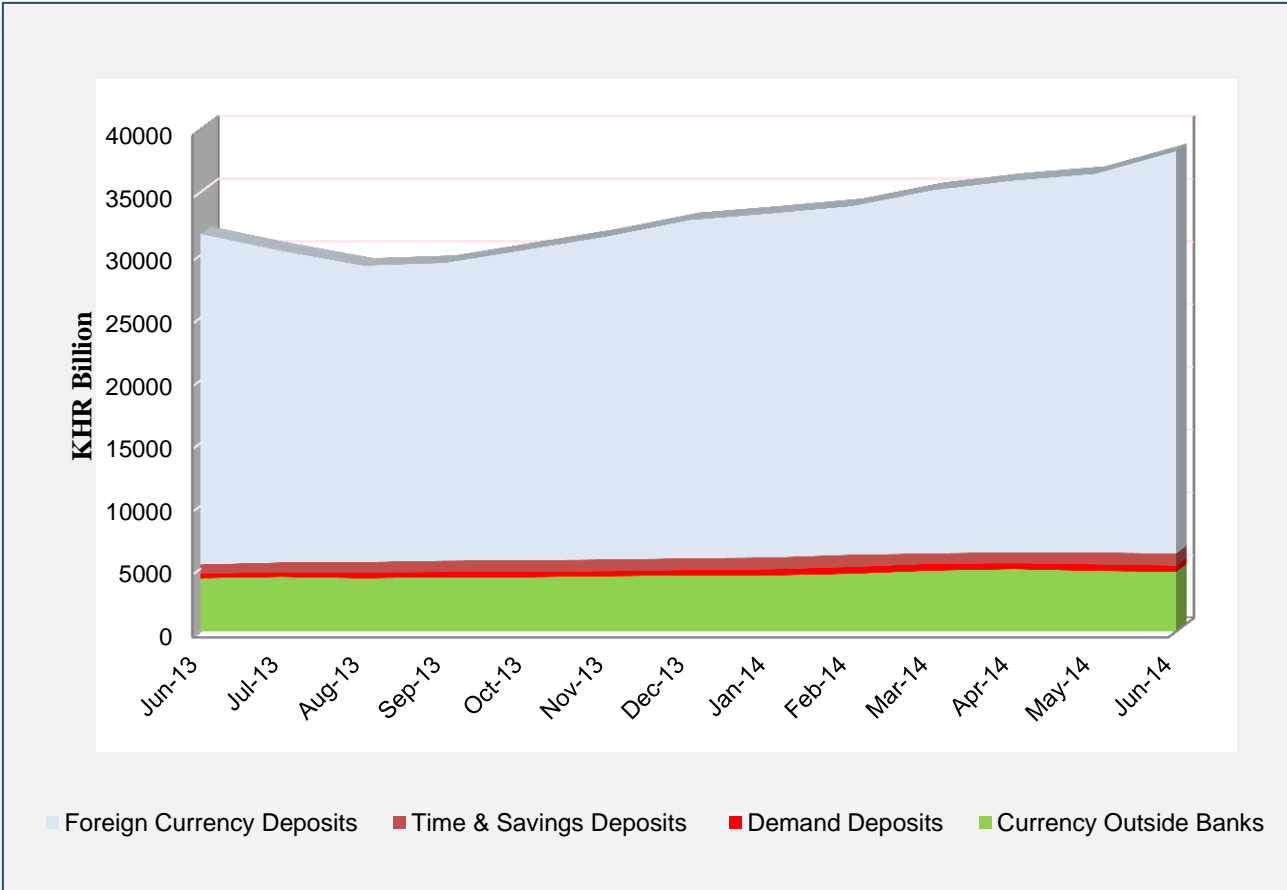

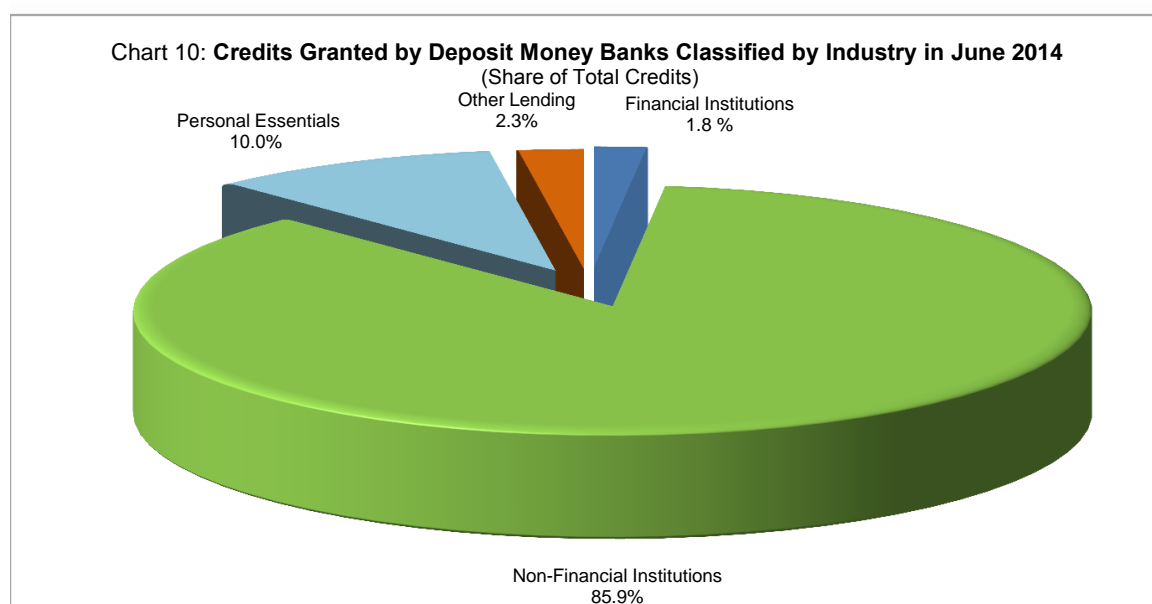

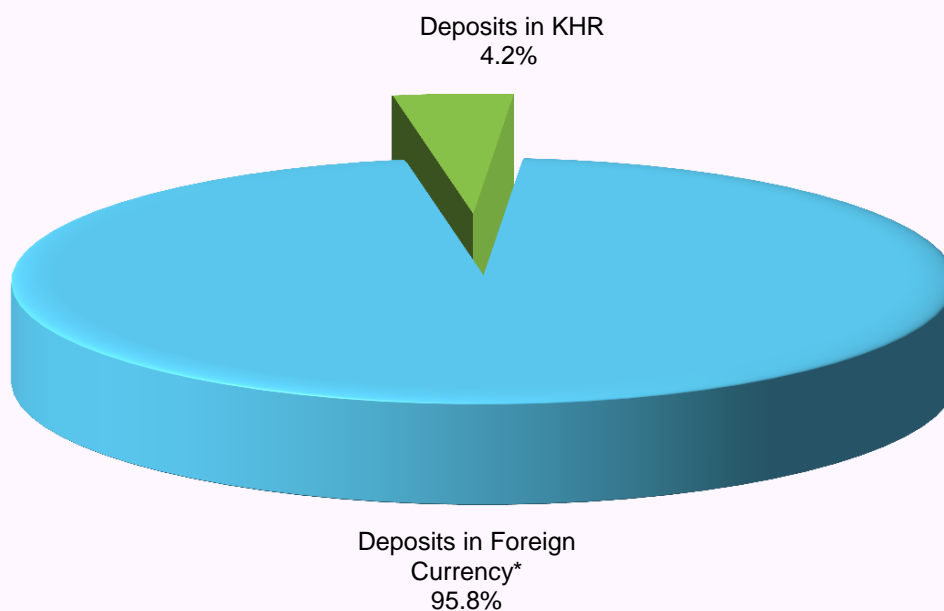

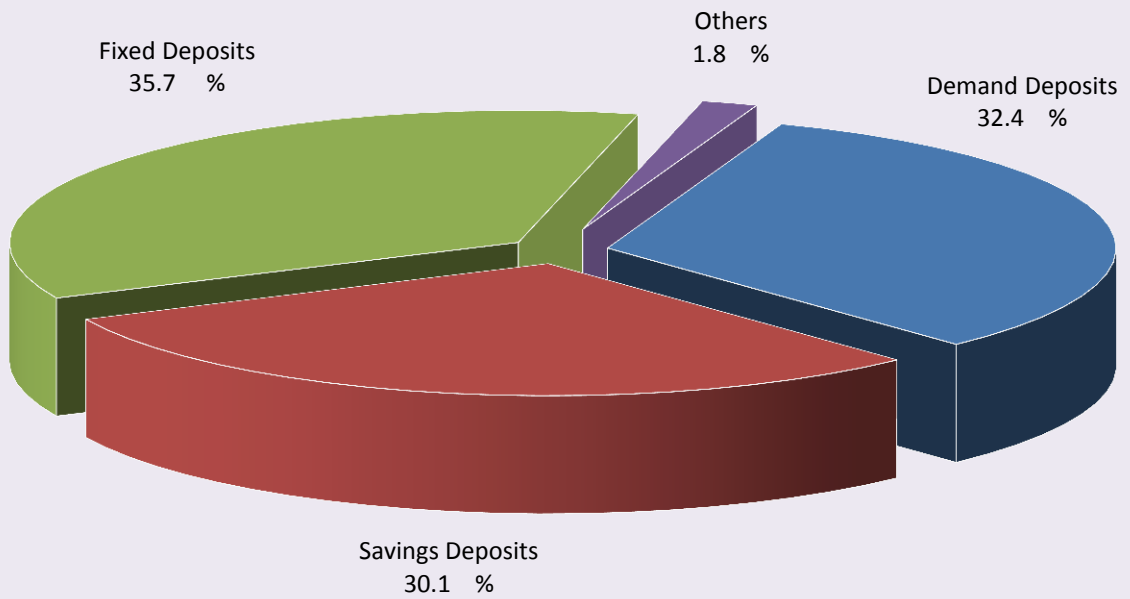
**Chart 11: Deposits with Deposit Money Banks Classified by Currency, as of June 2014**  
(Share of Grand Total Deposits)



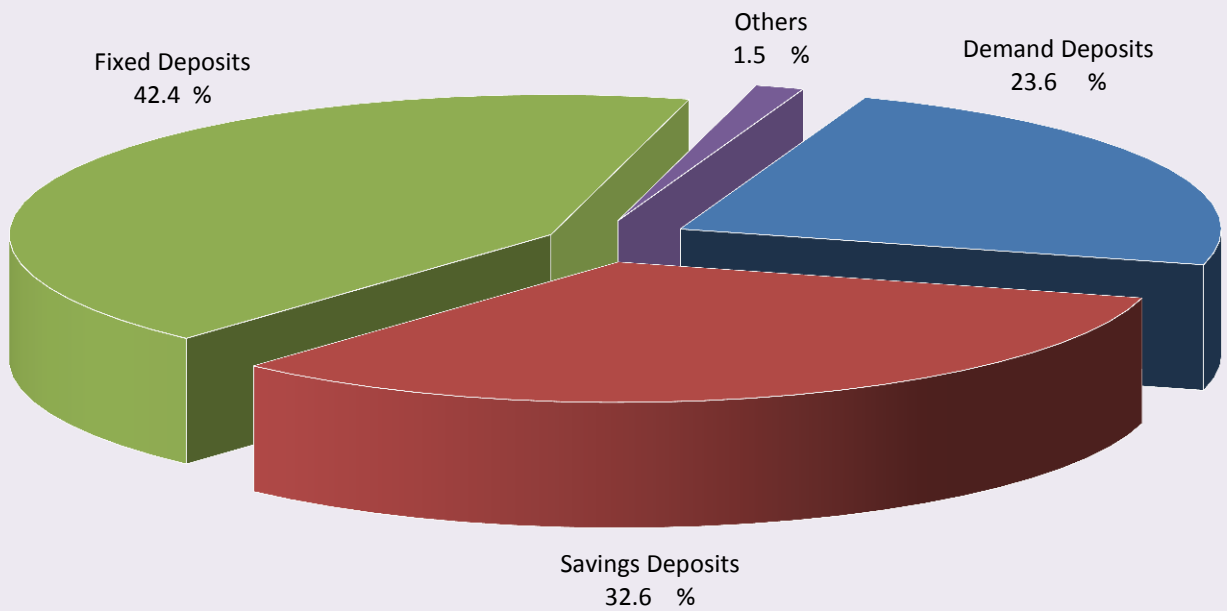
