Introduction

Consumer price inflation (month-on-month) declined moderately in October 2013, mainly due to the declines in the prices of transport services, clothing, and household appliances. At the same time, Cambodian riel (KHR) exchange rate against US dollar appreciated modestly and deposits by residents accelerated. Meanwhile, credit to private sector declined slightly. During the period, the International trade in goods showed an increase in deficit.

Consumer Price Index

Consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) eased to 0.23% in October 2013 from 0.69% in September 2013 reflecting an increase in consumer price index (CPI), from 154.92 in September 2013 to 155.27 in October 2013.

During the period, seven group indexes decreased, four group indexes increased, and other one group index remained stable. The group indexes showing the decreases in the month were: Furnishings and Household Maintenance (0.97%); Communication (0.94%); Clothing and Footwear (0.50%); Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics (0.36%); Transport (0.19%); Miscellaneous Goods and Services (0.19%) and Recreation and Culture (0.16%).

The group indexes increasing during the month were: Restaurants (1.18%); Health (0.61%); Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (0.35%) and Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages (0.26%) while Education group index remained unchanged.

The decrease in Transport group index was mainly due to the decreases in the prices of Transport services (0.7%), Spare parts and accessories for personal transport equipment (0.6%), Motor cars (0.3%), and Motor cycles (0.2%). The increase in Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages resulted from the increases of 0.3% in the index for food sub-group and 0.1% in the index for Non-Alcoholic Beverages sub-group. The increase in food sub-group index mainly resulted from the increases in the prices of Sugar, Jam, Honey, Chocolate and Confectionery (1.3%); Fish and Seafood (0.6%); Pork (0.6%); Rice (0.4%); Vegetables (0.2%); Chicken (0.2%); and Duck (0.2%). The increase in Non-Alcoholic Beverages sub-group was due to an increase of 0.2% in the price of Coffee, Tea and Cocoa while the price of Mineral waters, Soft drinks, Fruits and Vegetable juices remained stable.

Based on year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items, headline inflation accelerated to 4.2% in October 2013 from 3.7% in September 2013, mainly due to the increases in the prices of food, health, and clothing.

Exchange Rate

The value of KHR against the US dollar appreciated significantly in October 2013. The market buying rate decreased from KHR 4,067 per US dollar at the end of September 2013 to KHR 4,031 per US dollar at the end of October 2013, an appreciation of 0.89% compared to the appreciation of 0.61% in September 2013.

During the month, daily market buying rate varied between KHR 4,031 and KHR 4,065 per US dollar. As shown in Chart 7, the value of KHR was fixed with a rate of KHR 4,062 per US dollar for the first two days of the month. After that, the KHR depreciated to treat on a

rate of KHR 4,072 per US dollar from the third to the eleventh. Later on, the KHR depreciated slightly to trade on a rate of KHR 4,073 per US dollar from the twelfth to the twenty second. And then, the KHR appreciated consecutively from KHR 4,067 per US dollar on the twenty third to KHR 4,031 per US dollar at the end of the month. This was mainly due to the increase in the demand for KHR for tax payment purpose and for national festivals.

Money Supply

In October 2013, broad money (M2) increased at a faster rate compared to the previous month, up by KHR 1,056.8 billion (3.6%) following an increase of KHR 216.7 billion (0.7%) in September 2013, from KHR 29,355.5 billion in September to KHR 30,412.3 billion in October 2013. The increase resulted from the increases of KHR 1,019.4 billion (4.3%) in residents' foreign currency deposits, KHR 23.9 billion (6%) in demand deposits, and KHR 23.6 billion (2.6%) in time and saving deposits while currency outside banks decreased by KHR 10.2 billion (0.2%).

Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

Net domestic assets of the banking sector decreased moderately in October 2013 following an increase in the previous month, down by KHR 614.7 billion (5.8%) after increasing KHR 325.4 billion (3.2%) in September 2013. This was due to a decrease of KHR 486.4 billion (3.7%) in other items net and KHR 128.3 billion (0.5%) in domestic credit. The decrease in other items net was mirrored by a decrease of KHR 410.2 billion (594.2%) in other items contributed by an increase of KHR 91.4 billion (0.7%) in capital and reserves and partly offset by a decrease of KHR 15.3 billion (1.9%) in restricted deposits.

The decrease in domestic credit was reflected by the decrease of KHR 65.9 billion (0.2%) in credit to private sector and KHR 62.6 billion (2.2%) in net claims on government while credit to state enterprises increased by KHR 0.1 billion (1.7%). The decrease in net claims on government was entirely due to an increase of KHR 62.6 billion (2%) in government deposits while claims on government remained unchanged.

Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector increased significantly after decreasing in the four consecutive months, up by KHR 1,671.4 billion (8.9%) in October 2013 after decreasing KHR 108.7 billion (0.6%) in September 2013. This was due to an increase of KHR 1,919.3 billion (7.5%) in total foreign assets while total foreign liabilities increased only by KHR 247.8 billion (3.5%). The increase in total foreign assets resulted from the increases of KHR 1,176.1 billion (6.8%) in foreign assets of the National Bank of Cambodia and KHR 743.2 billion (8.8%) in foreign assets of commercial banks. The increase in total foreign liabilities resulted from an increase of KHR 249 billion (3.8%) in foreign liabilities of commercial banks while foreign liabilities of the National Bank of Cambodia declined by KHR 1.2 billion (0.3%).

Deposit Money Banks' Operations

As shown in Table 12, total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks continued to increase sharply from KHR 47,076.8 billion in September 2013 to KHR 49,029.1 billion in October 2013, up by KHR 1,952.3 billion (4.1%) after increasing KHR 1,092 billion (2.4%) in September 2013. This increase was due to an increase of KHR 1,148.8 billion (14.7%) in cash and deposits with the central bank, KHR 743.2 billion (8.8%) in foreign assets, and KHR 126 billion (2.9%) in fixed and other domestic assets while loans and advances to residents decreased by KHR 65.8 billion (0.2%). The decrease in loans and advances to residents was due to a decrease of KHR 65.9 billion (0.2%) in credit to private sector while credit to nonfinancial public enterprises increased by KHR 0.1 billion (1.7%).

The total liabilities of all banks in the month picked up reflected by an increase of KHR 1,067.7 billion (4.3%) in deposits by residents, KHR 556 billion (9.3%) in domestic liabilities, KHR 249.1 billion (3.8%) in foreign liabilities, and KHR 79.5 billion (0.8%) in capital and reserves. The increase in deposits by residents resulted from the increases of KHR 1,019.4 billion (4.3%) in foreign currency deposits, KHR 24.8 billion (8.3%) in demand deposits, and KHR 23.6 billion (2.6%) in time and saving deposits.

Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In October 2013, the interest rate movement with a maturity of 12-month on loans and deposits showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR decreased by 0.01% from 5.91% in September 2013 to 5.90% in October 2013 and for the same rate of deposit in US dollar also decreased by 0.01% from 4.38% in September 2013 to 4.37% in October 2013.

During the period, the weighted average lending rate in KHR decreased by 0.03% from 11.93% in September 2013 to 11.90% in October 2013 and the same rate for lending in US dollar decreased by 0.07% from 11.30% in September 2013 to 11.23% in October 2013.

The banks' interest rate spread between loan and deposit rates in KHR narrowed from 6.02% in September 2013 to 6% in October 2013, and the spread in US dollar narrowed from 6.92% in September 2013 to 6.86% in October 2013.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals

The number of foreign passenger arrivals in Cambodia increased moderately in October 2013 after decreasing in the previous month. The total number of passenger arrivals increased from 283,787 persons in September 2013 to 334,410 persons in October 2013, up by 50,623 persons (17.8%) after decreasing 58,277 persons (17%) in a month earlier. The increase in the number of passenger arrivals was categorised as follows: passenger arrivals by land, up by 21,989 persons (14.7%); passenger arrivals by water, up by 2,032 persons (39.7%); passenger arrivals by air at Siem Reap International Airport, up by 17,632 persons (25%); and passenger arrivals by air at Phnom Penh International Airport, up by 8,970 persons (15.2%). The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation

accounting for 94% of the total. Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam (20.2%), China P.R.C. (11%), Lao PDR (10.9%), and South Korea (8.9%) followed by Thailand (6.6%), Japan (4.4%), the United States of America (4.2%), Malaysia (3.6%), Australia (3.3%), and the Philippines (3.2%).

International Trade in Goods

In October 2013, the international trade in goods showed an increase in deficit of KHR 686.2 billion (28.4%) following the deficit of KHR 347.2 billion (14.3%) in September 2013.

Total exports (fob) continued to decrease by KHR 347.5 billion (16.7%) in October 2013 following the decrease of KHR 667.3 billion (24.3%) in September 2013, from KHR 2,080.9 billion in September 2013 to KHR 1,733.4 billion in October 2013. The decrease was mainly due to the decreases in the exports of Garment (KHR 292.1 billion or 16.8%), Rubber (KHR 24 billion or 41.8%), Footwear (KHR 10.2 billion or 11.2%), Textile (KHR 4.8 billion or 54.3%), and Swan Timber (KHR 1.6 billion or 6.8%) while exports of Fish products increased by KHR 0.1 billion (43.3%).

Total imports (fob) declined slightly in October 2013, down by KHR 8.5 billion (0.4%) following the decrease of KHR 289.5 billion (10.7%) in September 2013, mainly due to the decreases in imports of Vehicles (KHR 11.6 billion or 8.5%), Petroleum products (KHR 10.6 billion or 3.8%), Cement (KHR 7.8 billion or 47.8%), Construction Material (KHR 4.3 billion or 24.3%), Clothing (KHR 2 billion or 12.8%), and Steel (KHR 2 billion or 12.9%), while imports of Cigarettes, Motor Bikes, and Sugar increased by KHR 24.4 billion (51.9%), KHR 14.7 billion (58.3%), and KHR 4 billion (102.9%), respectively. In the meantime, imports of other commodities changed slightly.

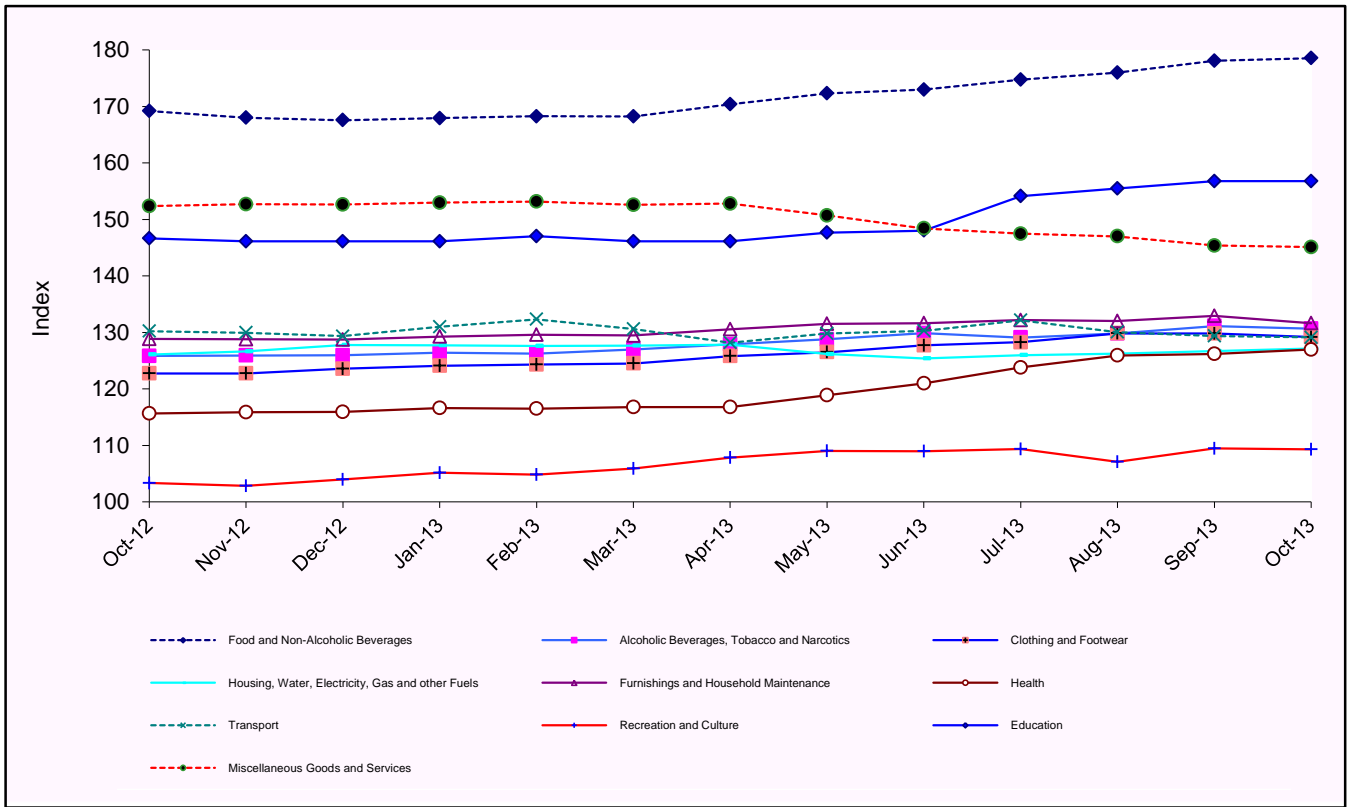

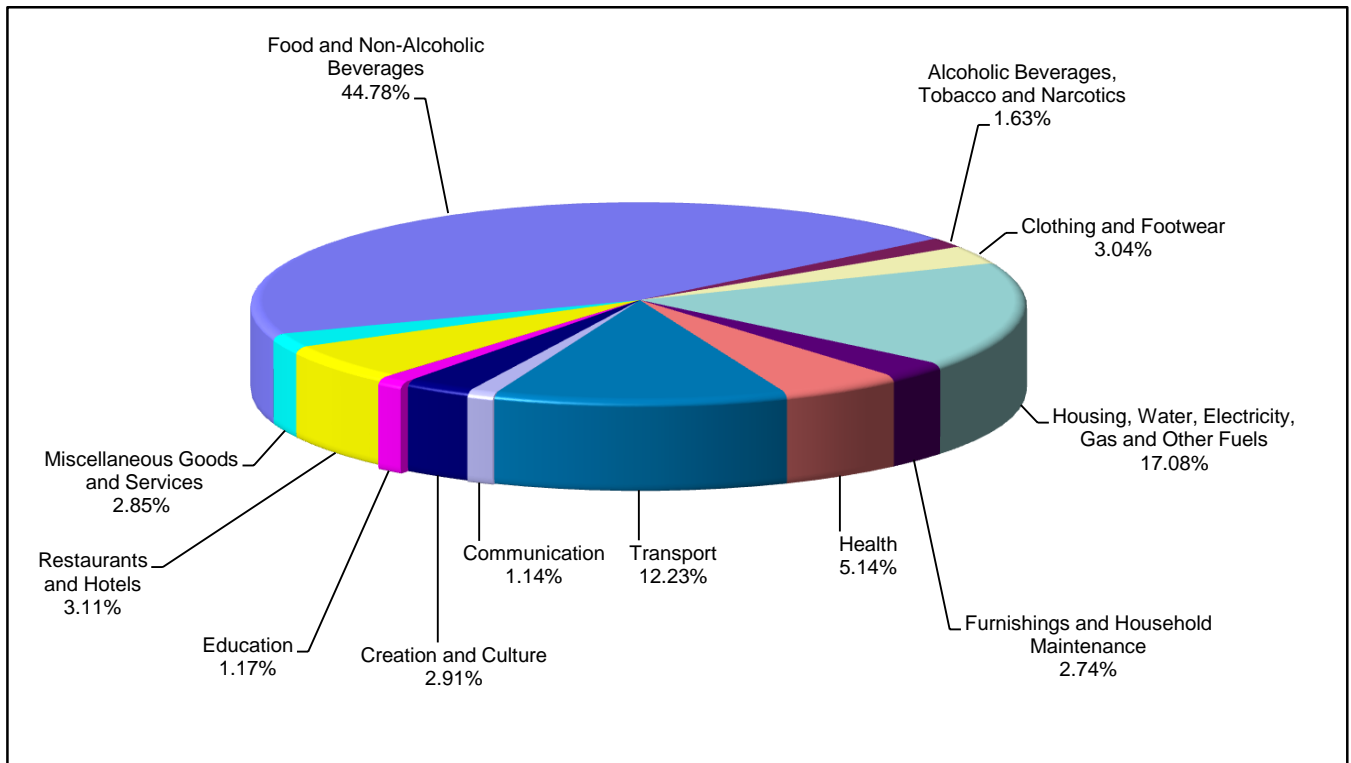

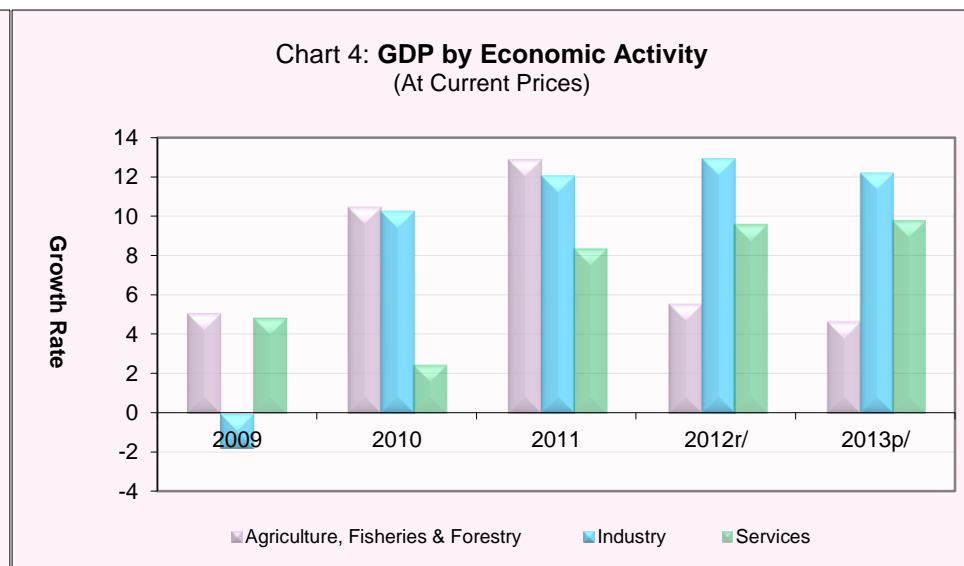
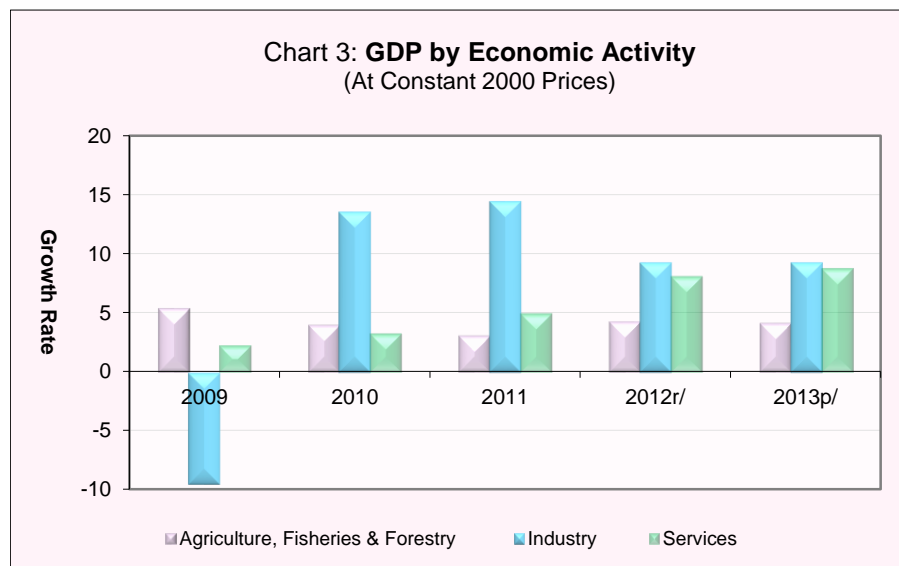
Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket

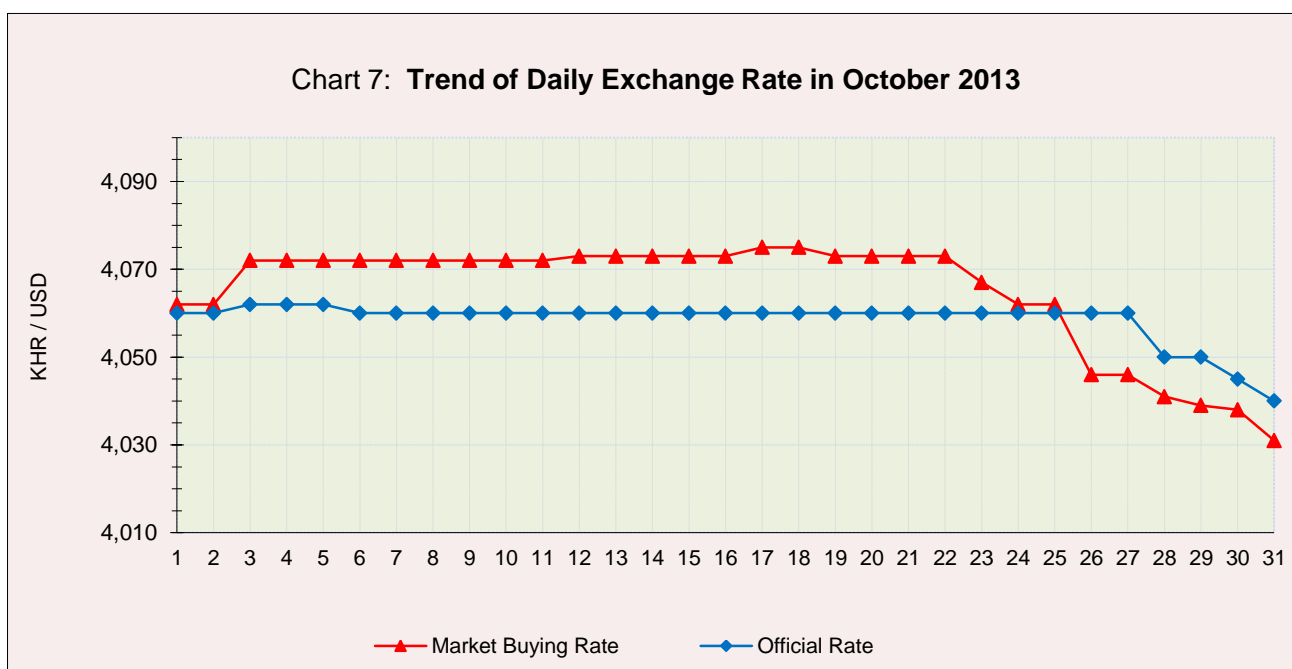

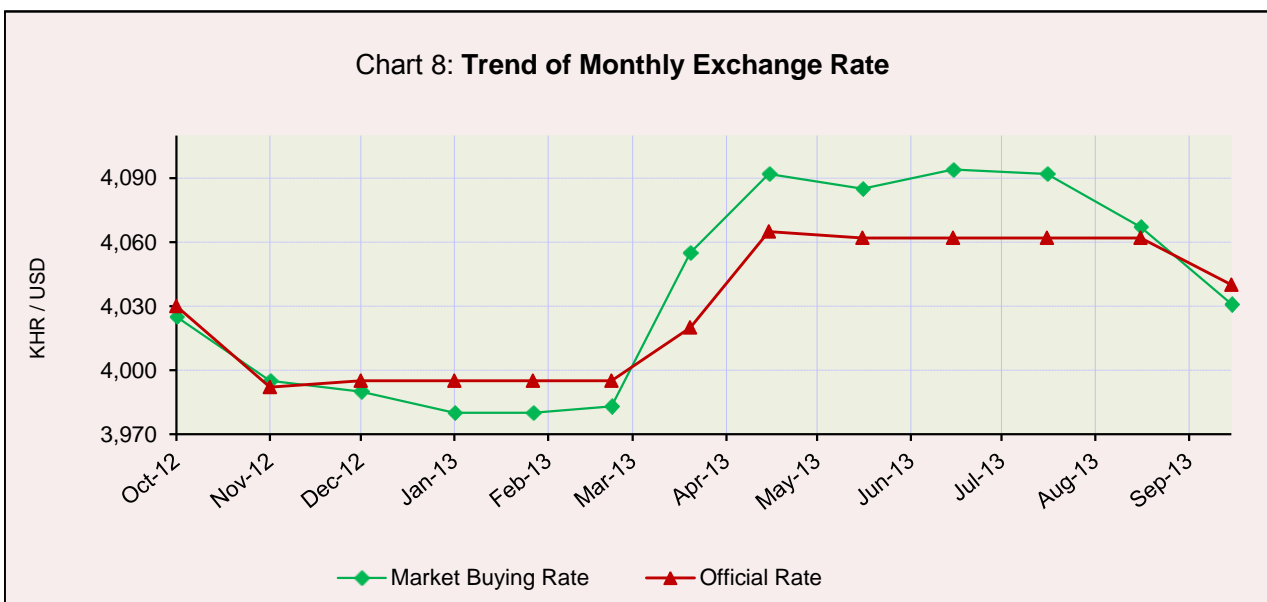

Chart 9: Monetary Survey

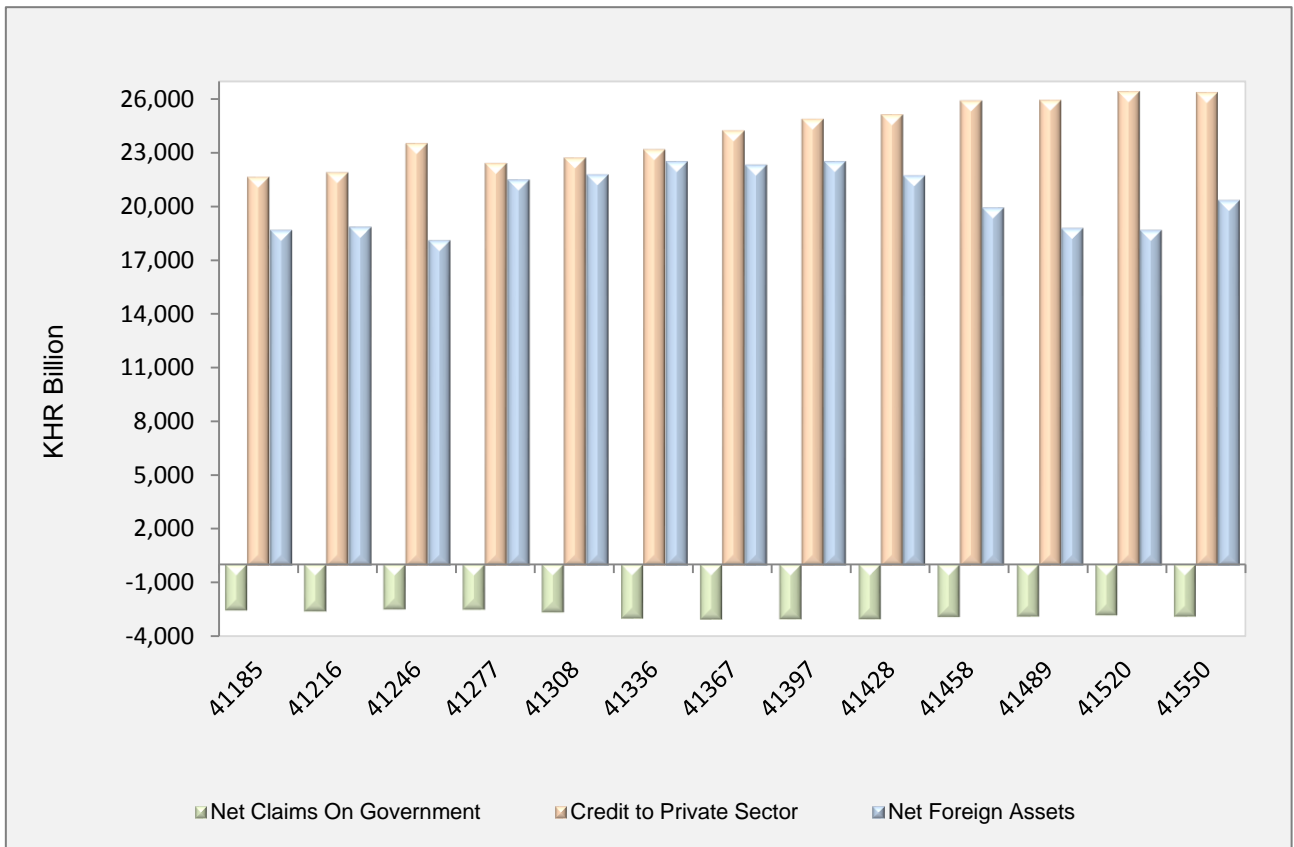


Chart 10: Components of Money Supply

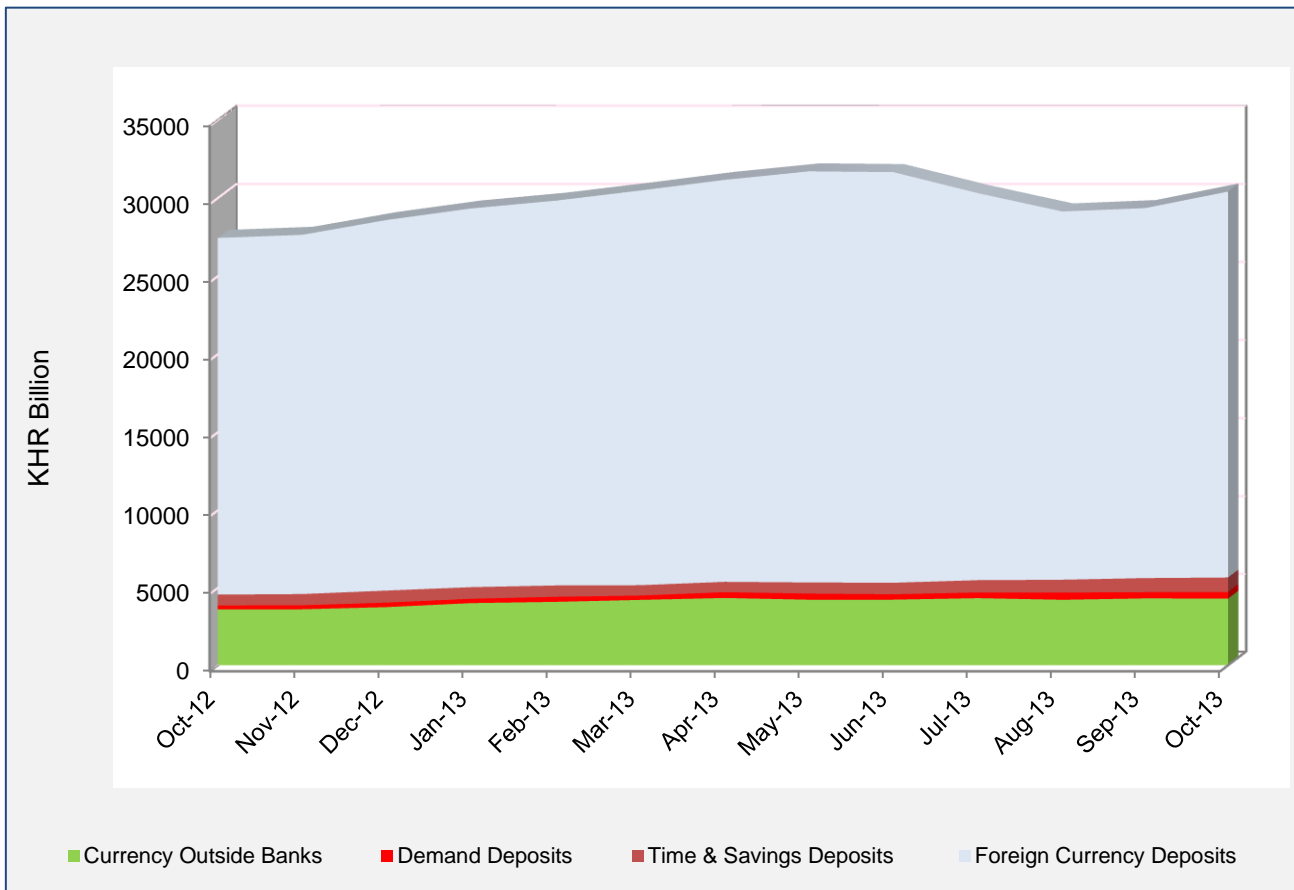

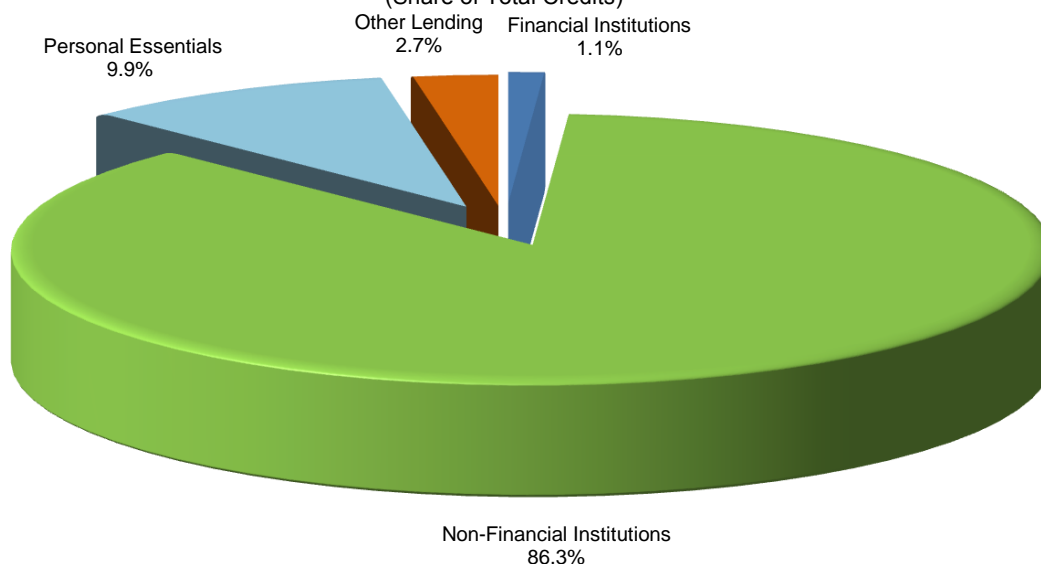

(Share of Grand Total Deposits)

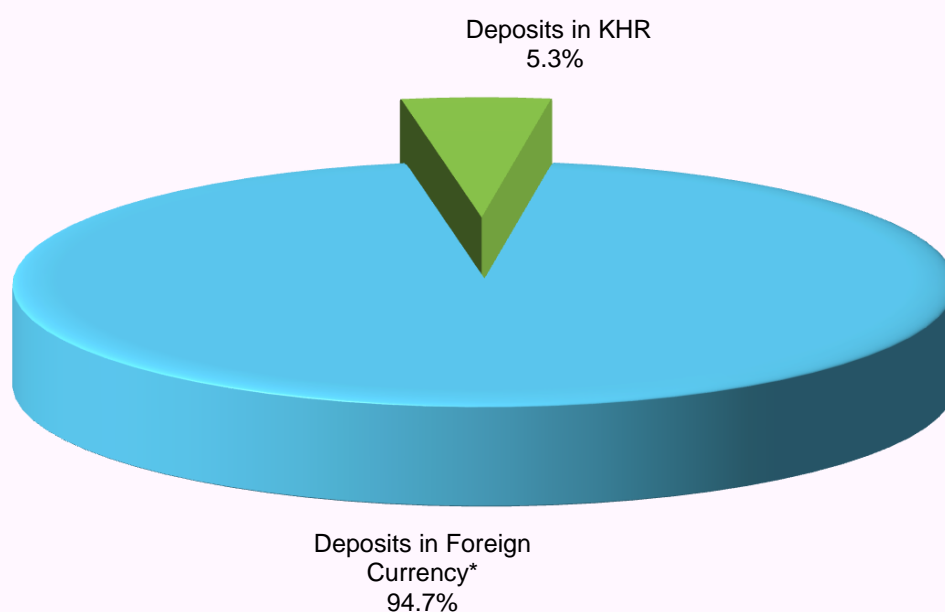

(Share of Total KHR Deposits)

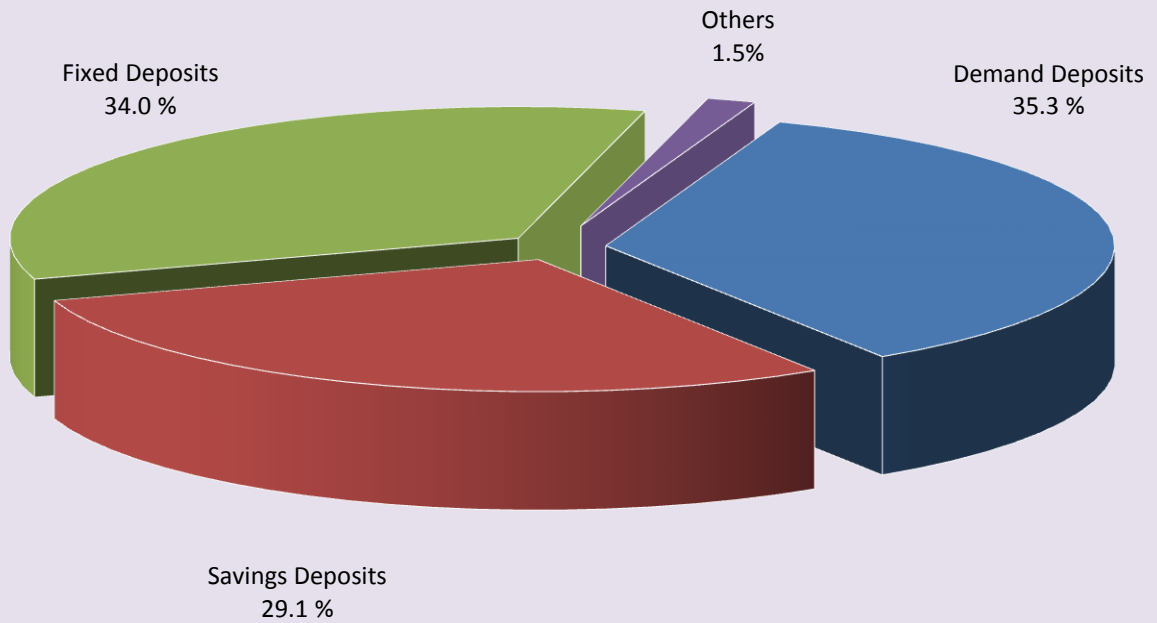
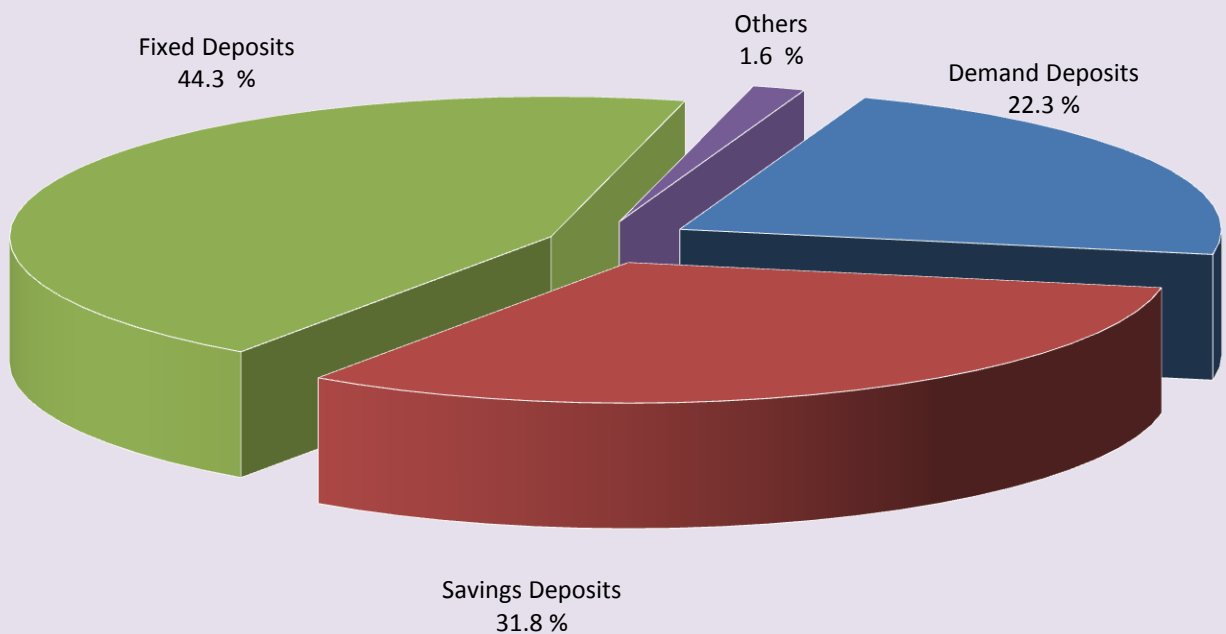


Chart 14: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of October 2013

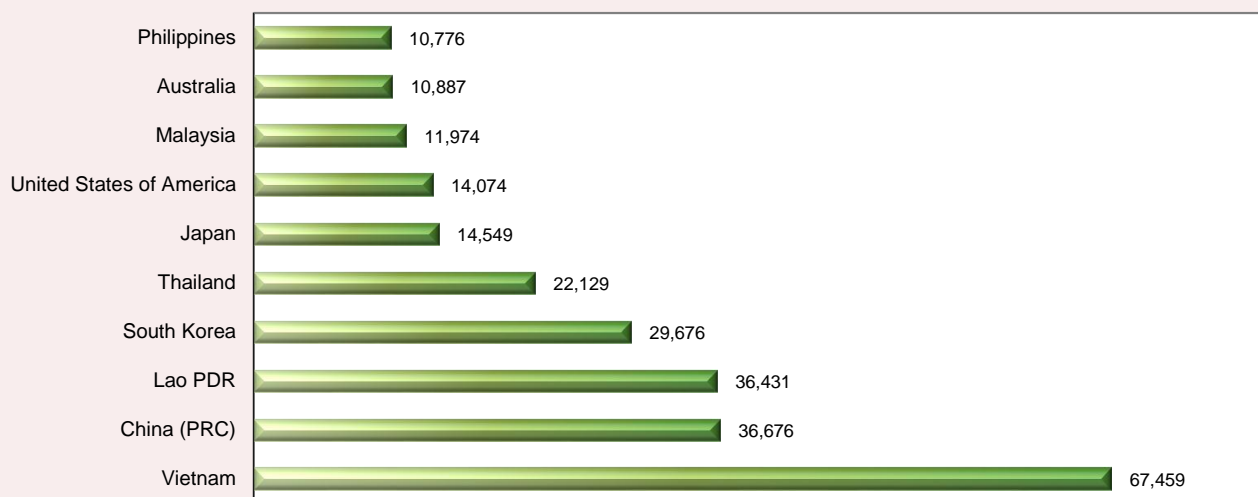
