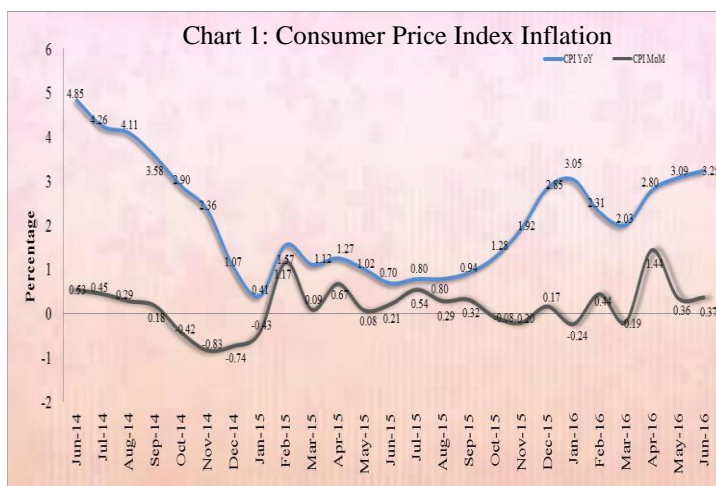
Introduction

Overall consumer price inflation in June 2016 accelerated, compared to last month. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) appreciated slightly against US dollar while credit to private sector and resident deposits of the banking system continued to increase. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

Consumer Price Index

The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) increased slightly to 0.37% in June from 0.36% in May 2016. In which, eight out of twelve group indexes increased while the other three group indexes decreased and one group index remained stable.

During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items accelerated to 3.3% in June 2016 from 3.1% in May, mainly reflected by the increases in prices of food, clothing, and recreation.

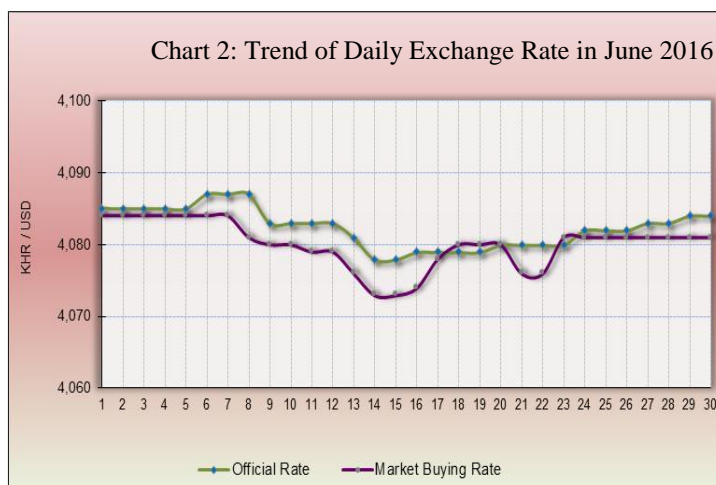


Gross Domestic Product

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices growth was preliminary estimated to rise to 7.2% in 2016, compared with revised 7.0% in 2015 from the value of KHR 43,009.3 billion in 2015 to KHR 46,112.7 billion in 2016, driven by an increase of 11.5% in industry sector, 7.3% in services sector, and 0.1% in agriculture, fisheries, and forestry sector. The key factors contributing to the increase were services sector (39.6%); industry sector (33.3%); and agriculture, fisheries, and forestry sector (19.8%).

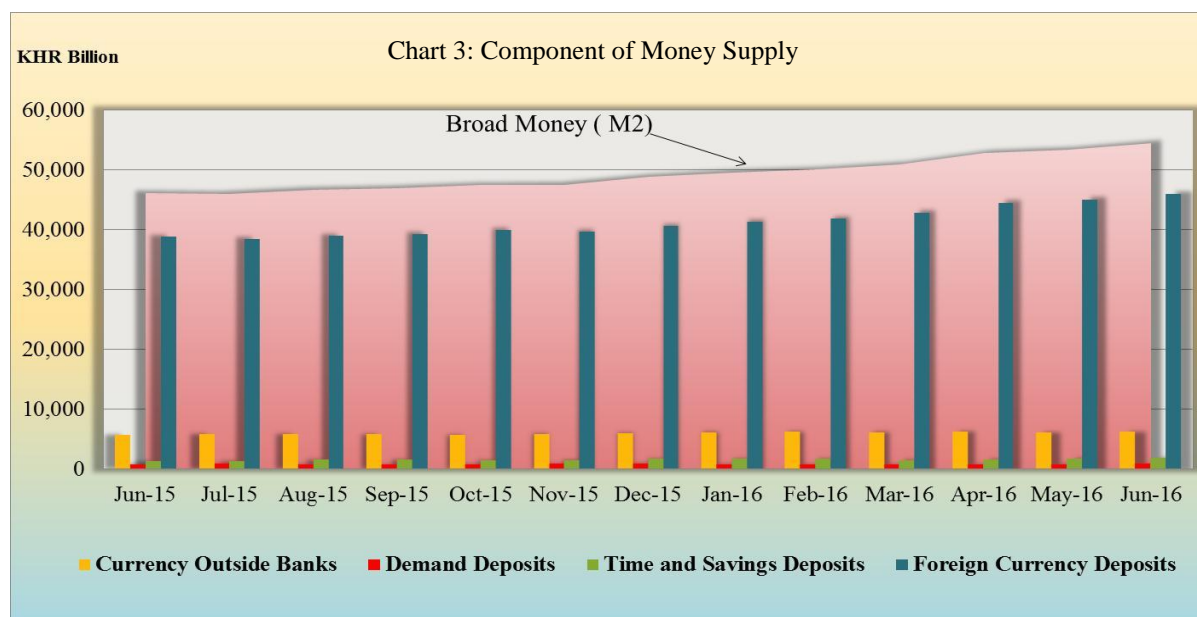
Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,081 per US dollar in June 2016, appreciated slightly by 0.02%, compared to the previous month. This was due to the depreciation of US dollar compared to many hard currencies in the world market except Pound Sterling and Euro that depreciated faster than US dollar.



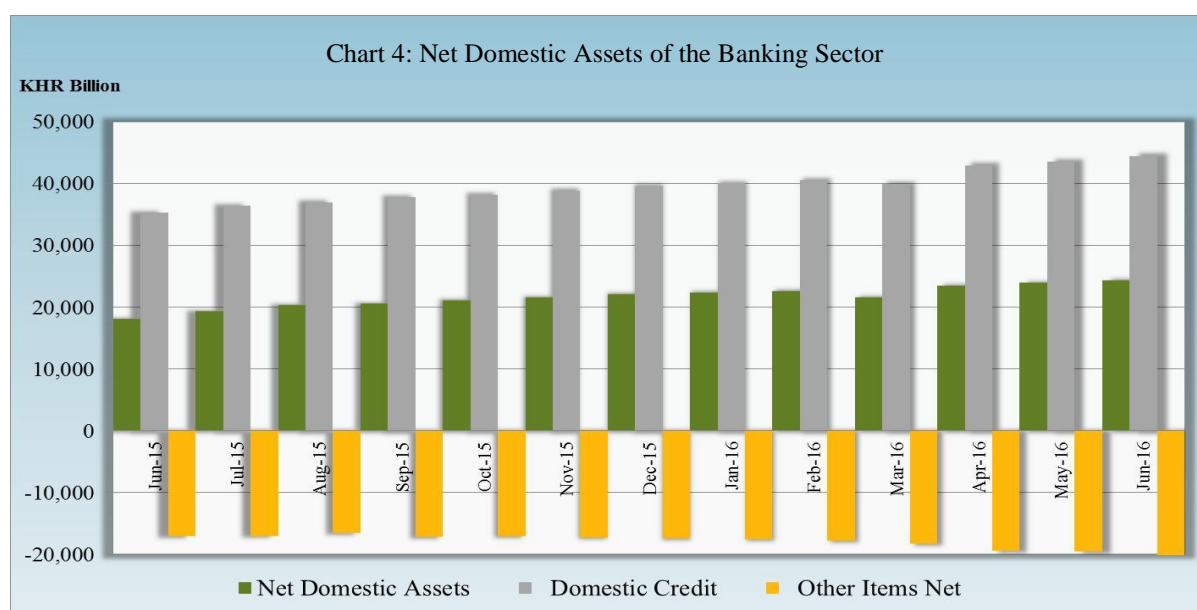
Money Supply

Broad money (M2) increased to KHR 54,473.4 billion in June 2016, up 2.2% compared to May 2016. The components of M2 including time and saving deposits, demand deposits, resident's foreign currency deposits, and currency outside banks increased by 9.1%, 4.5%, 2%, and 1.4%, respectively.



Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

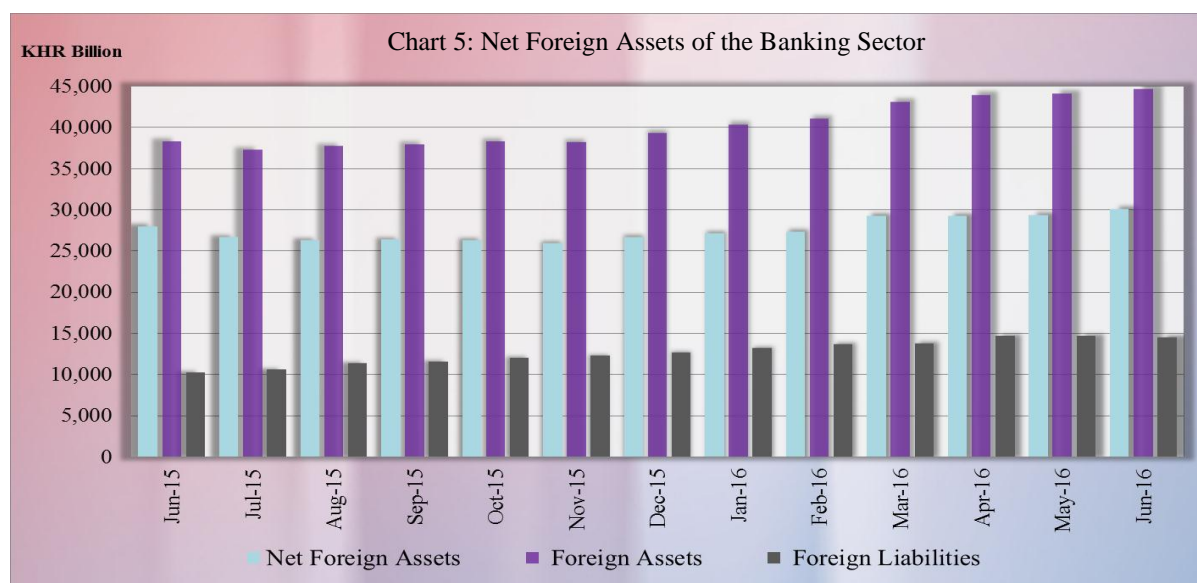
Net domestic assets of the banking sector in June 2016 continued to increase moderately to KHR 24,390.8 billion, up 1.7% from the previous month, due to an increase of 2.1% in domestic credit while other items net declined by 2.6%.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 2% in credit to private sectors while net claims on government decreased by 0.9%. The decline in other items net was mainly due to an increase of 6.3% in restricted deposits and 3.1% in capital and reserves.

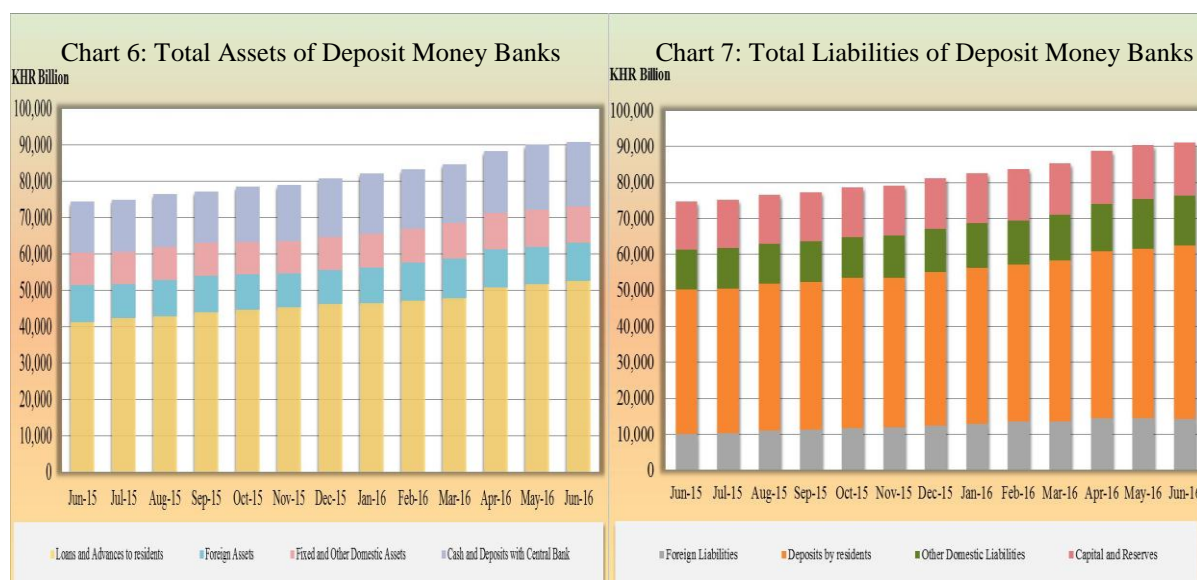
Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector increased to KHR 30,082.5 billion in June 2016, up by 2.5% from May 2016, mainly due to an increase of 1.4% in total foreign assets.



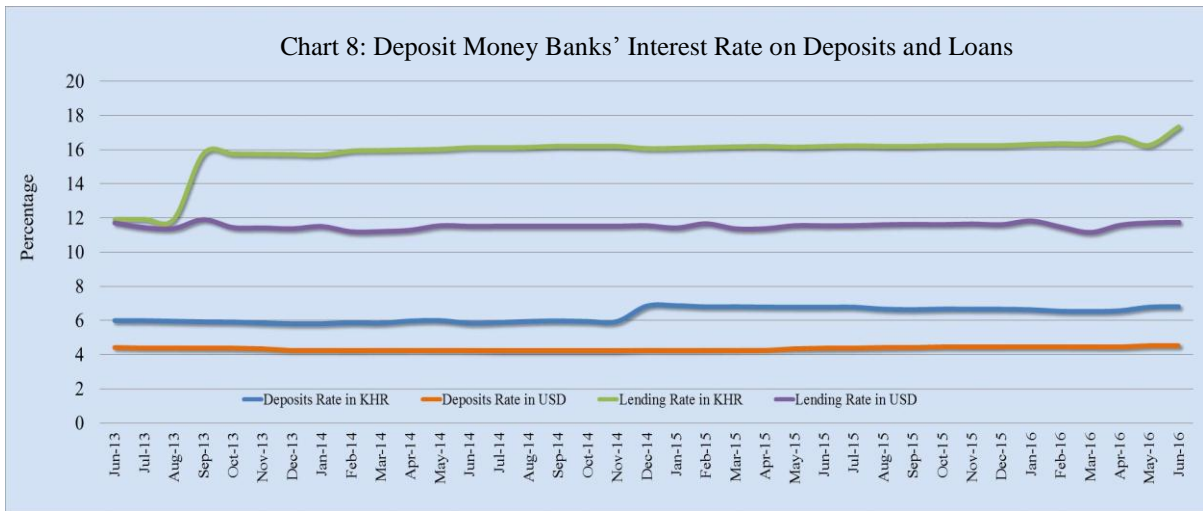
Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 91,093.1 billion, up by 1% in June 2016 from the previous month.



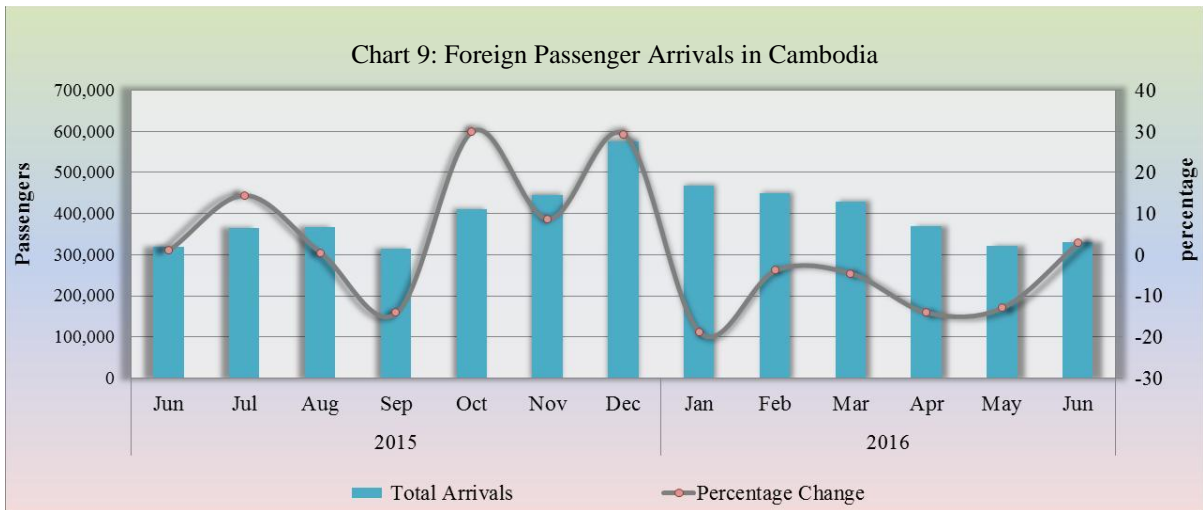
Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In June 2016, the interest rate movement with a 12-month maturity on deposits and loans showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR increased by 0.03% and deposit in USD increased by 0.01%. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR increased by 1.08% and lending rate in US dollar increased by 0.03%.

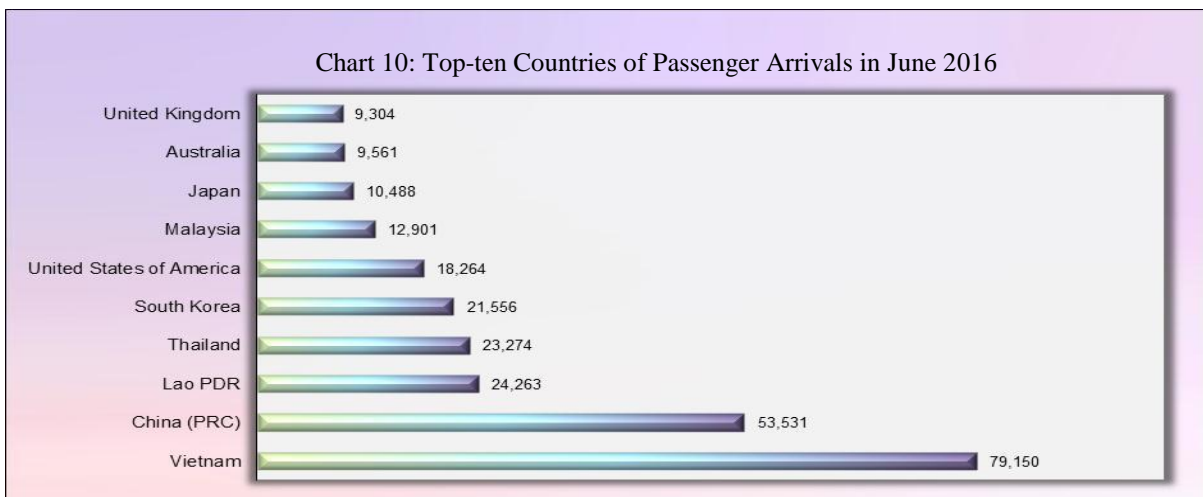


Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In June 2016, the total number of passenger arrivals was 330,170 passengers; increased by 3% following the decrease of 12.8% in the preceding month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 86% of the total.



Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, China P.R.C., Lao PDR, Thailand, South Korea, United States of America, Malaysia, Japan, Australia, and United Kingdom.



International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 639.4 billion (15.8%) in June 2016, from the deficit of KHR 1,748.3 billion (40.2%) in May 2016.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, Textile, and Sawm Timber. And the major components of total imports were Petroleum, Vehicles, Cigarettes, Motor Bikes, Construction Materials, Steel, Clothing, Cement, Sugar, Beer, and Cloths.

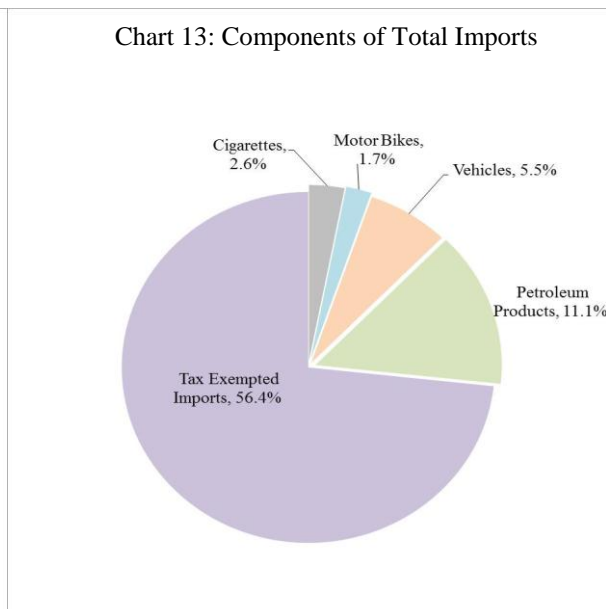
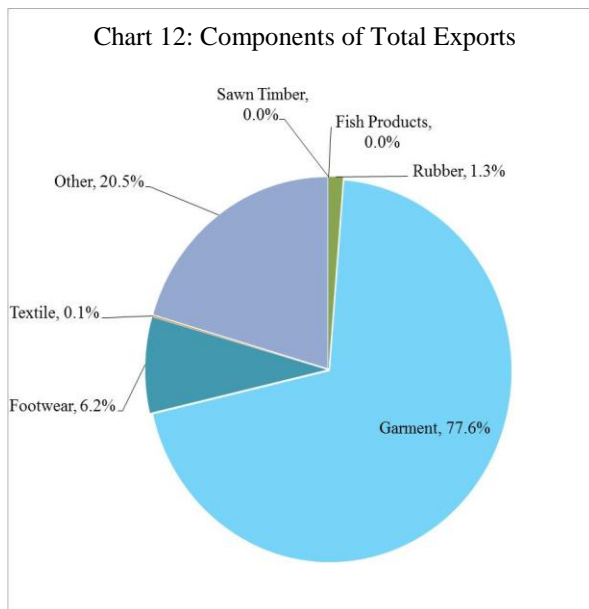

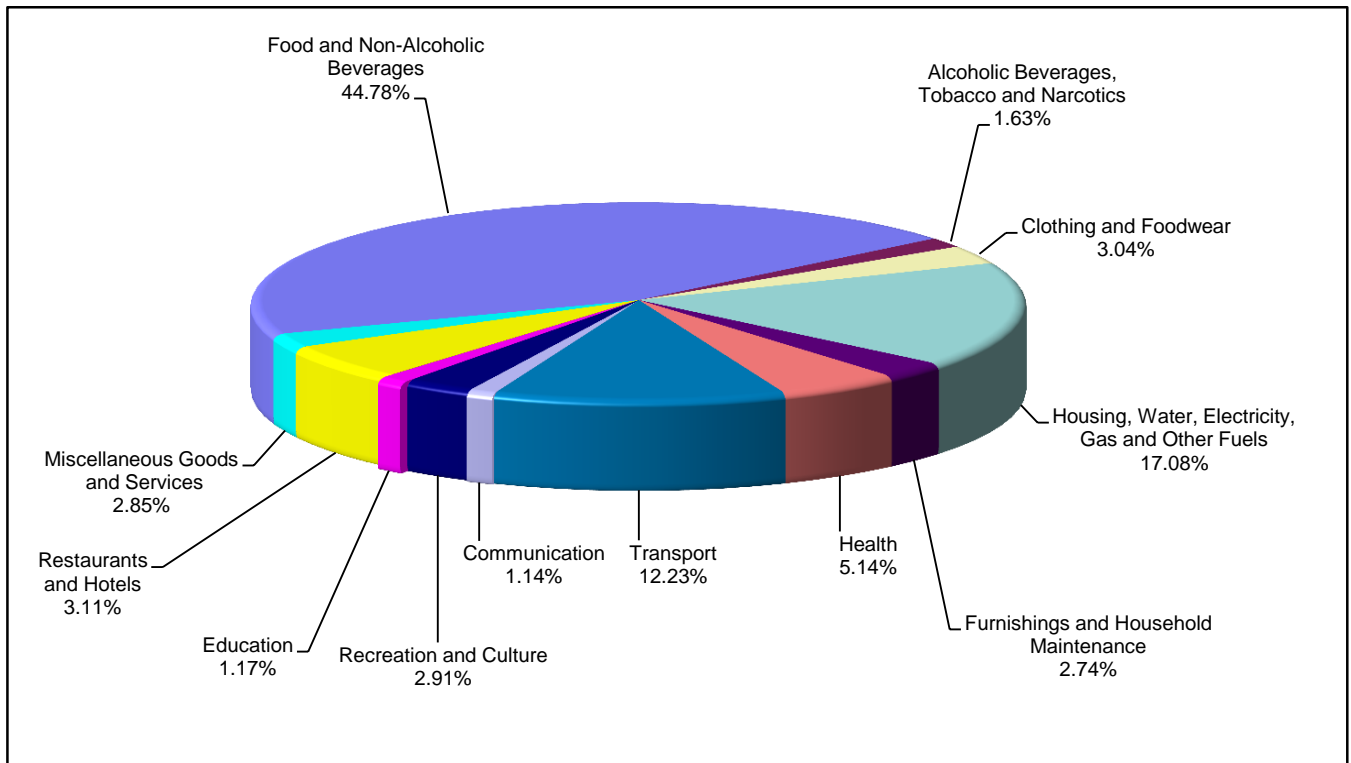

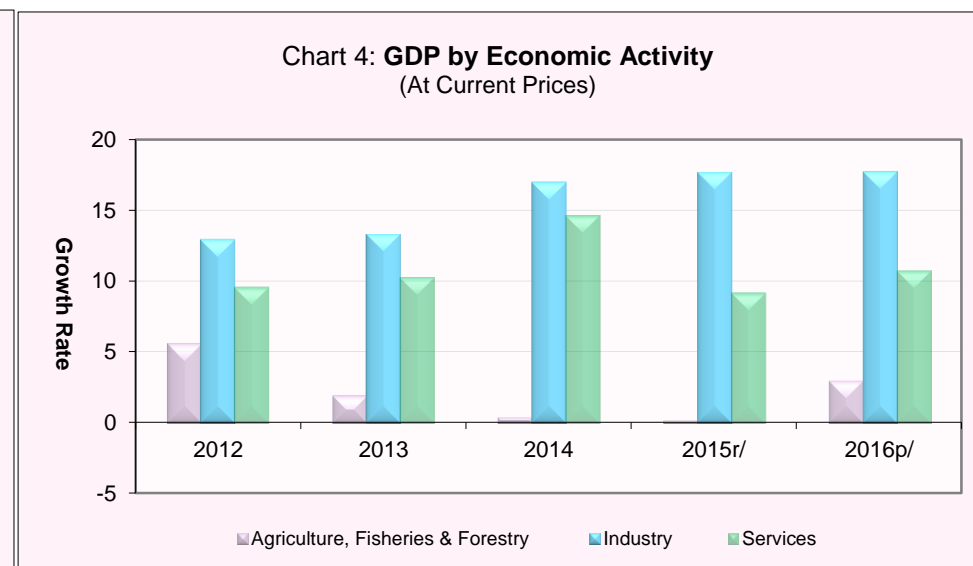
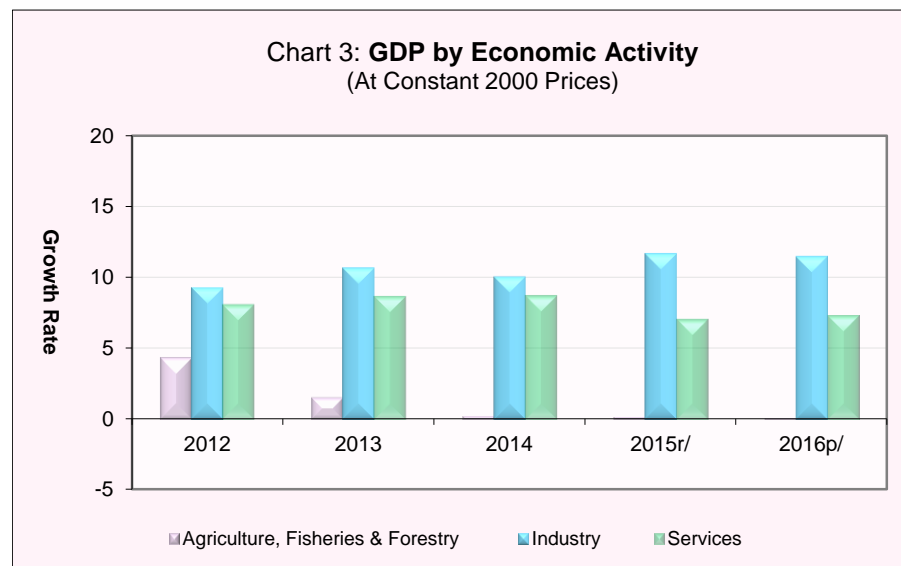
Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket

Chart 5: Investment Fixed Assets by Sectors

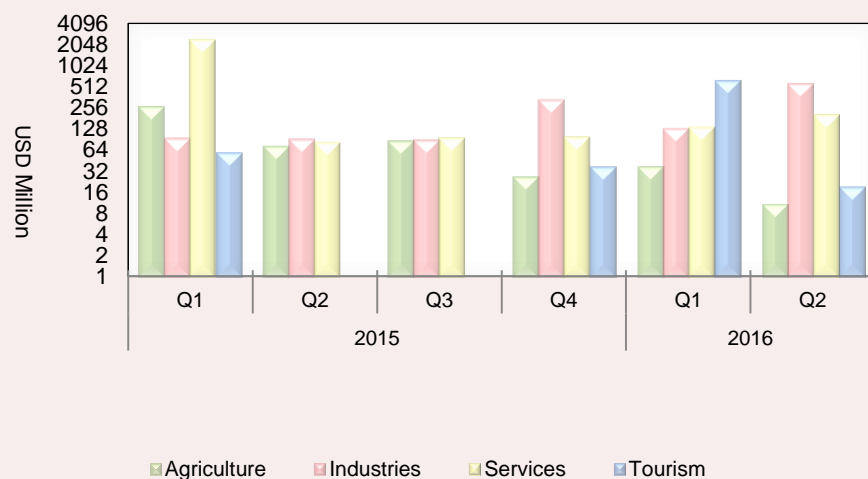
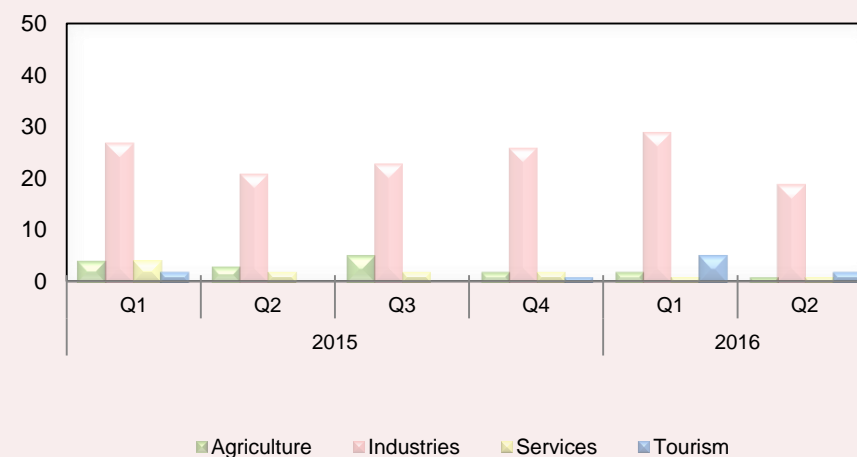


Chart 6: Number of Investment Projects by Sectors

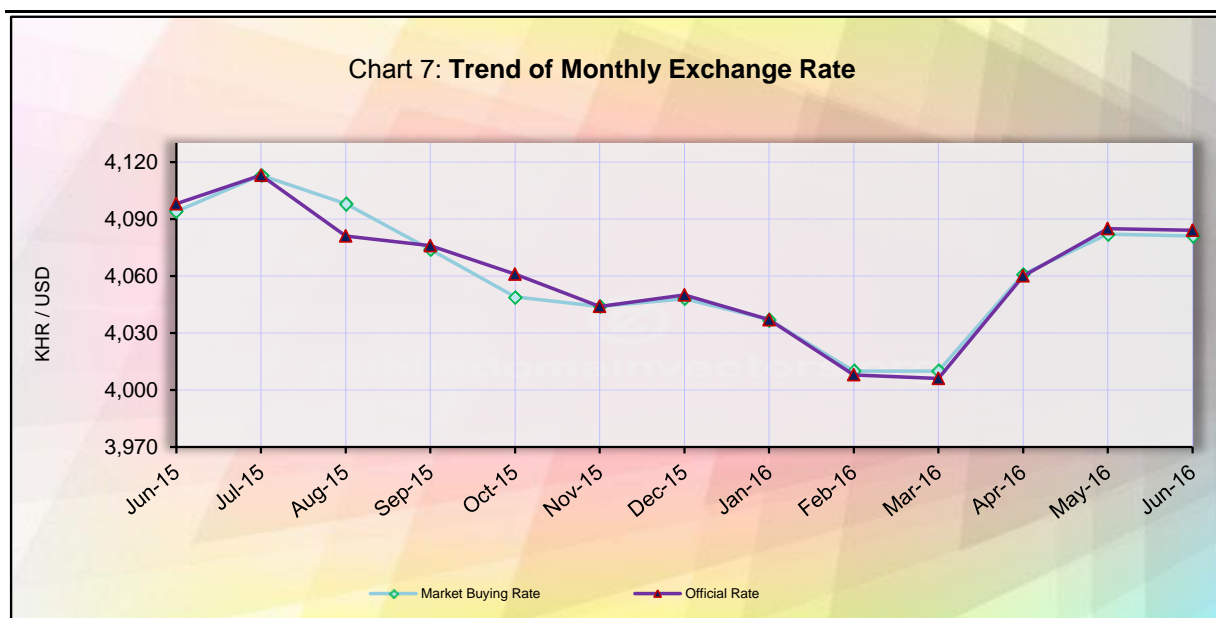

Chart 8: Monetary Survey

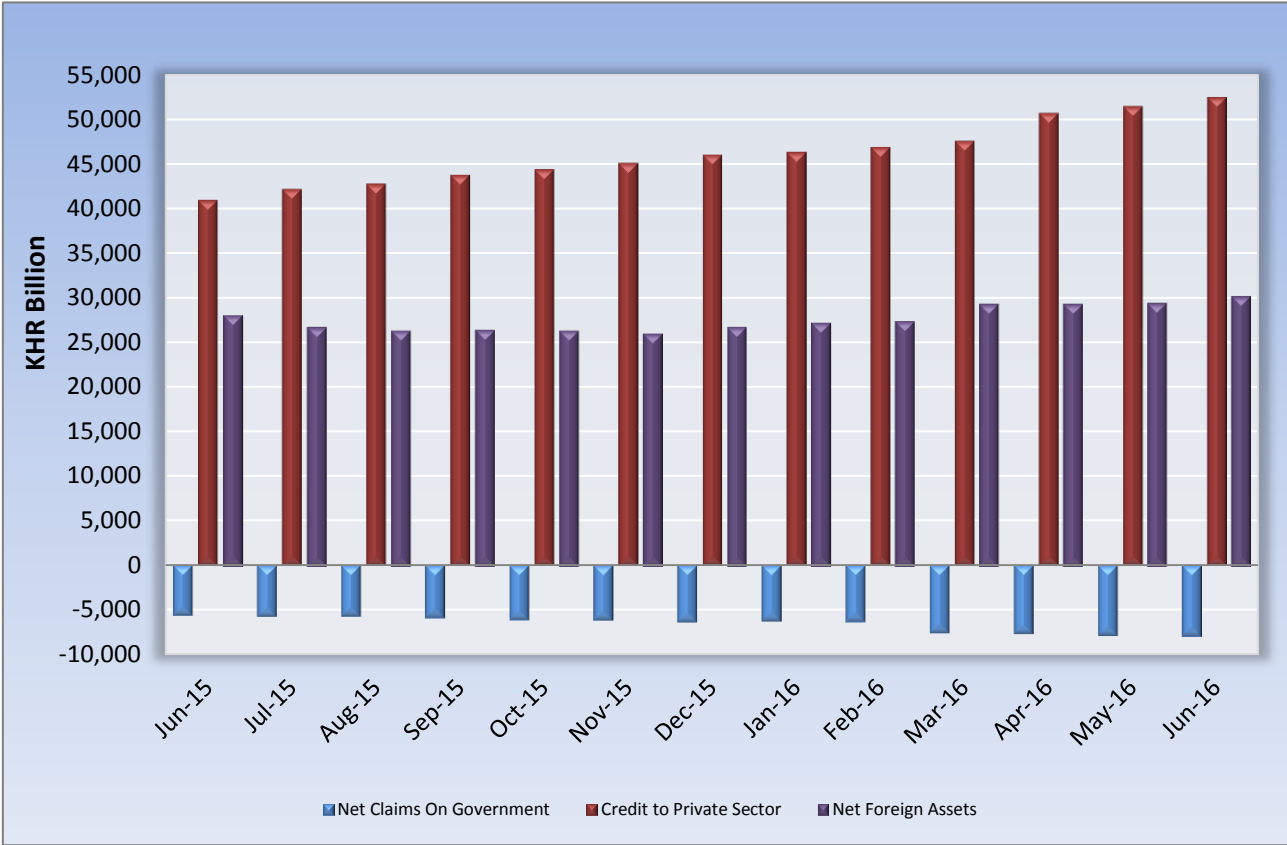


Chart 9: Components of Money Supply

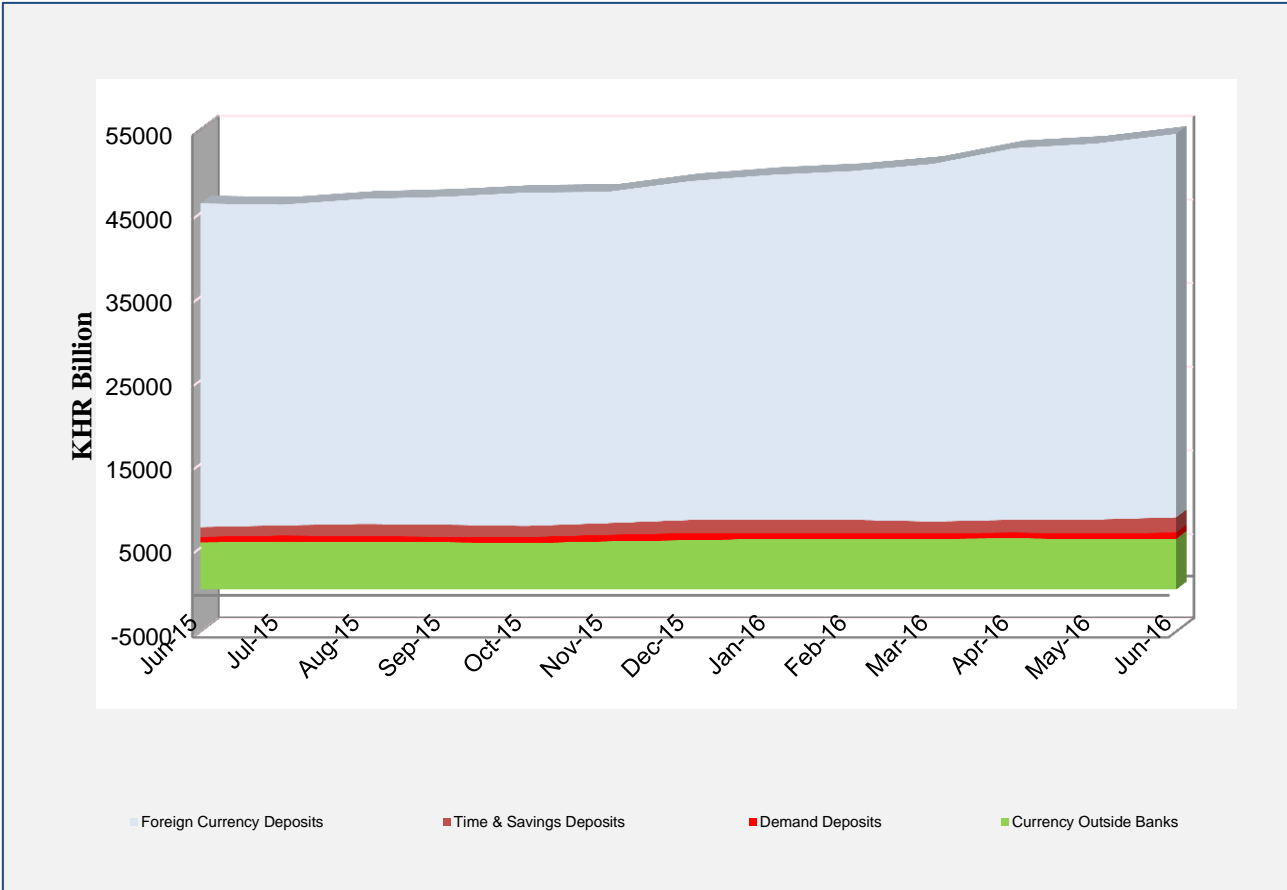

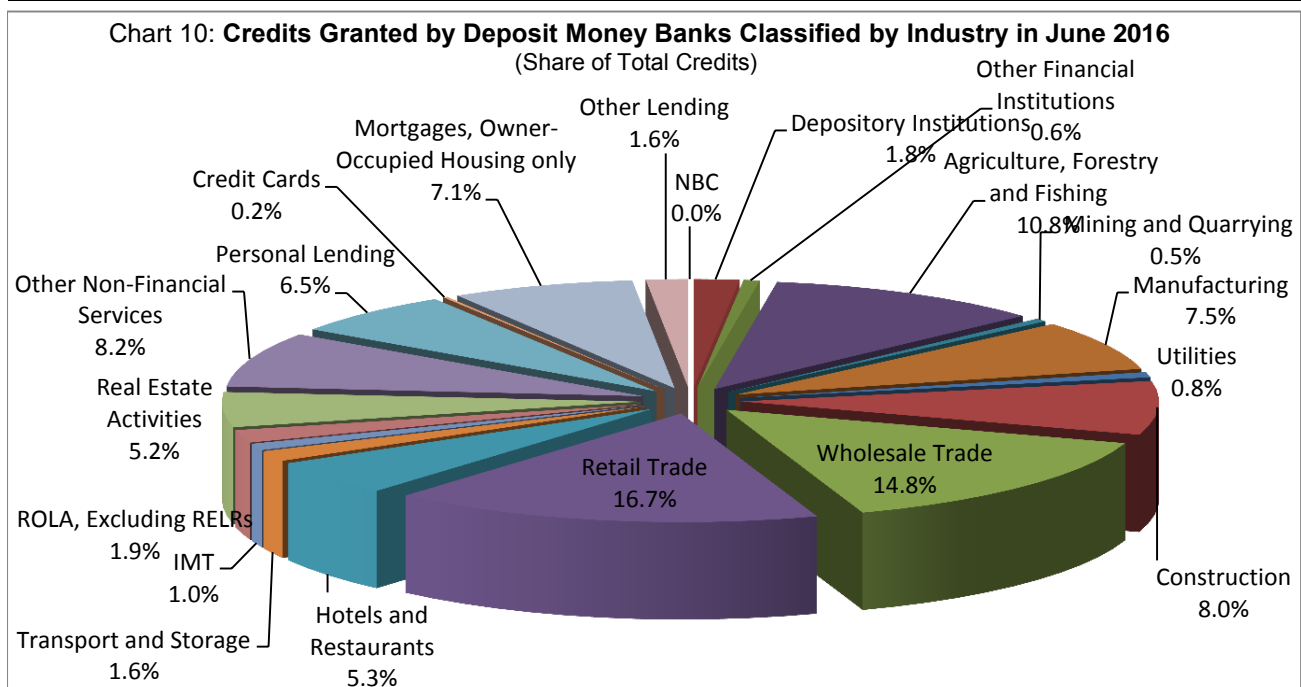

(Share of Grand Total Deposits)

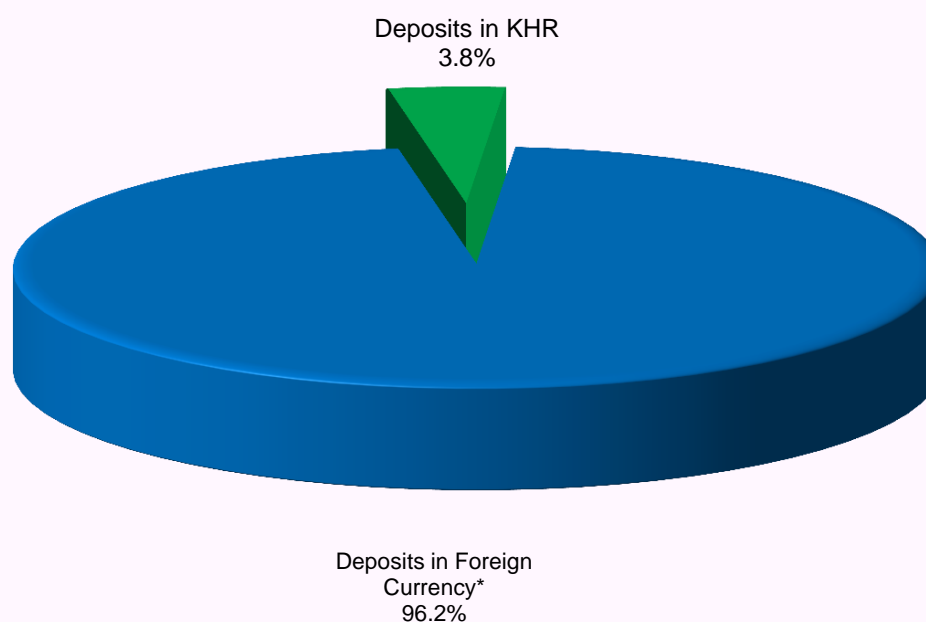

(Share of Total KHR Deposits)

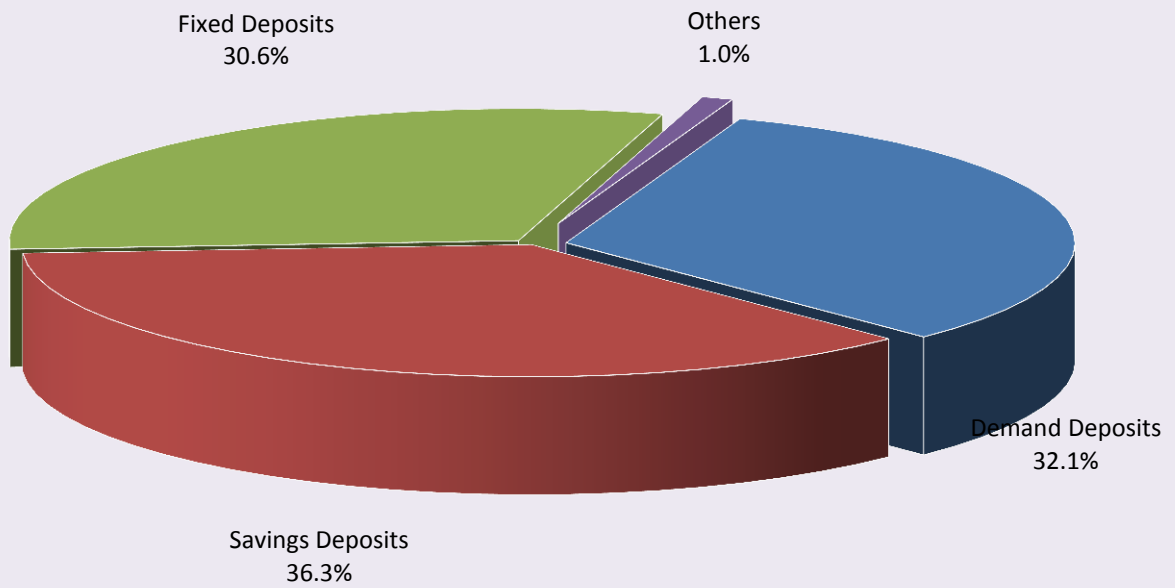
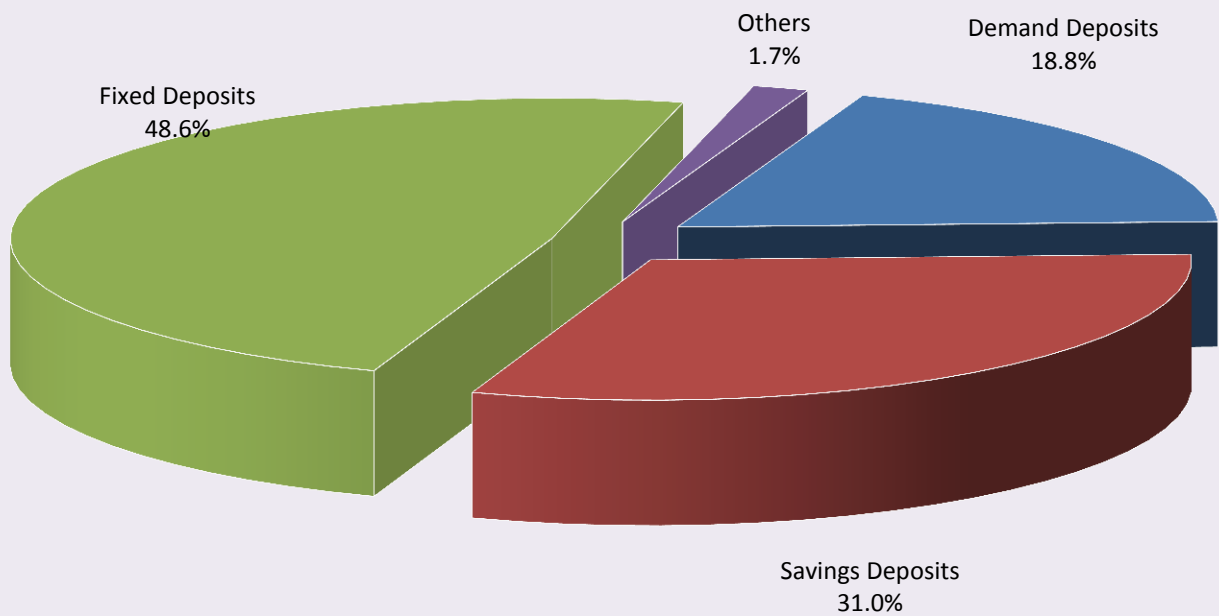


Chart 13: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of June 2016
