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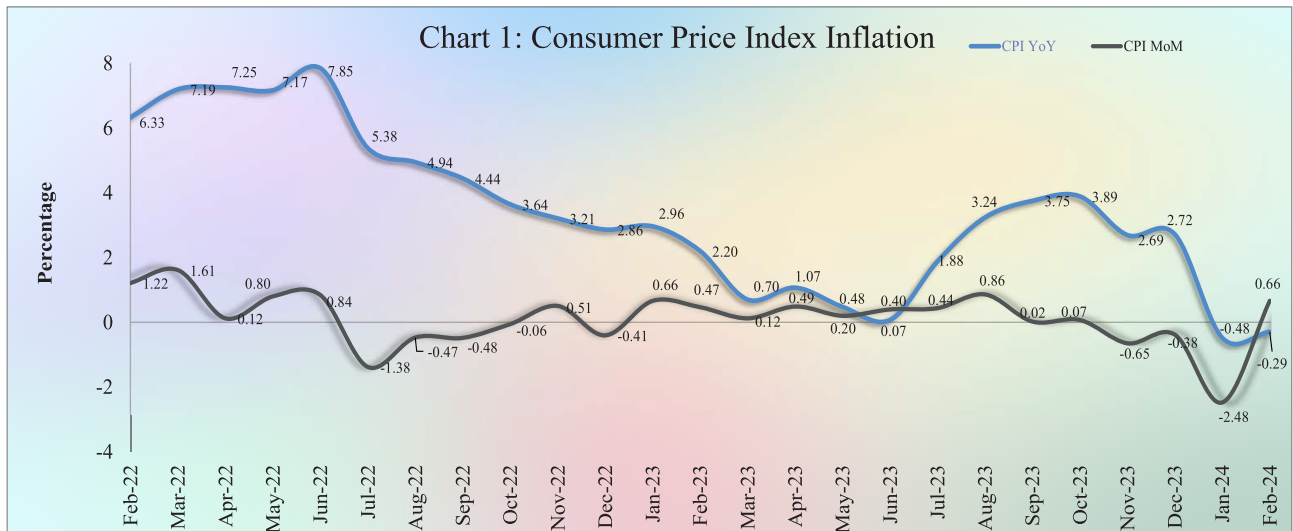
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## Introduction

Overall consumer price inflation in February 2024 accelerated over the previous month, whereas the Khmer riel (KHR) appreciated against US dollar. During this period, residents' deposits in the banking sector continued to increase, while credit to private sector decreased slightly. In the meantime, international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

## Consumer Price Index

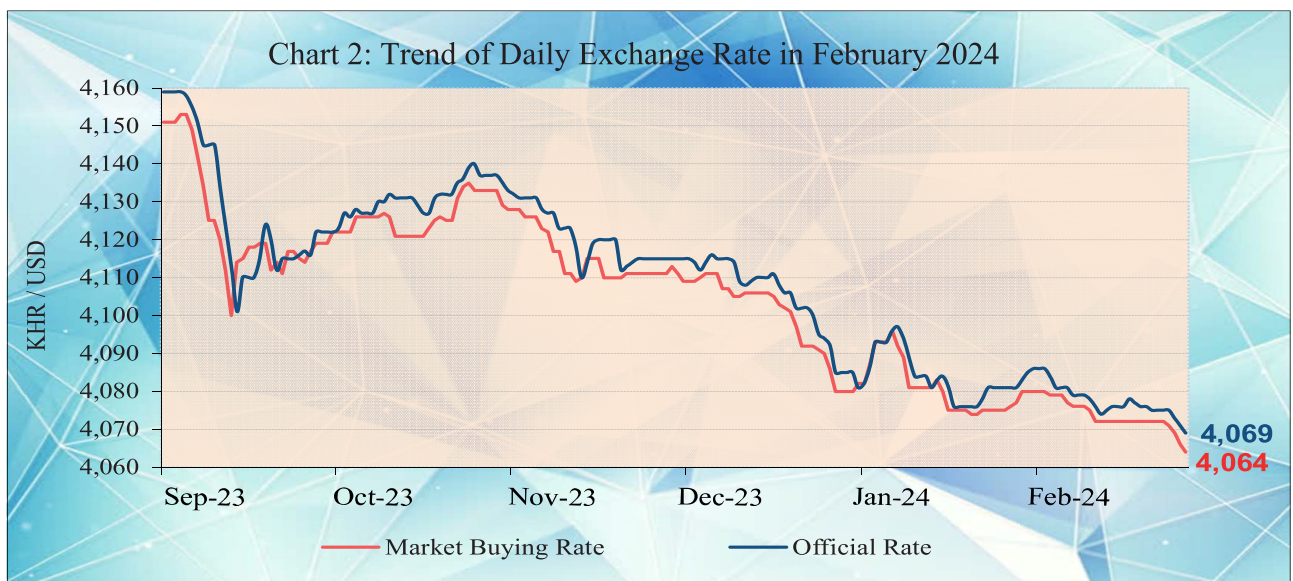
The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) increased to 0.66% in February 2024 from the negative level of -2.48% in January, in which all group indexes increased.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items continued to decline to the negative level of -0.3% from -0.5% in January, which was mainly due to the decrease in food and oil prices.

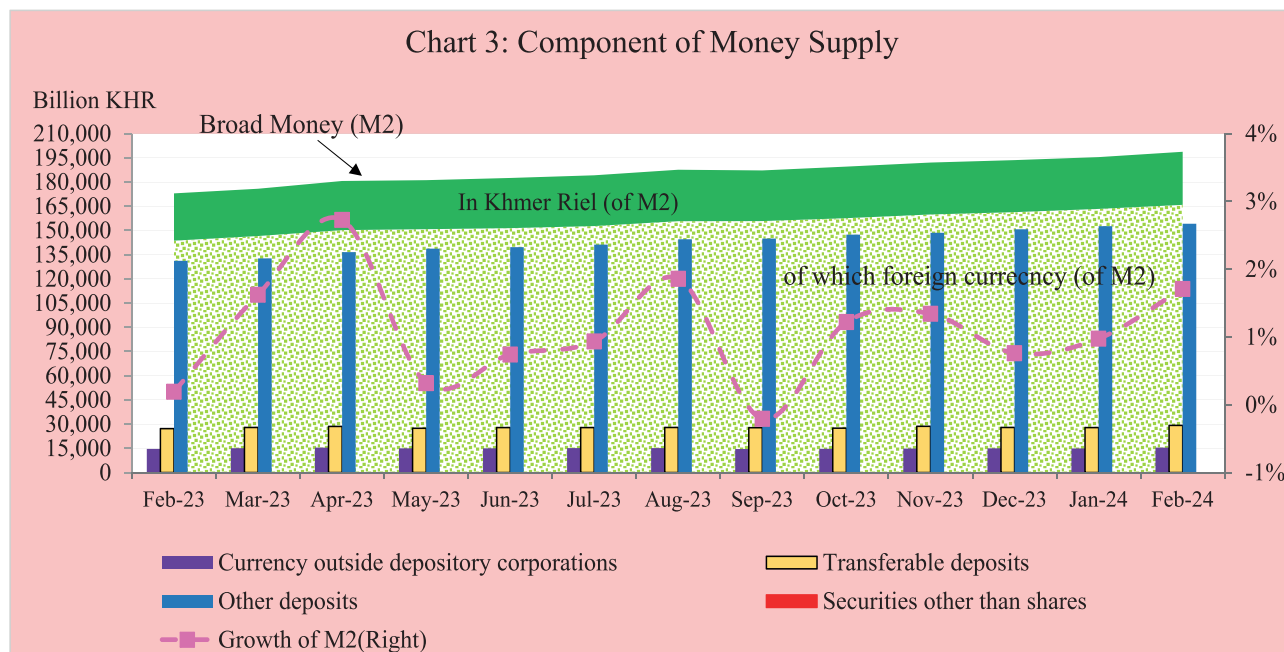
## Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,064 per USD in February 2024, appreciated by 0.39% over January.



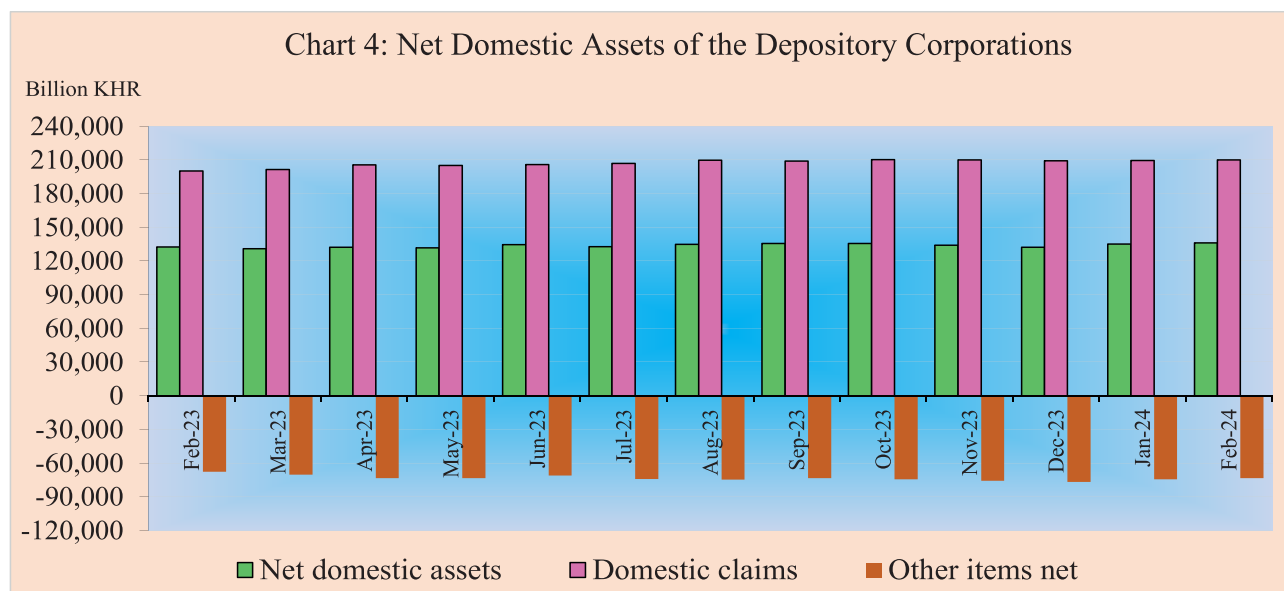
## Money Supply

Broad money (M2) increased to KHR 198,760.2 billion in February 2024, up by 1.7% compared to January. The main components of M2 showed that transferable deposits, currency outside depository corporations, and other deposits increased by 4.8%, 3.4% and 1%, respectively.



## Net Domestic Assets of the Depository Corporations

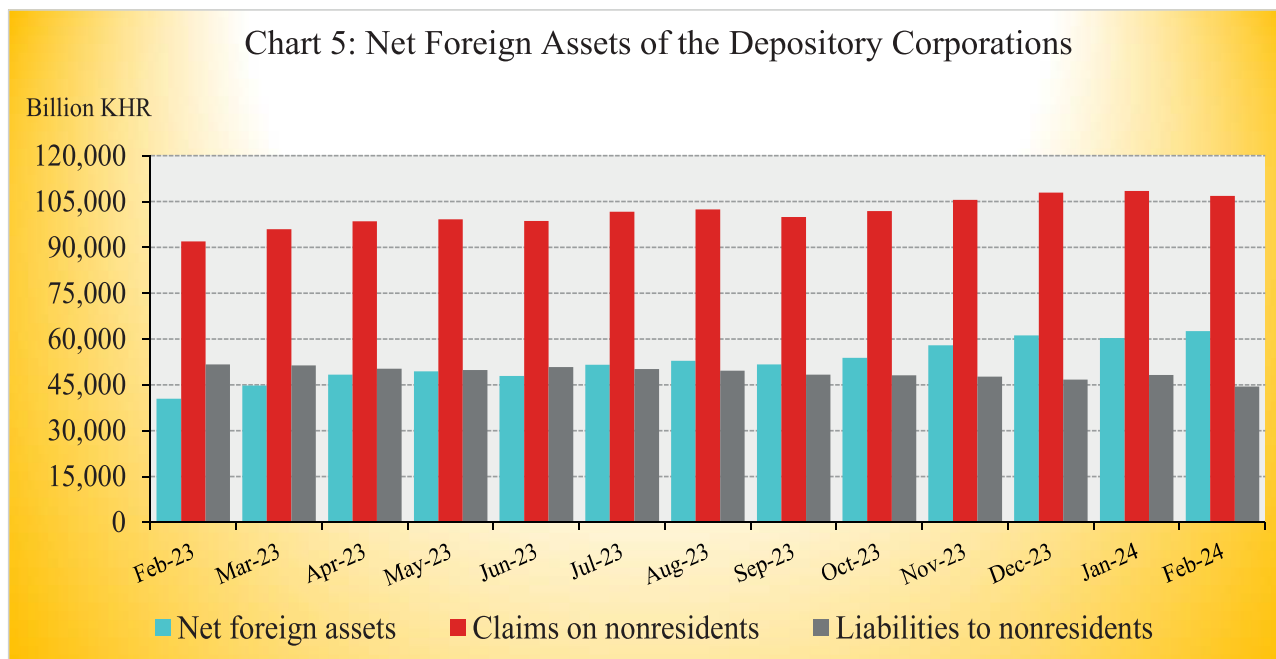
Net domestic assets of the depository corporations increased to KHR 136,219.1 billion in February 2024, up by 0.8% compared to January. This was due to the increase of 1% and 0.2% in other items net and net domestic credit, respectively.



The increase in other items net was due to a decrease of 1.3% in capital accounts, while others declined by 1.8%. The increase in net domestic credit was due to the increases of 3.5%, and 1% in net credit to nonfinancial public sector, and net credit to other financial corporations, respectively, while credit to private sector declined by 0.1%.

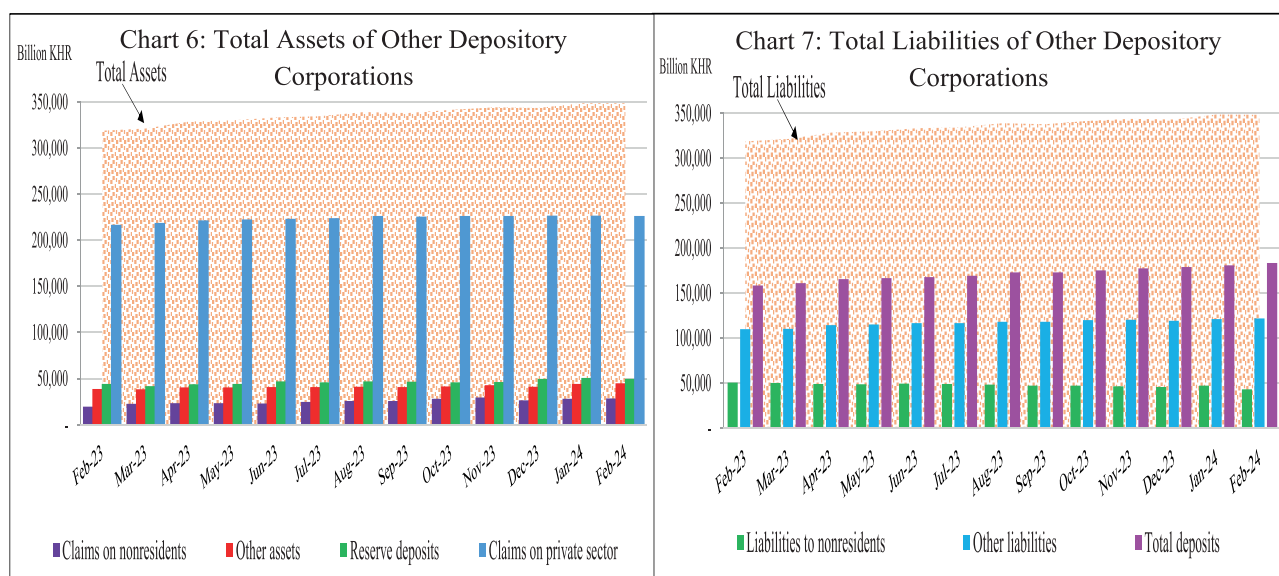
## Net Foreign Assets of the Depository Corporations

Net foreign assets of the depository corporation increased to KHR 62,541.1 billion in February 2024, up by 3.6% from January. This was due to an increase of 2.1% in other foreign assets along with a decrease of 8% in foreign liabilities, while gross foreign reserve decreased by 2.8%.



## Other Depository Corporations Survey

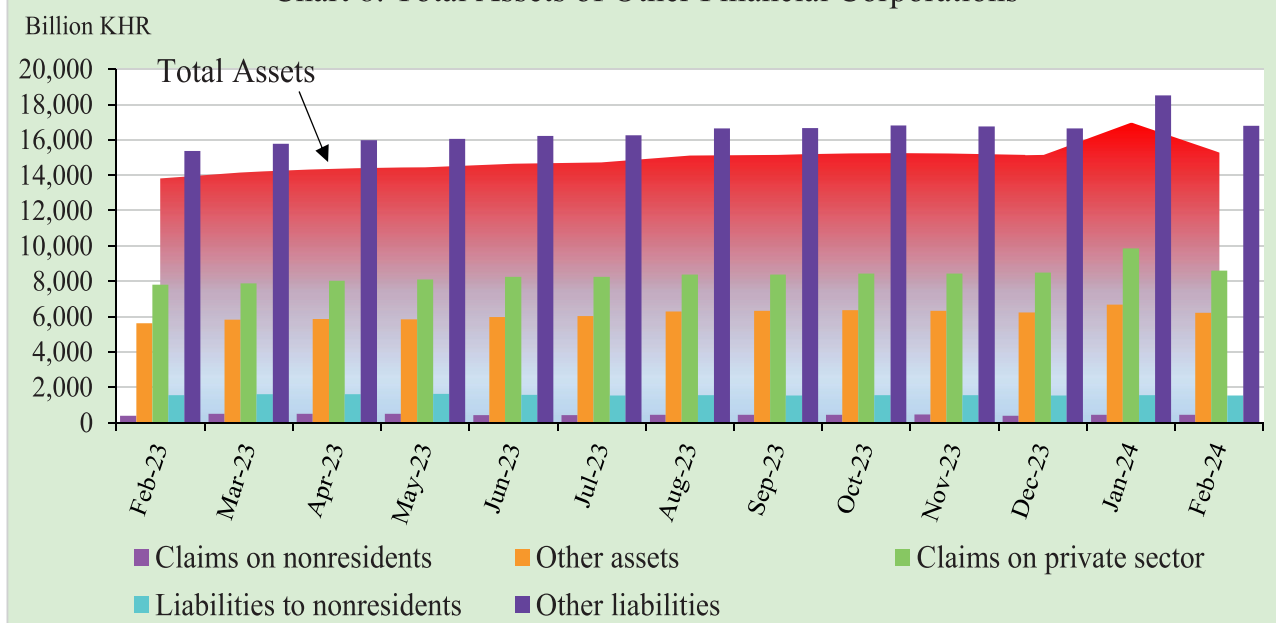
Total assets of other depository corporations (including commercial banks and microfinance deposit-taking institutions) were KHR 348,290.9 billion, down by 0.04% in February 2024 compared to the previous month.



## Other Financial Corporations Survey

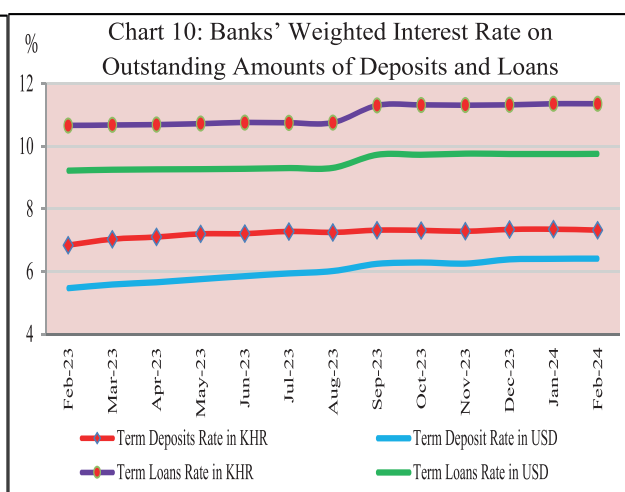
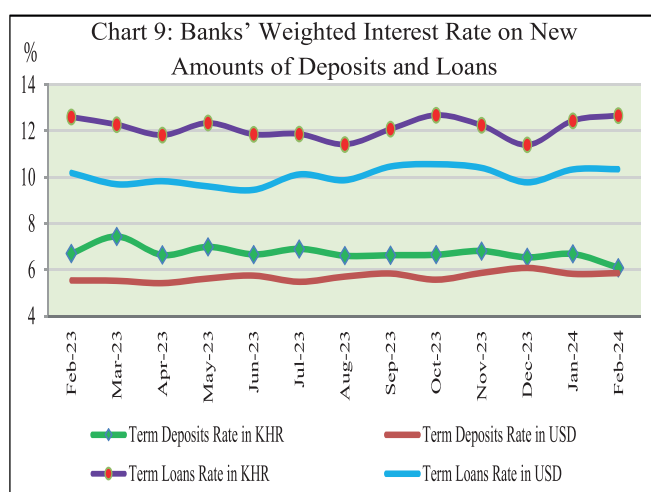
Total assets of other financial corporations (including specialized banks, MFIs, and insurance companies) were KHR 15,269.7 billion, down by 10% in February 2024 compared to January.

### Interest Rates on Deposits and Loans

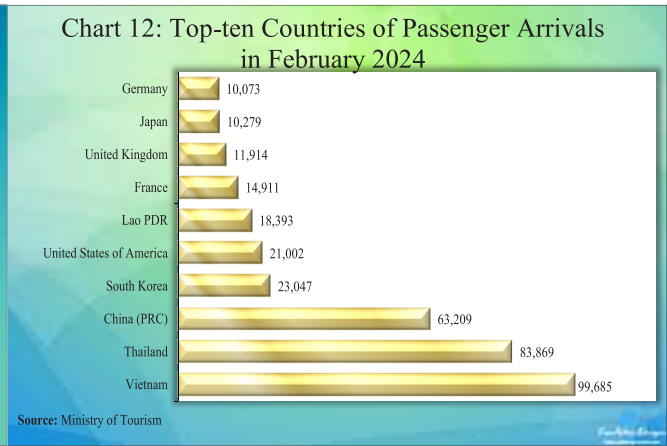
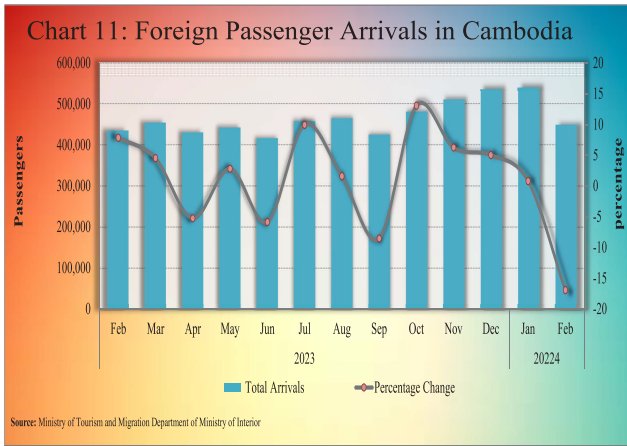
Interest rate on deposits and loans of banking sector in February 2024 showed that the (new amount) weighted average interest rate on term deposits in KHR decreased by 0.6% to 6.09%, while term deposits in USD increased by 0.03% to 5.86%. At the same time, the weighted average interest rate on term loans in KHR increased by 0.22% to 12.67%, and term loans in USD increased by 0.01% to 10.35%.



### Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In February 2024, the total number of passenger arrivals was 448,551, decreased by 16.9% after the increase of 0.8% in the previous month. The main purposes of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia were for vacation, and business and professional, which were accounted for 75.2% and 22.6% of the total, respectively.

Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, Thailand, China P.R.C., South Korea, United States of America, Laos PDR, France, United Kingdom, Japan, and Germany.

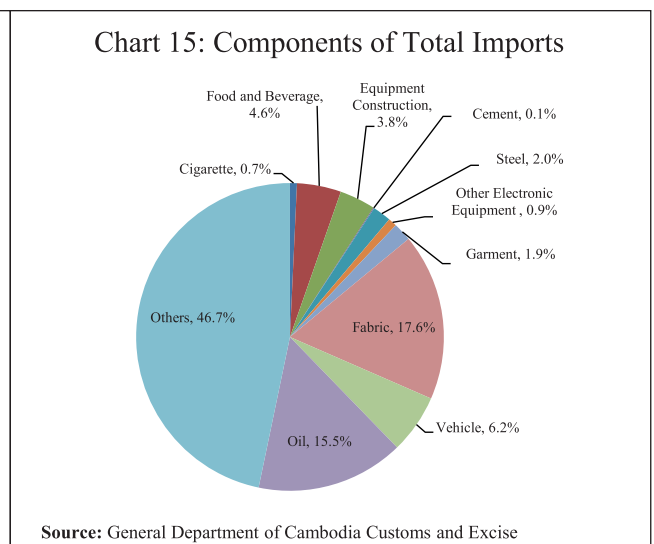
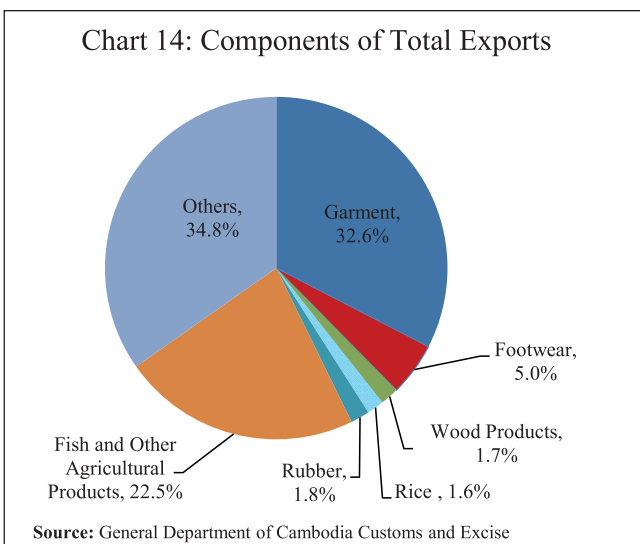


## International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 245.2 billion (2.9%) in February 2024, following the deficit of KHR 796 billion (8.9%) in January.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Fish and other agricultural Products, Other Textile Product, Electrical Part, Footwear, Rubber, Wood Products, Rice, Bicycle, and Vehicle and Bicycle Part. In addition, the major components of total imports were Fabric, Oil, Vehicle, Food and Beverage, Equipment Construction, Gold, Steel, Garment, Other Electronic Equipment, Medicine, and Fertilizer.

Chart 5: Investment Fixed Assets by Sectors

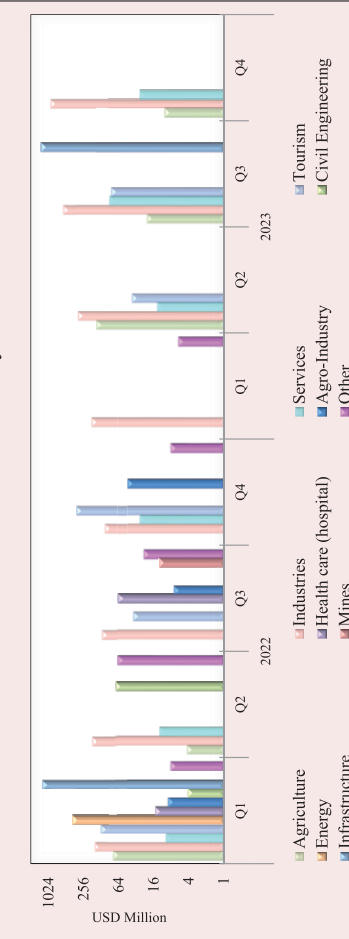
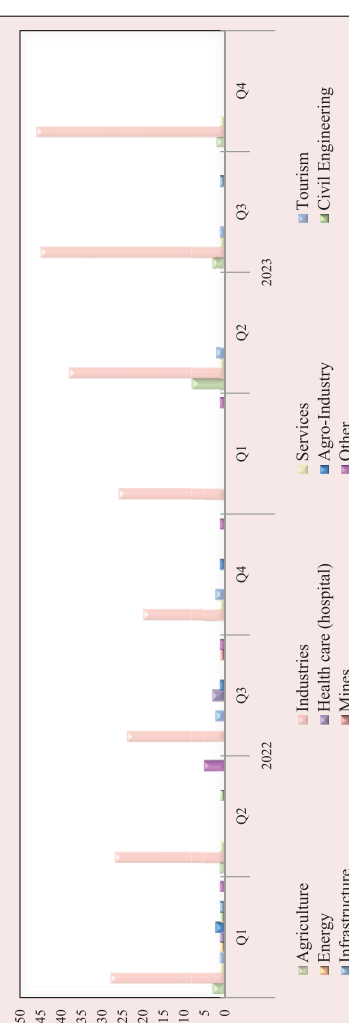


Chart 6: Number of Investment Projects by Sectors

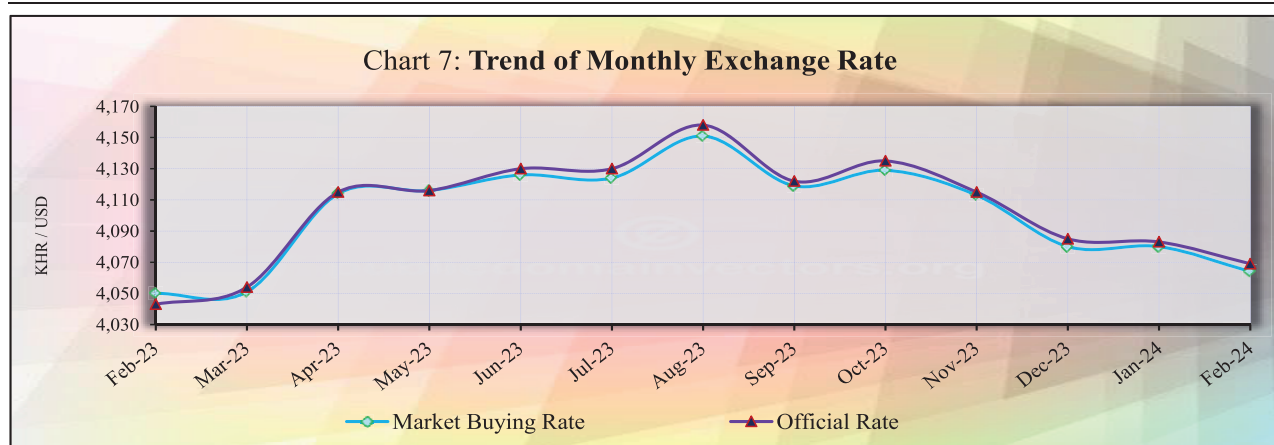

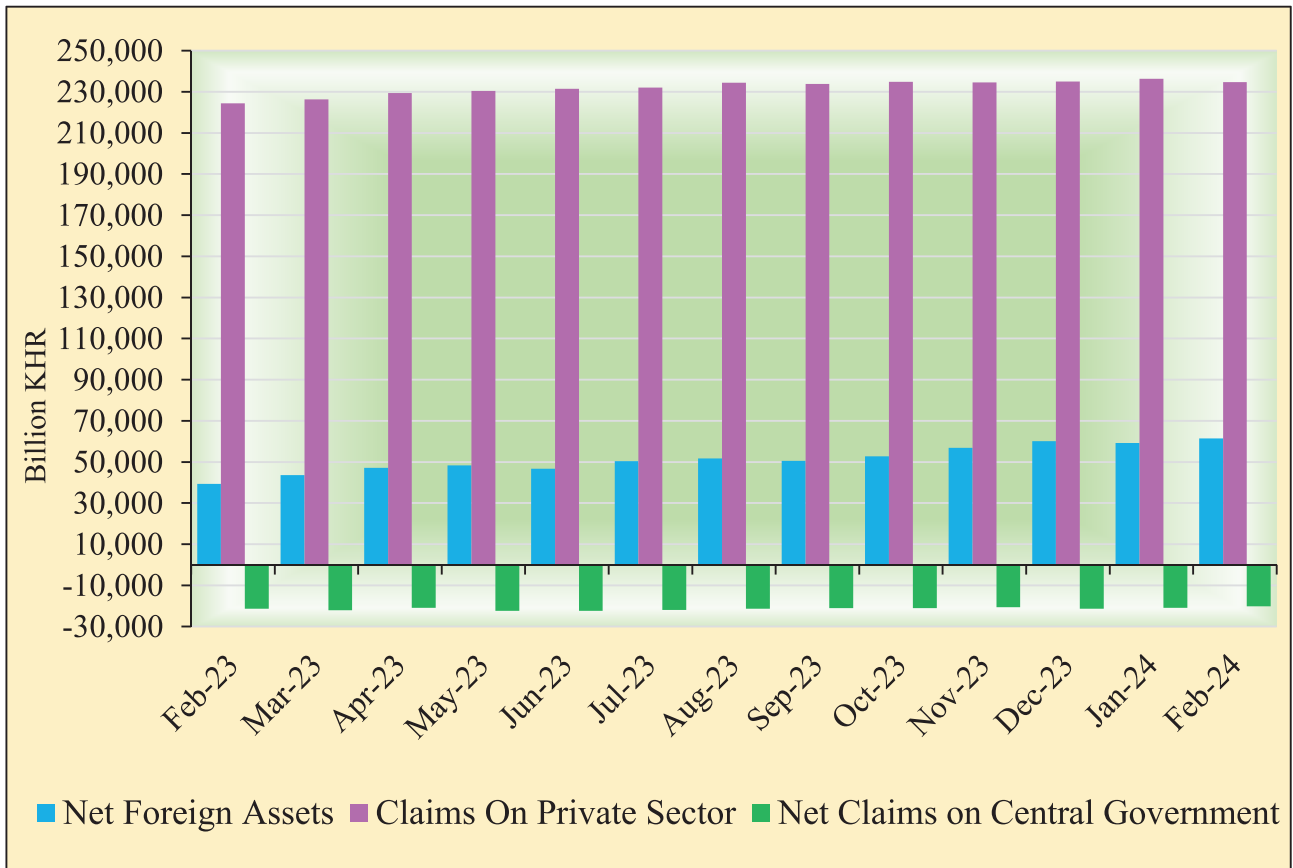

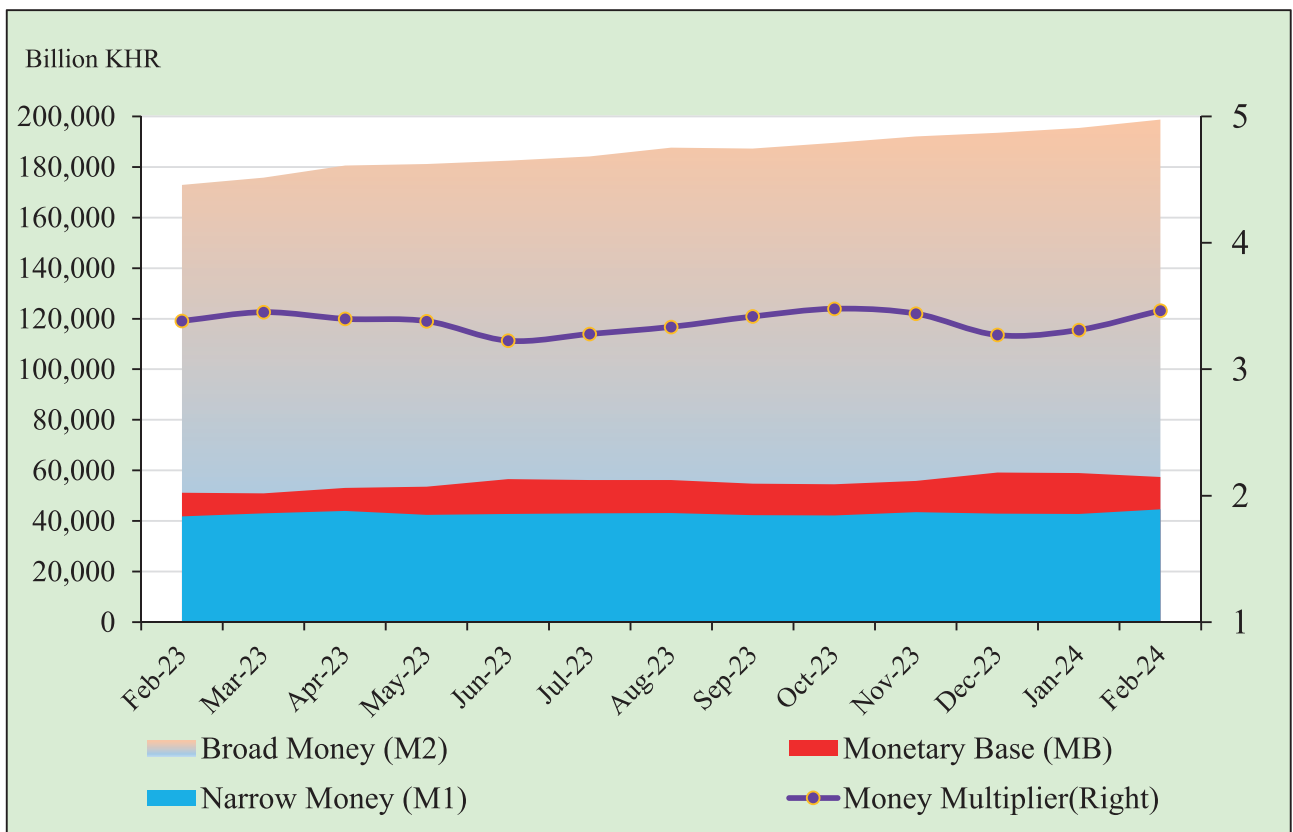

### Chart 8: Financial Corporations Survey



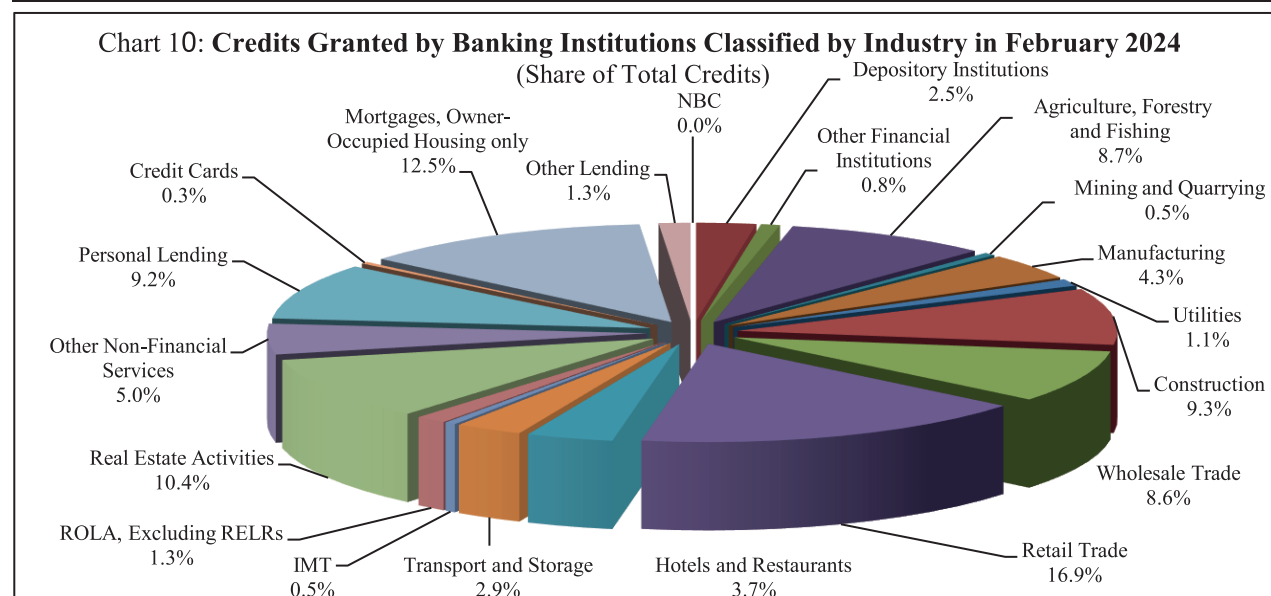
### Chart 9: Monetary Aggregates Components

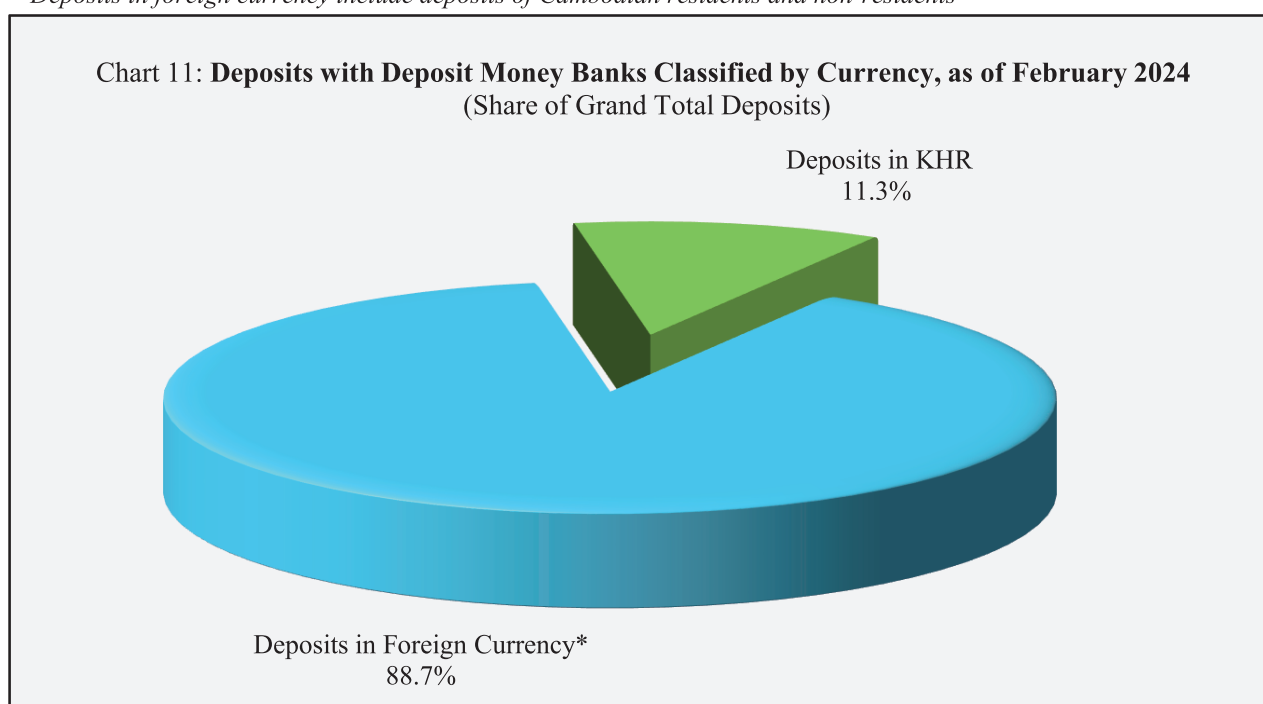

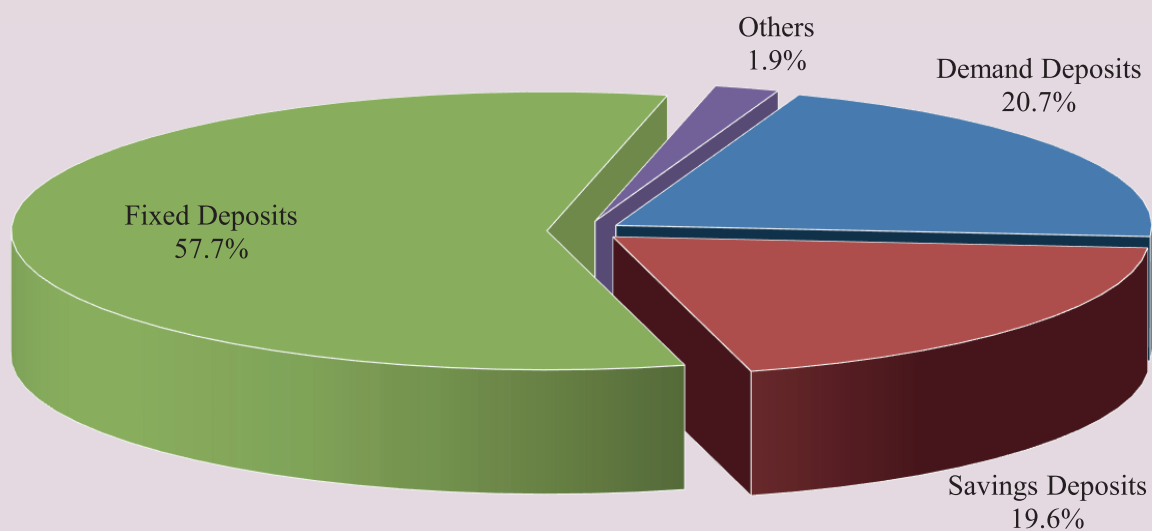

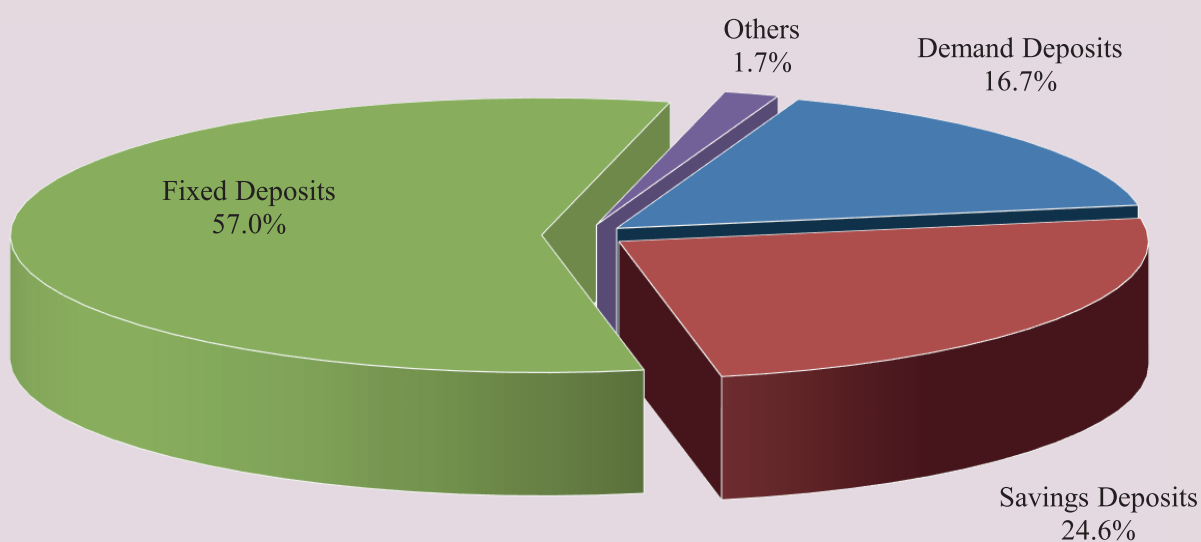
**Chart 12: Deposits in KHR Classified by Type, as of February 2024**

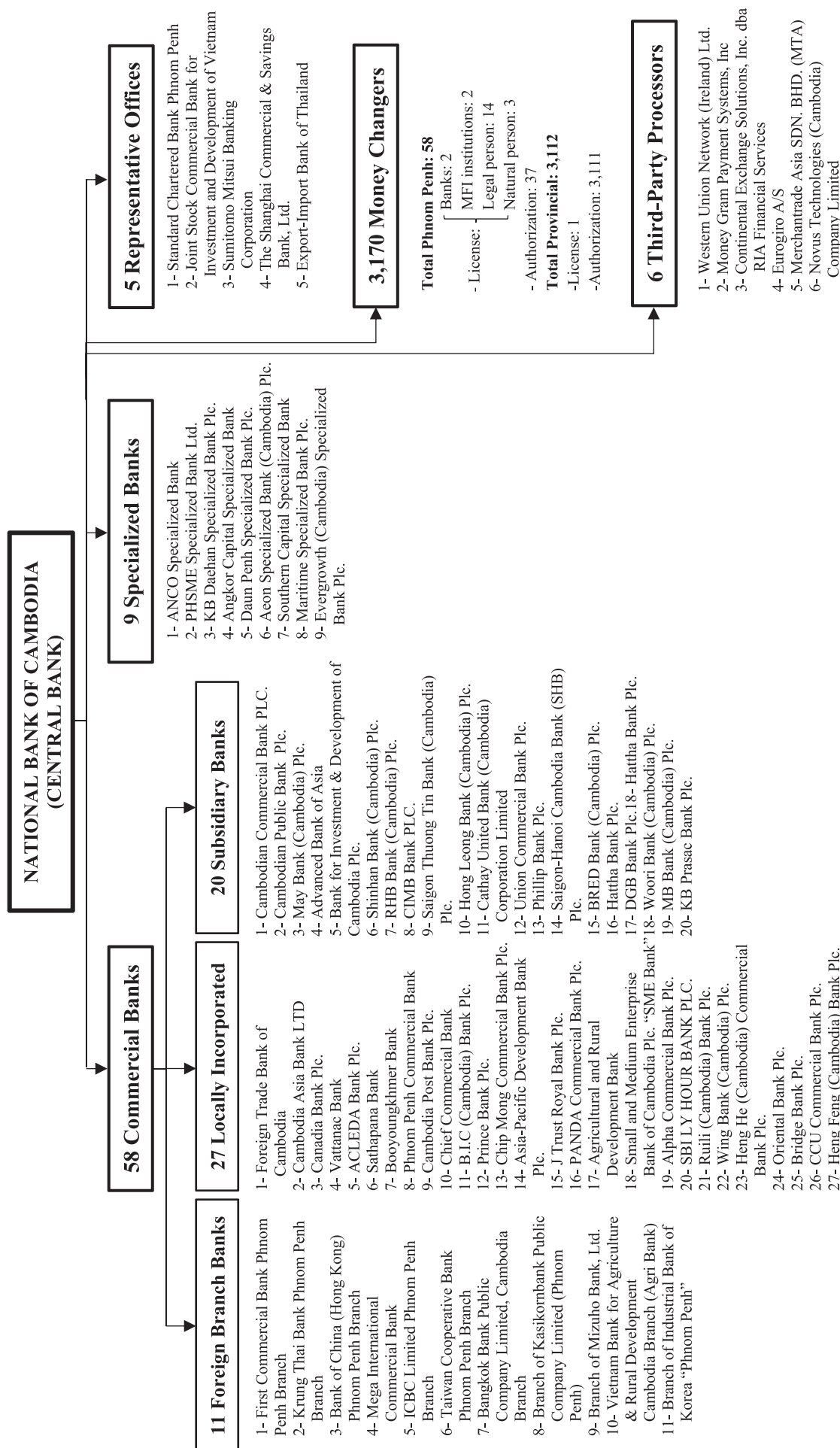

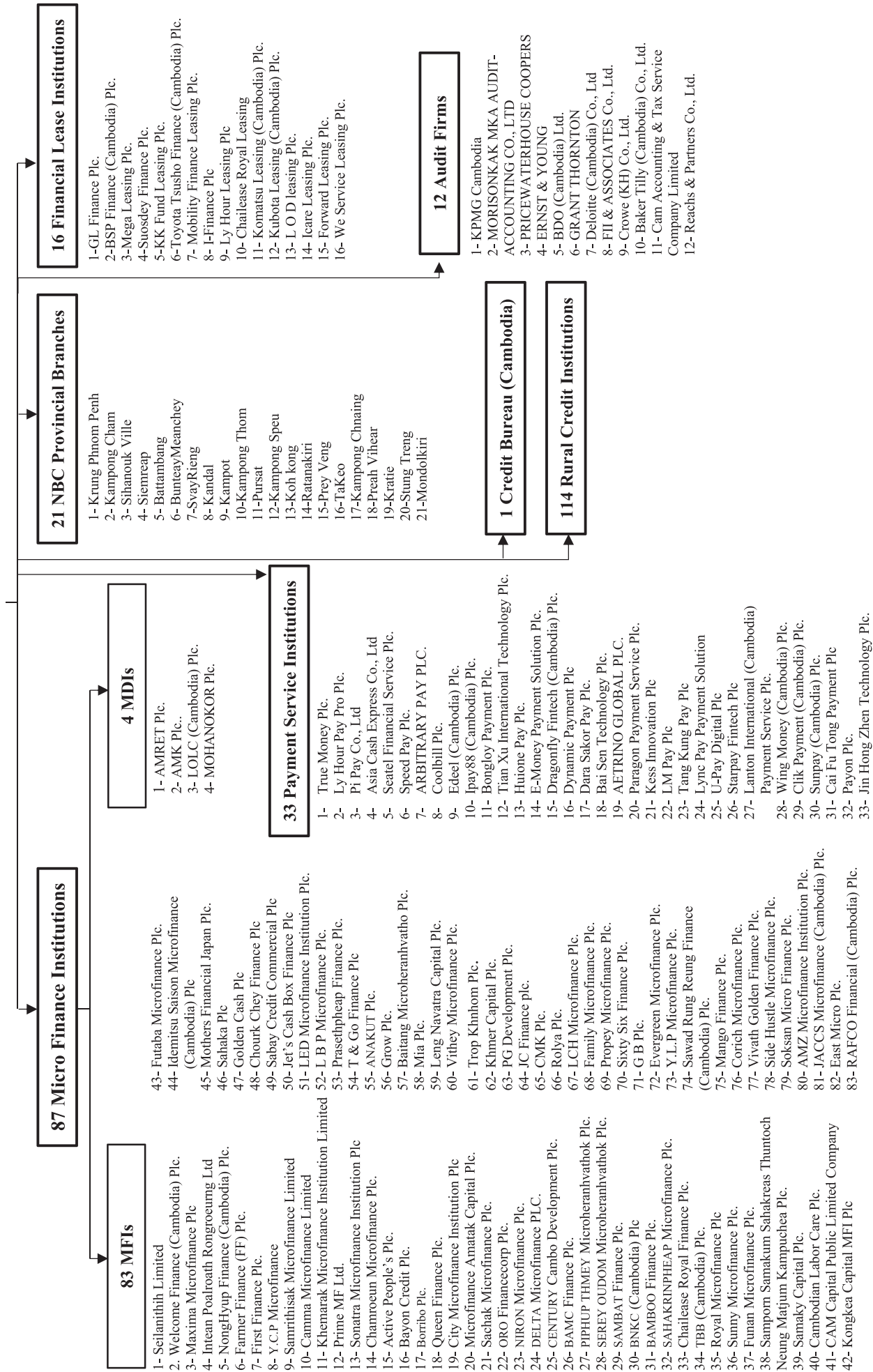
