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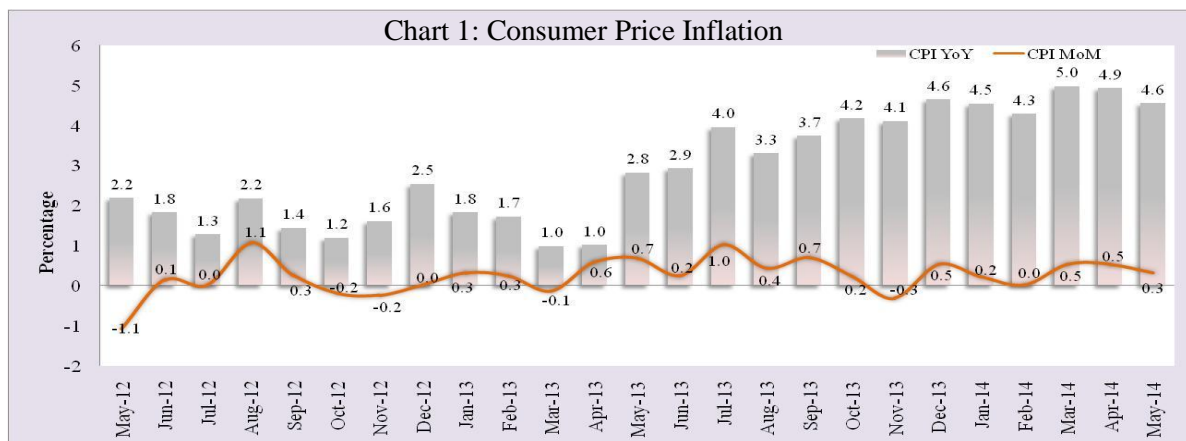
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Introduction

Overall Consumer price inflation in May 2014 eased while Cambodian riel (KHR) exchange rate against US dollar continued to depreciate. At the same time, financial intermediation of the banking sector continued to improve. During the period, international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

Consumer Price Index

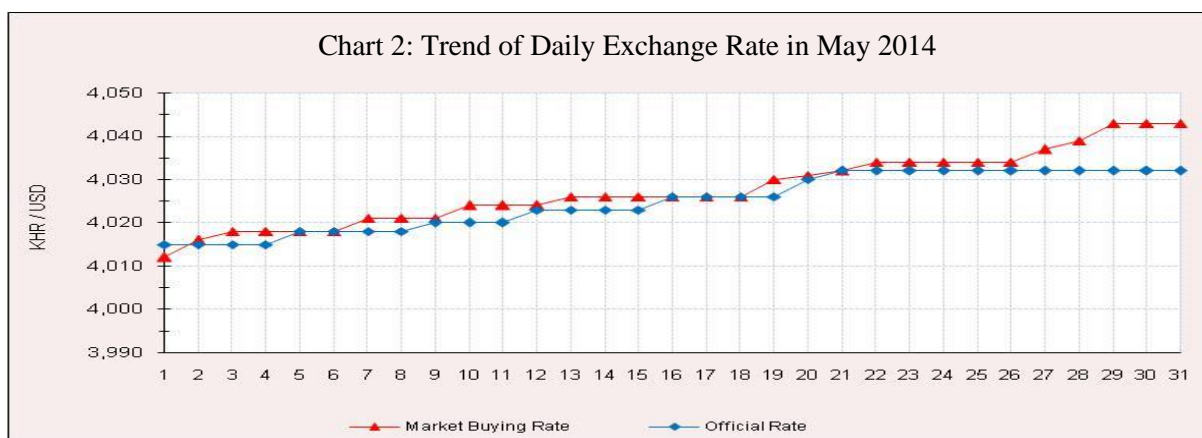
Consumer price inflation (CPI) in Phnom Penh eased to 0.32% (month-on-month) in May 2014, from 0.53% in April 2014. In which, six out of twelve group indexes decreased, five group indexes increased, and other one remained stable.



During the period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items eased to 4.55% in May from 4.94% in a month earlier, mainly due to a decline in oil prices and a slower hike in food prices.

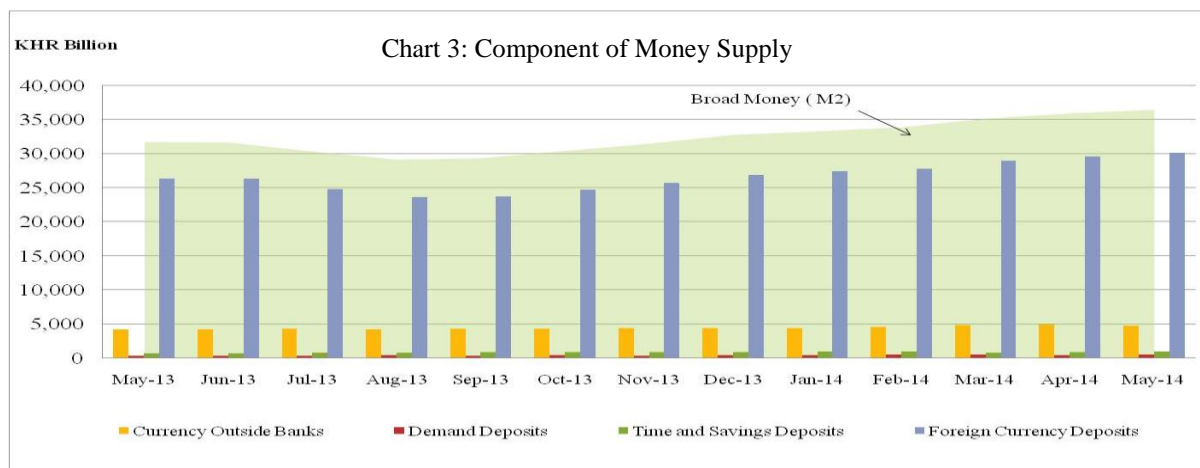
Exchange Rate

The value of KHR against the US dollar (market buying rate) continued to depreciate by 0.77% in May after depreciating 0.42% in April 2014. This was mainly due to the rainy and fishery ban season.



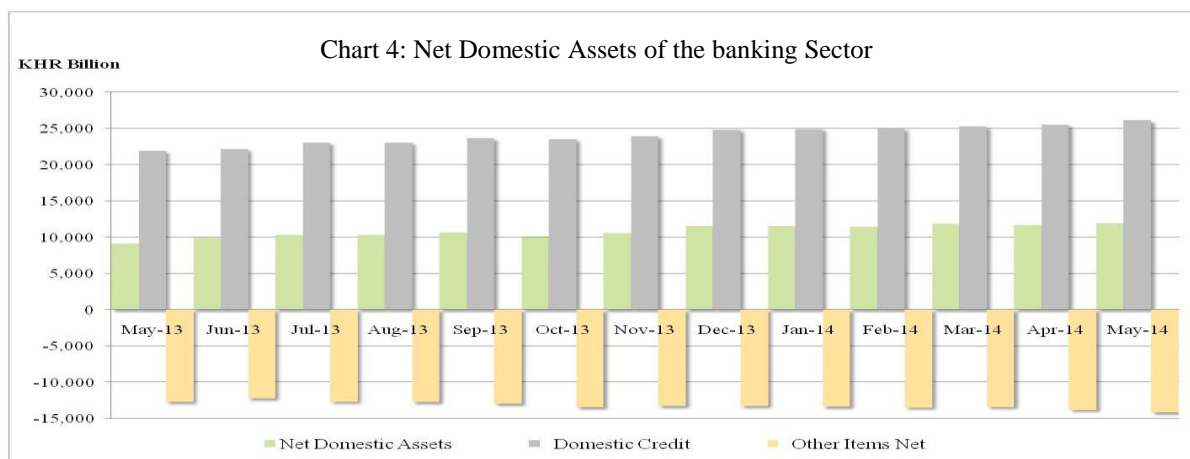
Money Supply

Broad money (M2) in May 2014 continued to increase moderately by 1.5% following the increase of 2.2% in the preceding month. The contributors to this increase were: demand deposits (13.6%), time and saving deposits (6.8%), and resident's foreign currency deposits (1.9%) while currency outside banks declined by 2.9%.



Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

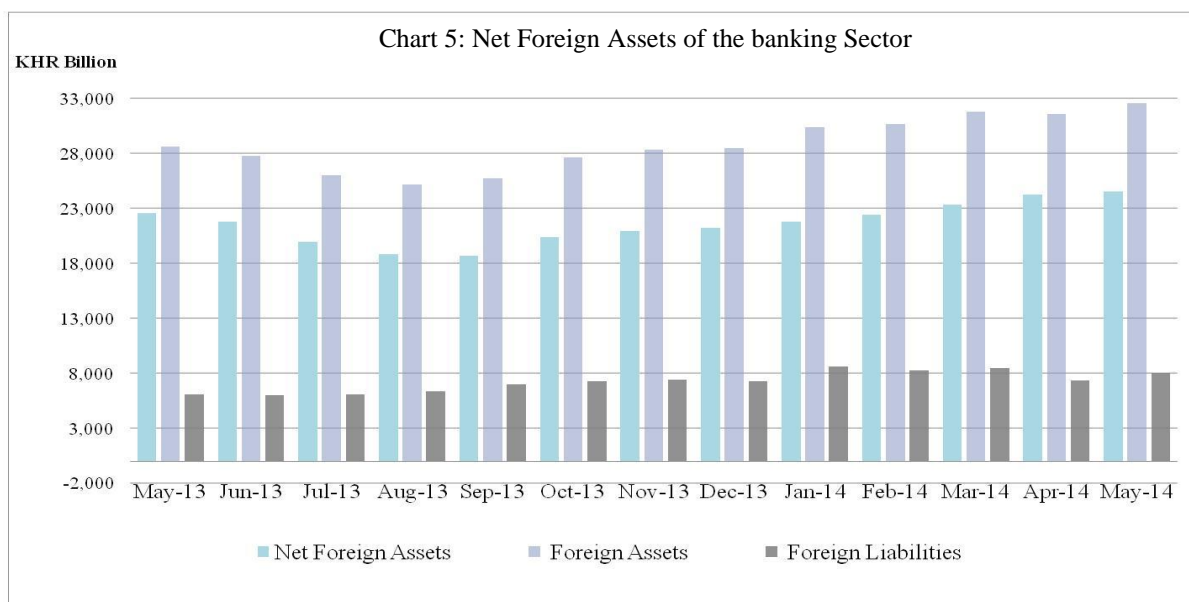
Net domestic assets of the banking sector increased moderately by 2.3%, due to an increase of 2.5% in domestic credit while other items net decreased 2.6%.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 2.4% in credit to private sector while credit to state enterprises and net claims on government declined by 16.5% and 1.8%, respectively.

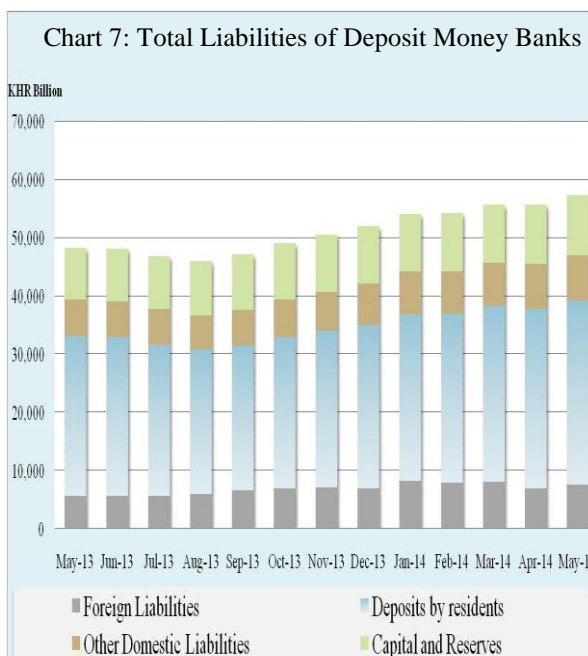
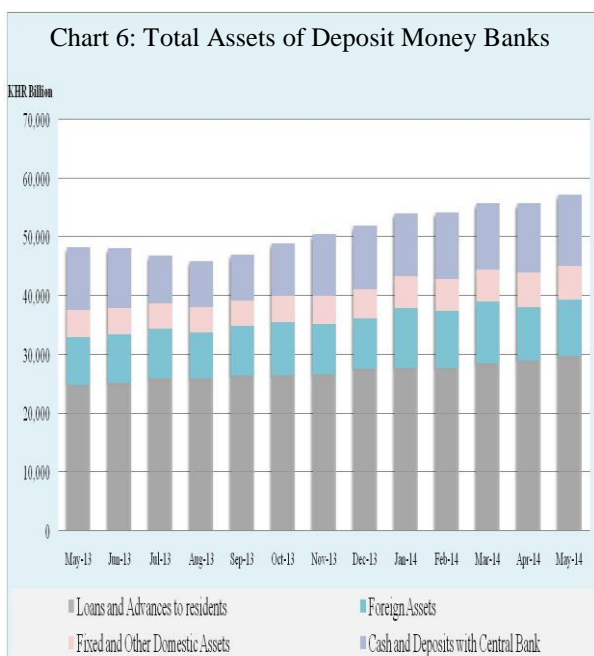
Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector in May 2014 continued to increase 1.1% from the 4% increase in April. This decline was due to an increase in total foreign liabilities.



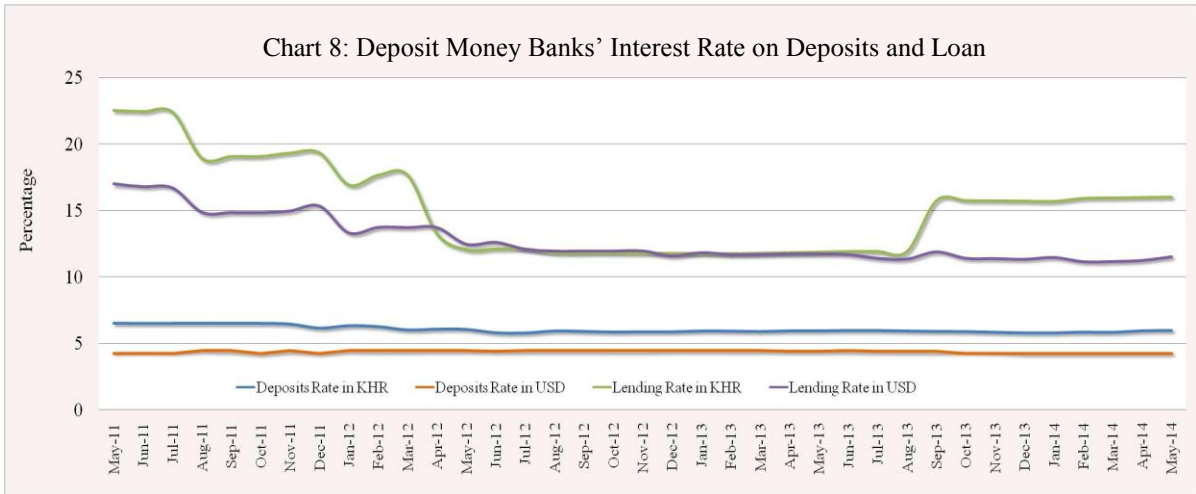
Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks increased sharply in May 2014, up by 2.84% after decreasing 0.03% in the previous month.



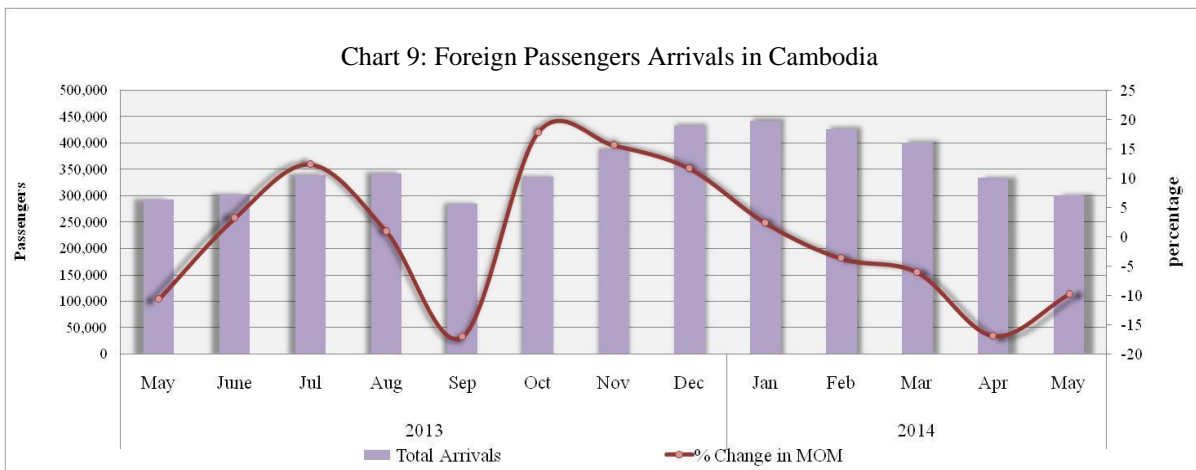
Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In May 2014, the interest rate movement with a maturity of 12-month on loans and deposits showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR increased by 0.02% while deposit in US Dollar decreased by 0.01%. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR increased by 0.03% and lending rate in US dollar increased by 0.27%.

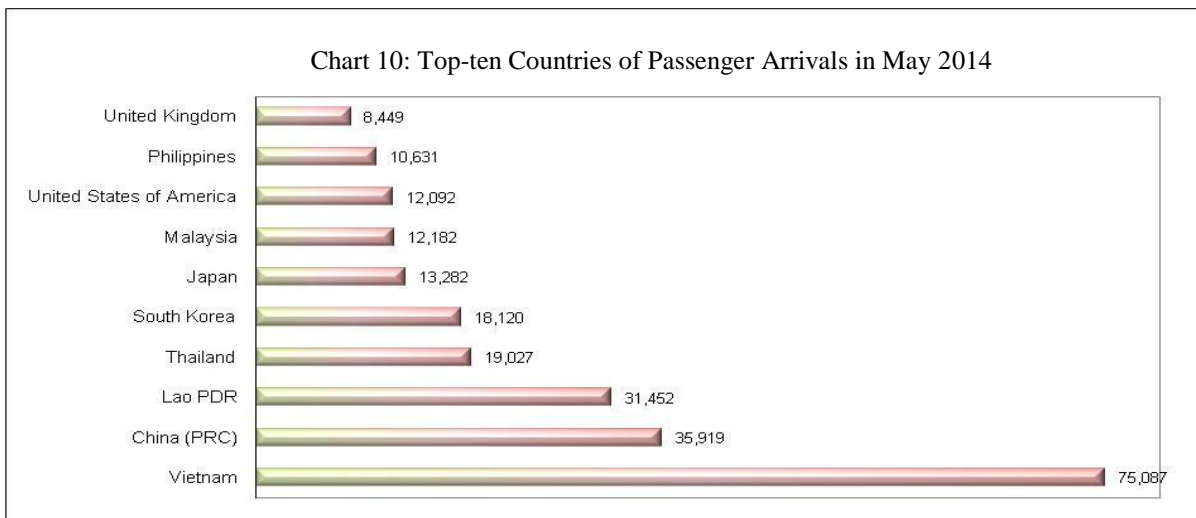


Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In May 2014, the total number of passenger arrivals continued to decrease 9.7% following the decrease of 16.8% in a month earlier. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for 94% of the total.

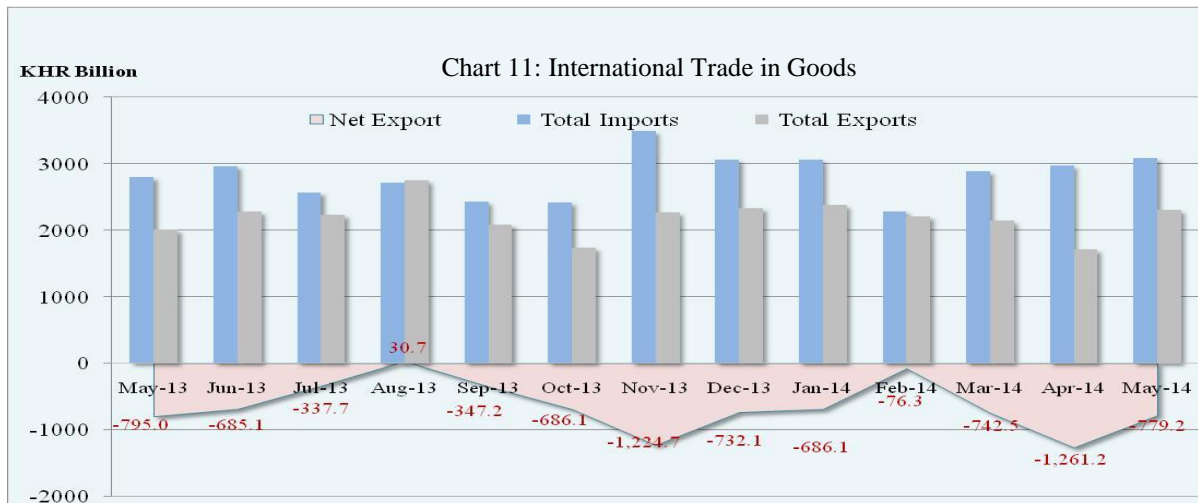


Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, China P.R.C., Lao PDR, Thailand and South Korea.



International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 779.2 billion (25.3%) in May, from the deficit of KHR 1,261.3 billion (42.4%) in April 2014. This was mainly due to an increase in total exports.



The major components of total exports were: Garment, Footwear, Swan Timber, and Rubber and the major components of total imports were: Petroleum, Vehicles, Cigarettes, Motor Bikes, Cement, Construction Materials, Clothing, Gold, and Steel.

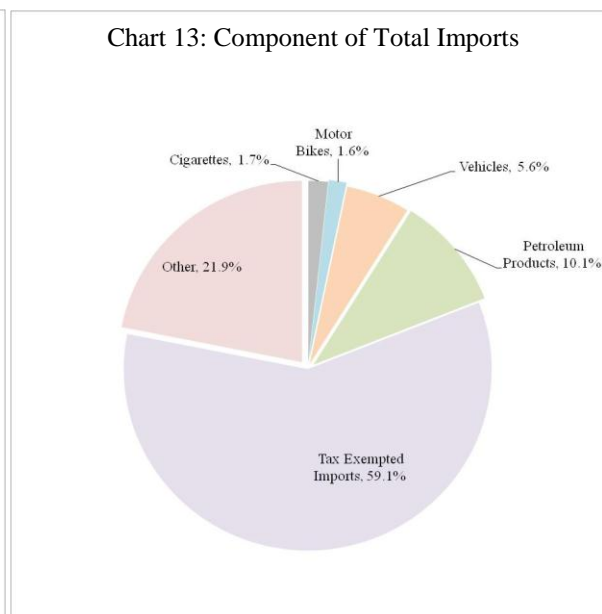
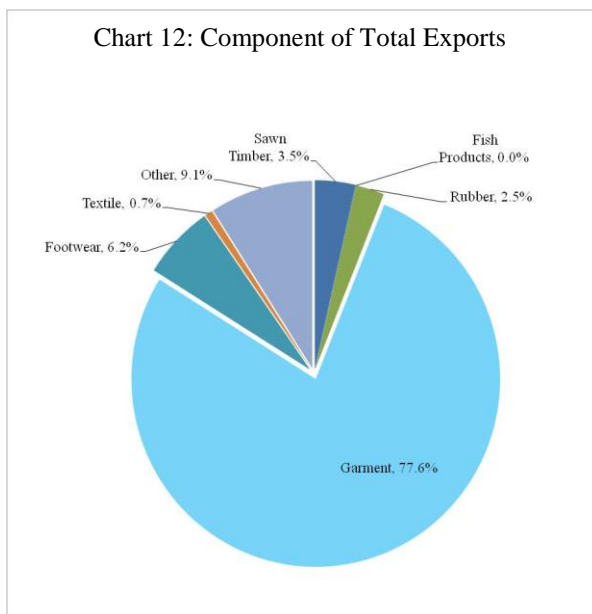

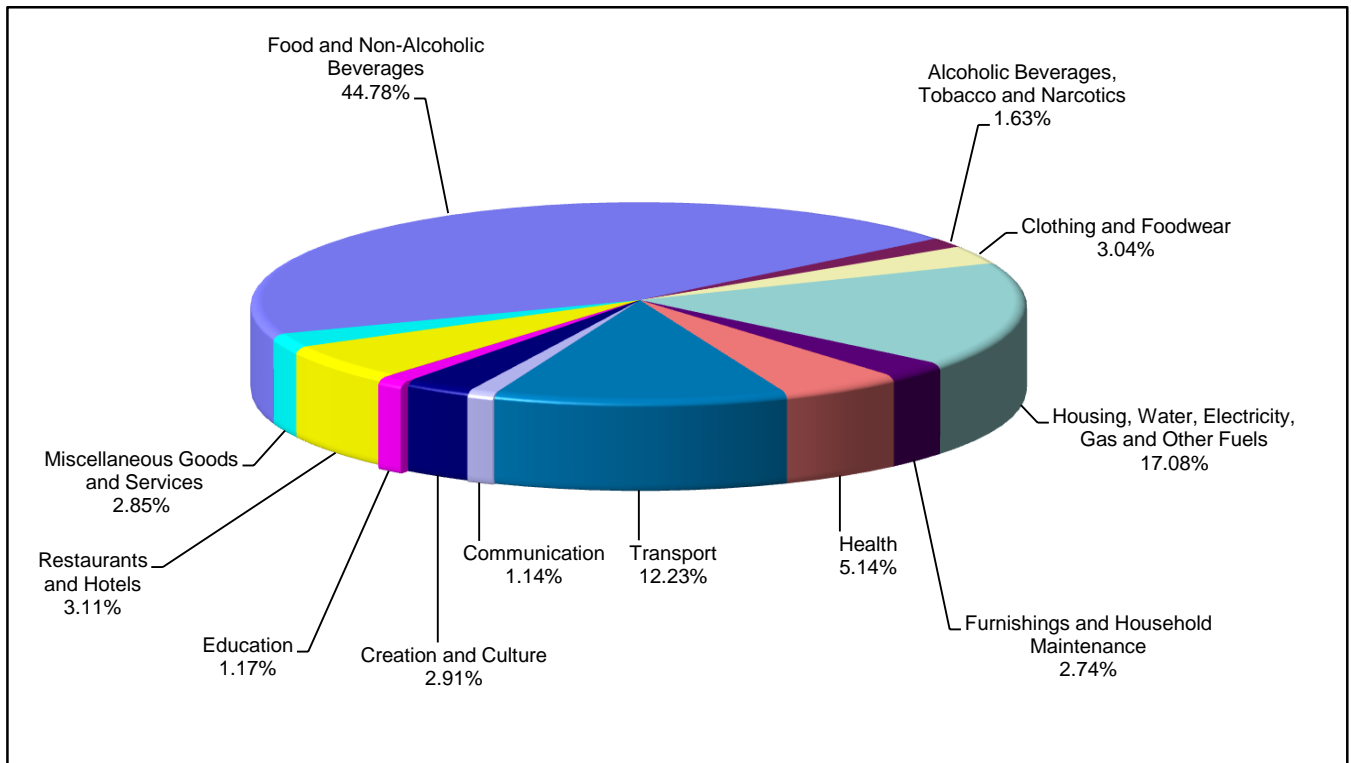

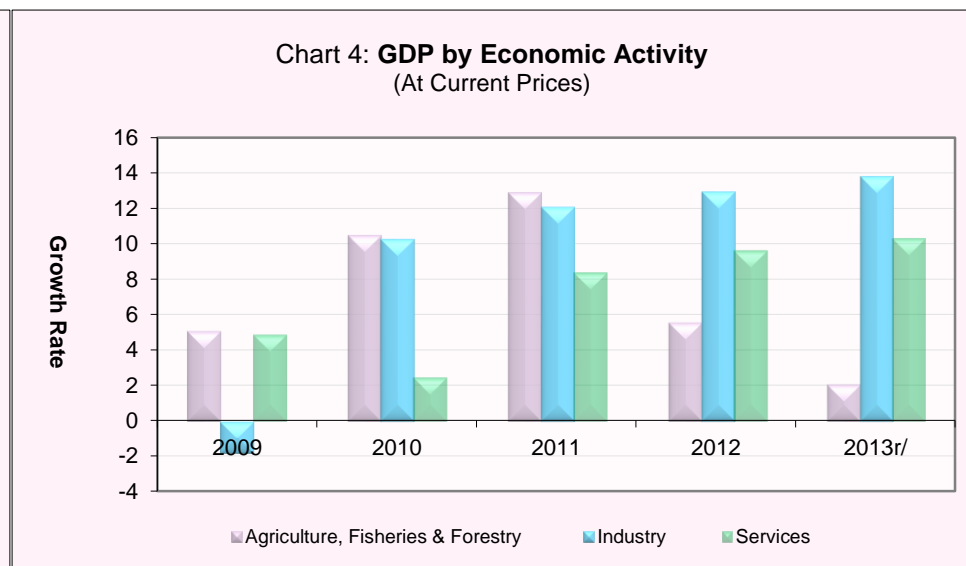
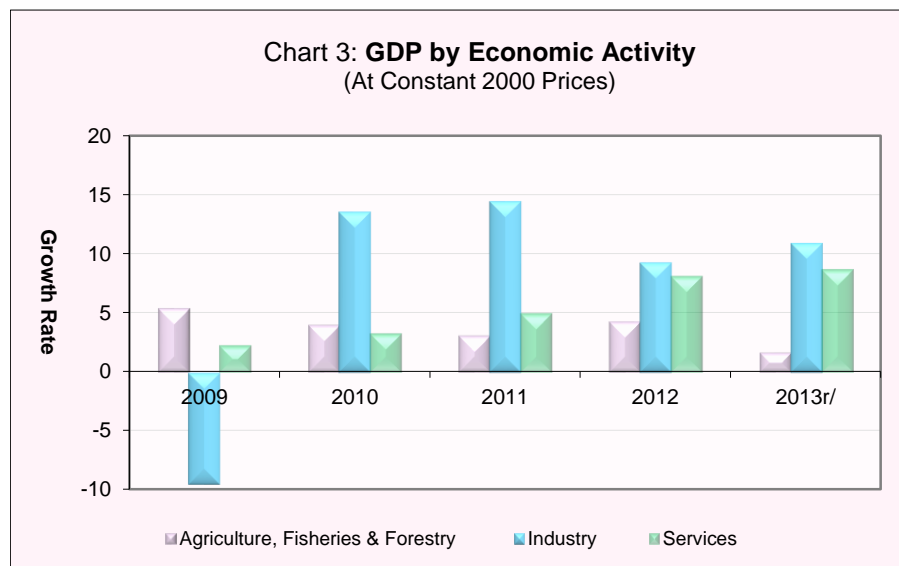
Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket

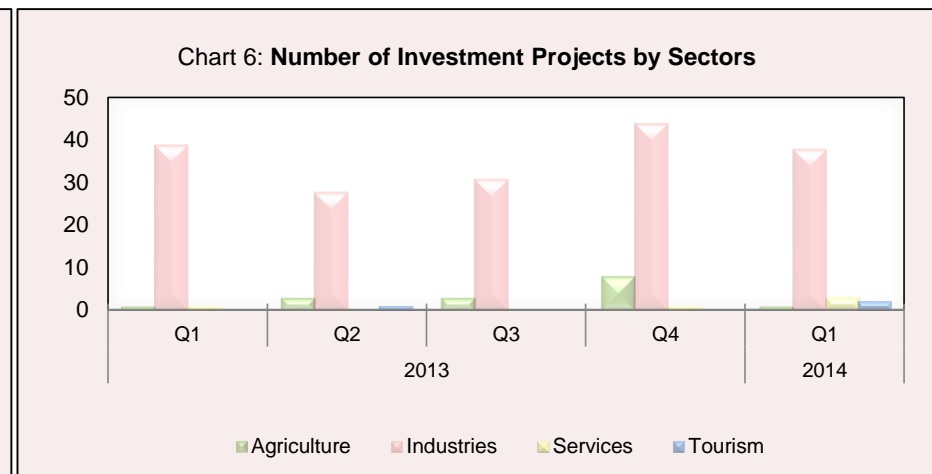
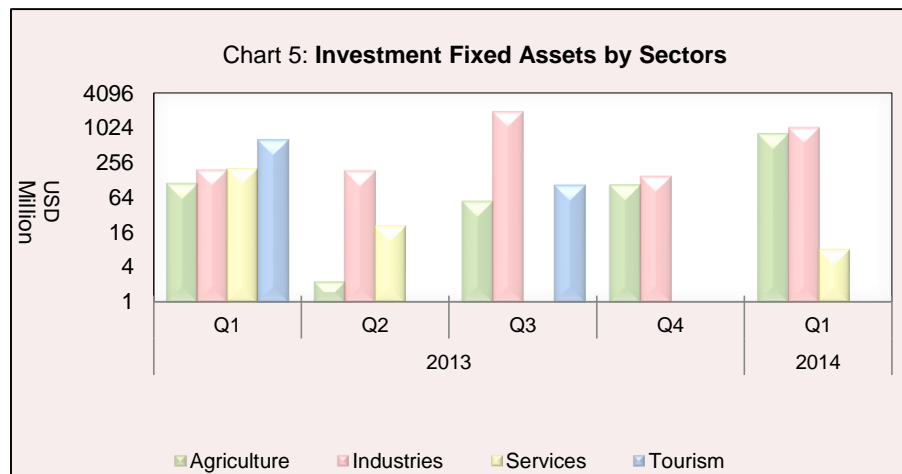

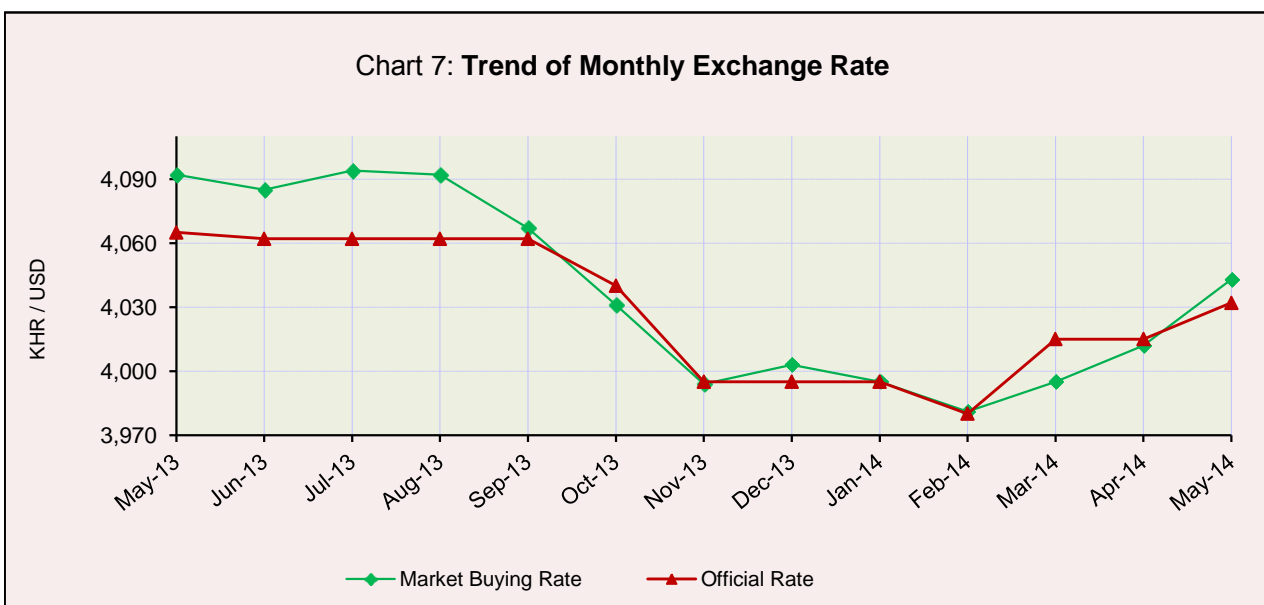

Chart 8: Monetary Survey

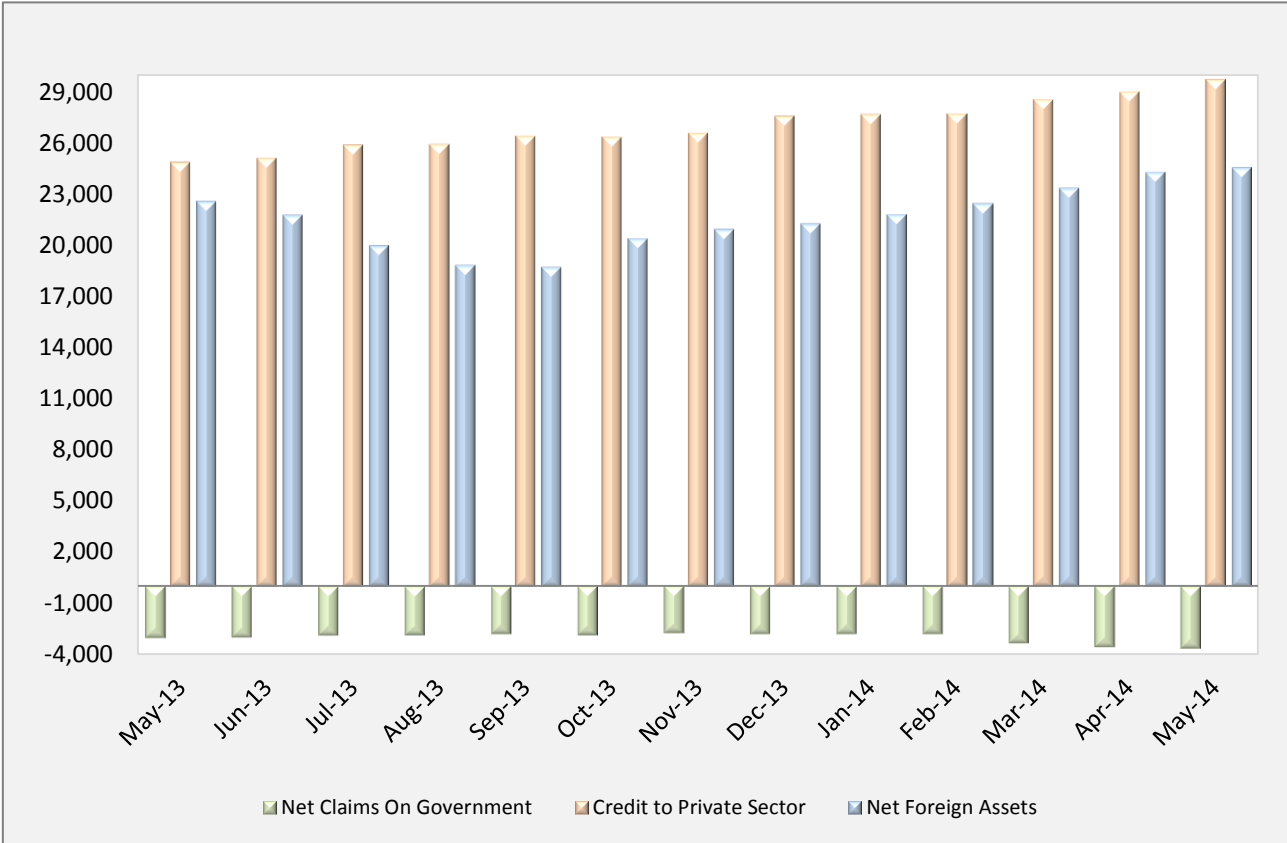


Chart 9: Components of Money Supply

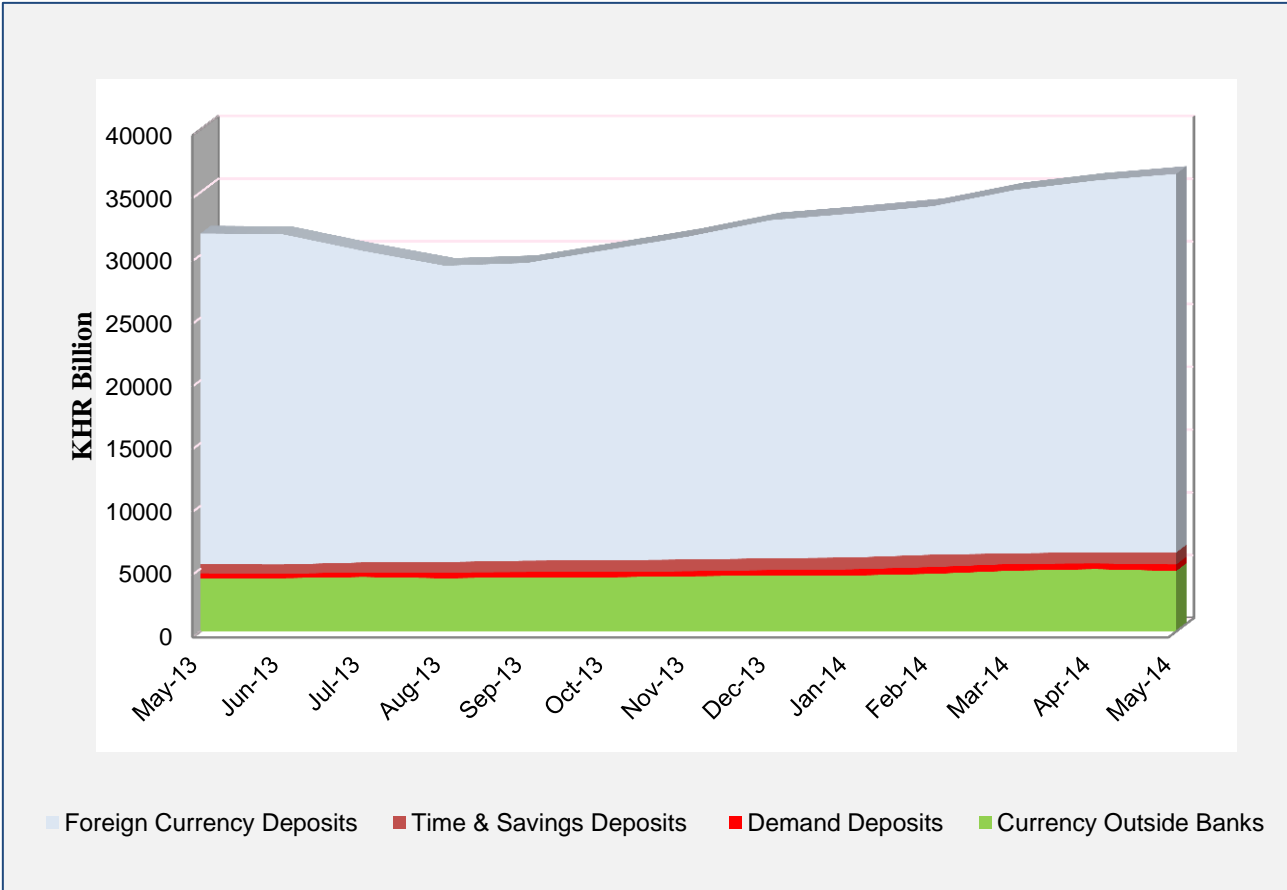

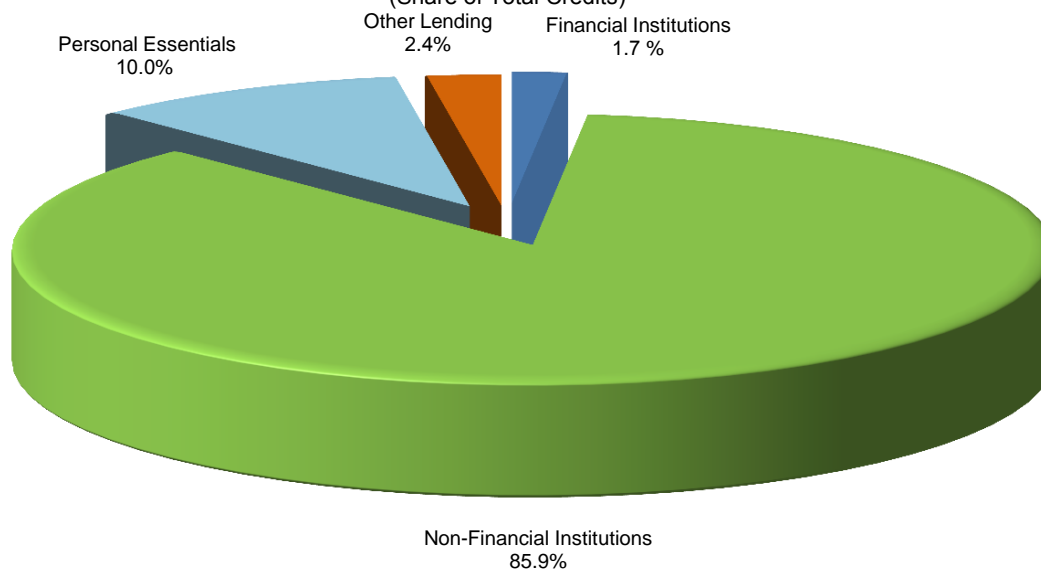

(Share of Grand Total Deposits)

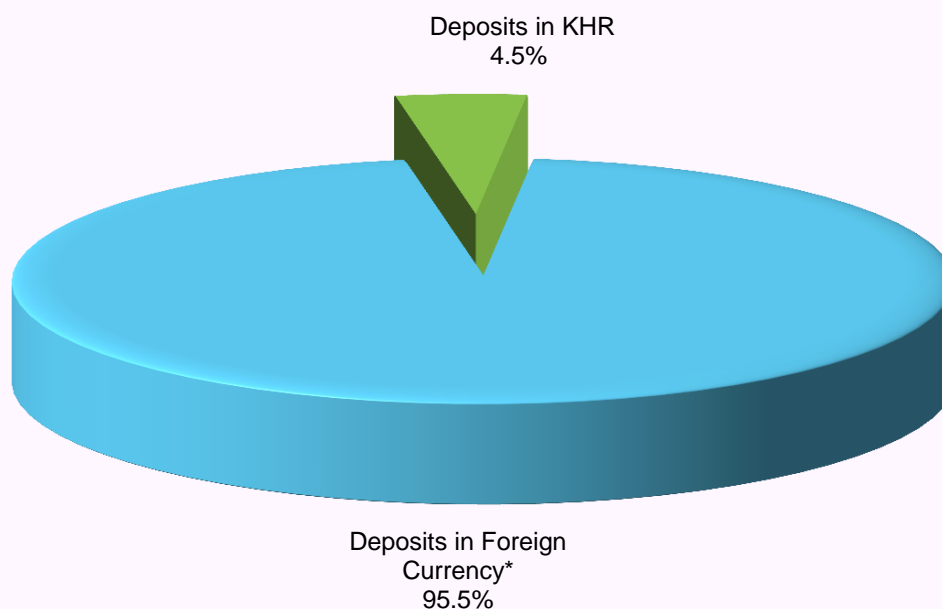

(Share of Total KHR Deposits)

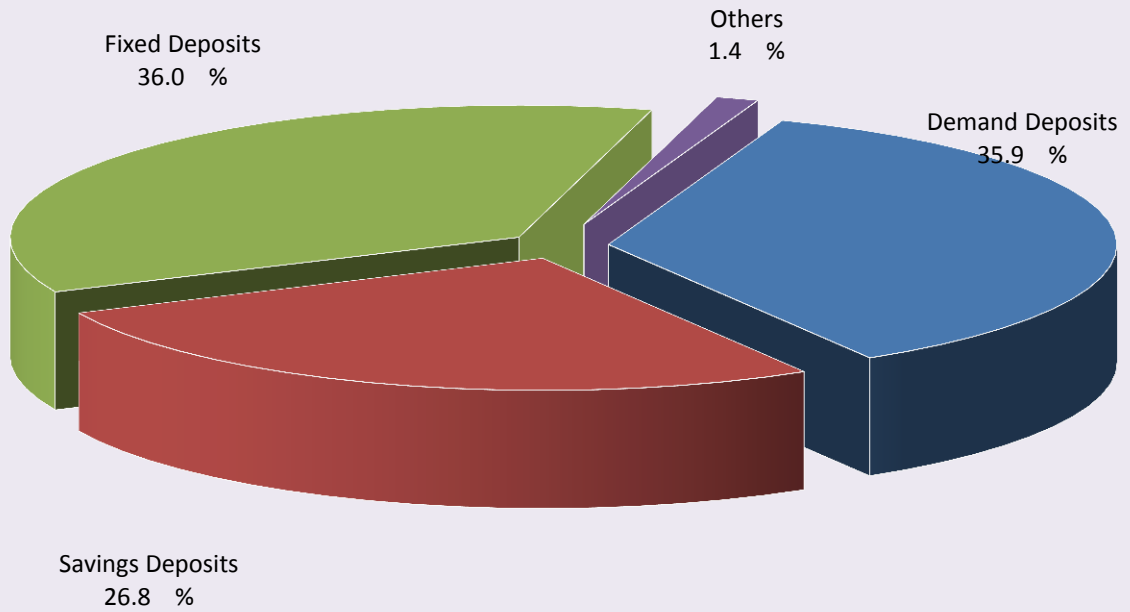
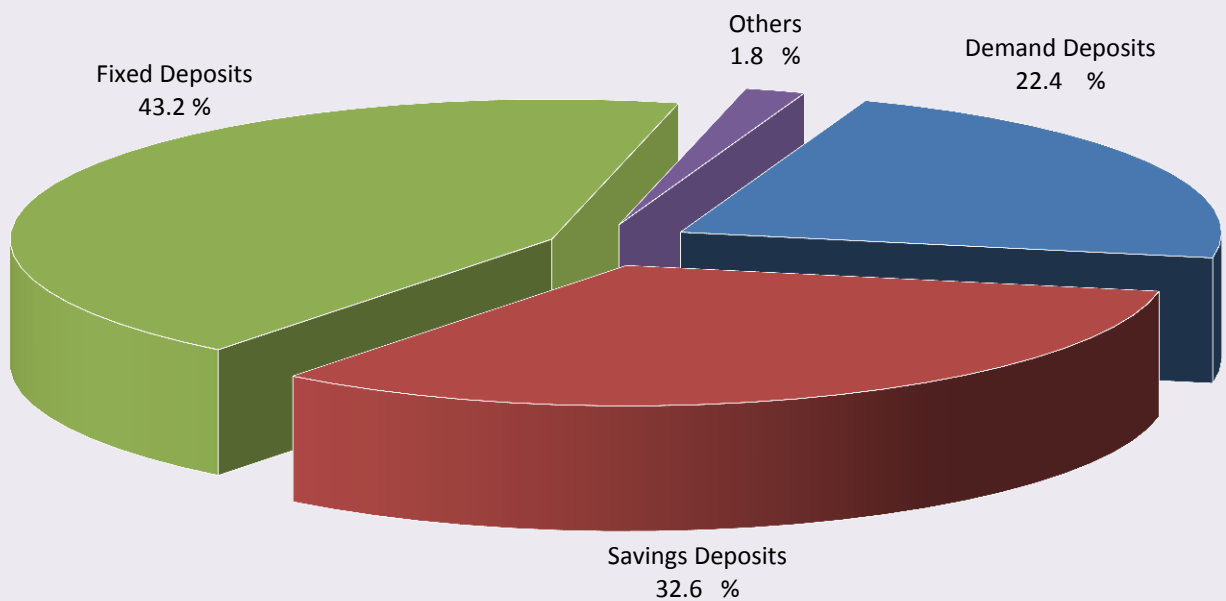


Chart 13: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of May 2014
